ang! Gae is a brand that always turns heads of avid music lovers and followers but for the 31 year old Tshepo Nephew Moanakwena it is a fulfilled dream. Birthed from humble beginnings he used university allowances to buy equipment to fulfil his dream and Bang! Gae came to be. The record label does an array of music management, videography and documentaries on different content about life in Botswana.

Nephew wanted to make his brand identifiable to Batswana hence the creative name Bang! Gae, "BANG" representing something big and irresistible "GAE" representing home, being Botswana. As a producer he understood what had to be done and his fruits to his labour were achieved through

various awards which include best motswako hip hop song, best producer and best male artist just to name a few. He has worked with many heavy weight local artists like Zeus, Daxis and Nicole Martinez. He even went on to spread his wings and produce for Yarona Fm, The Voice, Rako, Mafoko, Motovac, Onespread and many others.

Can you tell us more about your record studio, Bang! Gae.

We started in 2010 and I founded it with two other friends of mine, Pako Keoleletse and Theo Nthoi. We were fresh out of high school, so I spearheaded the whole thing when I started college on my first year at NIIT but never finished. However in honour of my mum, who passed on I went on to study Sound Technology

at Limkokwing University as she had always wanted me to finish school. So when I was in NIIT I used my allowance to buy some equipment and we started Bang! Gae based in Mogoditshane.

Have you ever received any award in your label?

We are an award winning studio, in 2015 we won three awards at the YAMAs. We won best producer, best collabo of the year and male best song of the year. We also won another award the following year at the BOMU awards.

What are your hobbies?

My hobby is working, I enjoy being in the studio, any time I am stressed out or feeling happy I will be in the studio producing, engineering or finishing up people's projects.

Is there anything you would like to add to your skills?

Well, I am happy with the skills I have but I would like to learn softwares. I want to know every software used in editing music videos and photos. I am interested in the visuals since I am skilled with sound.

Many artists usually tend to have an association with drug use, have you had any

dealings with drugs?

No, I have never tasted drugs and I do not even drink alcohol.

What are the misconceptions that people have about you, what do they say out there?

People think I drink, which I do not. The other thing is that people think I am a playboy but I am not, I was single from 2012 until last year when I met the lady I am with at the moment.

Let's talk about your greatest stresses, how do you handle stress?

I have had mental issues and suicidal thoughts before due to the work pressure. So how I dealt with them was through speaking to my good friends and let them know how I felt. I also express myself through my creativity.

As a producer and records label owner, what words can you share with people out there?

Get to know the gatekeepers to your success, know those people and network your way up, build relationships. Also watch your back, and don't trust easily. Associate yourself with the right people, they say your network is your net worth.

years old. I grew up like any other child, I have never allowed myself or anyone to

ormally I am define me in any different way because as we know, when you are an orphan there is a certain way people around you would want to treat you, mostly with pity, so I never allowed that. I knew that being an orphan didn't mean that I was handicapped or limited to some extent, which is why I feel like I played a vital role in moulding myself to become the person I am today. That is a musician, a digital artist, a father and a graduate with Bachelor's Degree in Community Development.

> I have six years in this industry, I started exploring my music talent back in 2012 while I was in Junior School and decided to go professional in 2015 because I felt like I was ready to share my gift with everyone.

Being an upcoming rapper in Botswana has been quite a challenge for me. Most of us upcoming youngsters have been on the edge of success, but the support still lack which is why even today renounced artists such as Vee and others still triumph over us. Not that we are all less talented, but because the people we are trying to entertain and inspire with our music are less receptive of us. It is the reason I am still struggling with finding stability, but I look forward to a more stable music career in future

Nonetheless, I have a handful of supporters since I started my music journey and I'm proud that over the years I have gained more supporters through social media. Their loyalty is overwhelming and I can never thank them enough. I am not certain of weather I have an audience outside the borders but I have made contacts at Lesotho when I went there for my graduation. They are supportive in terms of sharing my music with others that side. I had actually planned a joint project with one artist at Lesotho by called AtomicWolf, which got delayed due to the Covid-19 pandemic but with hope, we will resume our plan and start working.

The pandemic has disrupted a lot of my projects, in September last year I released an Official Demo Compilation titled FROM PALAPYE WITH A DREAM. Things didn't go as planned and I feel it's because my timing wasn't ideal as people were more concerned about the Covid-19 and the political atmosphere of the nation. However Im planning a re-drop of the project soon.

Most of the time when I write a song, I actually write to myself. I find true inspiration in myself and send positive vibes through music. It has worked for me because I rap about real and relatable issues.

One thing about me is that i like working with with other upcoming artists, I have worked with Noello and I am looking forward to work with more renounced artists. When I finished school I had to move back to Palapye from Gabs and this has posed a challenge for my work as there are limited resources required for production here in Palapye. But in a bid to tackle it, I recently acquired a home studio which allows me to record from my station and email my projects to producers in Gaborone.

I am currently working on visuals for my music. I am also preparing to drop a brand new single titled 'Pure Intentions,' an exciting and religious project which I worked on with my all-time beat maker Uniq-Thus and sound engineer AxeOnTheBeat from 205 Affiliated Entertainment Studio in Gaborone.

ez, born Kabo Maruping is a young talented and versatile artist who has been doing music since 2011. The lad was born and raised in Selebi Phikwe but he is originally from Maun. The artist says he has had a remarkable journey with his music as he has managed to incorporate his unique ways to delivering music, visuals, live performances and other diverse multiple skills that have helped him grow in his journey

as he never looked back.

He is an Electrical Technician professionally and also a businessman as a way of trying to make ends meet. He says he has worked with a number of renounced artists in Botswana like Yung Fella, Yung Fella, Cyc Jouzy, Jack Bohloko, Tribal Tido and Unique Thus just to mention a few. In 2015 the artist performed in the Orange Marathon after party and went on to perform again the following year. He also got to perform at the Miss Bulawayo Polytechnique Beauty Pageant in 2019 and the Spss Alumni in 2018 among many others. The artist had a chat with us regarding his music and this is what he had to say:

Tell us more about your music, your chosen genre.

My music is very special because I feel like I have been doing music for a while which has given me exposure to experiment with different sounds and they led me to my comfort zone which is Rap, but I have been able to work with other artists doing genres like Afro Beats and Amapiano.

What inspired you to become a musician?

Singing is something that has always been within me because from a young age I always did something that had to do with music, from primary school. I was in music clubs like choirs and marimba and they trigged that passion.

Is being a musician an easy

It's simple, solely because I have been doing music for a while so I have had time to practice and perfect myself, also learning new ways to being a better musician but it's not always easy, it's not also that much of a challenge ether.

If you were to sit down and introspect yourself today would you say you have grown as a musician, and how have you grown?

I have had quite a number of achievements which came without me noticing. Right before the pandemic I got heated up with performances. I also had a great opportunity to perform in Zimbabwe.

Whom do you aspire to work with in the near future?

Well, it's a question I have been asking myself since last year December. I came with three artists, I want to collaborate with Drak, Phologolo and Luz

I am looking into pushing the brand this year but I am also working on an E.P and I believe that it's going to be a great E.P to ever come out.

her studies she went on to work Baboneng at Film Productions where she was an Assistant Producer for two years. After working with Baboneng went on to work for Duma FM as radio presenter content producer from 2012 to 2015 before she became correspondent for an international agency, Xinhua News Agency in 2016 untill 2017. Having acquired that much experience not only as a Film producer but in the general media as well she felt she was ready to be her own boss and produce her own productions, in 2017 Walker

promote different artists in the SADC region. Her company is also currently working on a documentary that focuses on acknowledging and celebrating those who have served this country. The show is called THE STORY and they managed to interview the former president Ian Khama among others.

Otsile says that working in this field of industry has not been easy especially in Botswana. In a country that is still growing at a slow pace in the film industry, funding for projects has been difficult for her as they find it hard to source out funds. This has been even more difficult for her company as it is upcoming and without enough experience for companies to confidently offer financial assistance. Selling and marketing the products as well is a huge challenge as BTV is the major local buyer of content but does have their own trusted producers so with her company has also been difficult to market and compete with fellow more accomplished competitors. She says that one requires to have networks and know people in order to get through in this industry.

Being a female film producer and even when she was still a radio producer too was a challenge as there has always been a lot of men dominating the industry. This was especially difficult when she was producing sports programs as there has always been a stereotype of sports being a men's thing. She says they would "block" her once they felt threatened by her successful work in the field, since she has always had some knowledge on sports issues she did good but they made it difficult forth which she ended up quitting or having to work but not to her level best. She says however the challenges where for her as a female producer she managed to excel and be where she is today.

The production company is currently working on the "THE STORY" and she says that she intended to have stations like Now TV buy and air the show. She says that she also hopes that international productions like BBC Africa would buy her content and documentaries.

Otsile Breaks Through The Cemented Boundaries Of Botswana Filmmaking

he is one of this country's hardworking female producers having produced shows that aired in the national television. Otsile V Keobokile, the founder of Walker production, a product of Botswana's biggest Media and film school Limkokwing University of Creative Technology (LUCT) has thus far made the university proud by her successful productions in a country that still suffers growth in the Film and Television industry. Born in 1985 she grew up in Gaborone and studied in the city from her primary level to tertiary where she studied an Associate Degree in TV and Film Productions from 2008 to 2010 at LUCT. After finishing

Productions was born.

Walker Production produced some programs that aired in the national television, BTV like The Business Kraal and Check Up which was a health magazine and so many others. These are not the only shows that Otsile has produced and aired on BTV, before she started her company she produced a documentary, "Snakes of Botswana," a talent seeking show, "Gemstones" and a feature film, A Lerato ke Lone leo all of which were played on station. She said in the interview with CW magazine that she has also worked with an American producer to film a Baha'i Blog studio session that was meant to



amsung Galaxy Chromebook 2 has been unveiled for CES 2021 as the successor to last year's Galaxy Chromebook. The new model has a QLED display that comes as a noteworthy upgrade over the AMOLED screen available on the predecessor. The Galaxy Chromebook 2 also comes with thinner bezels. Samsung has retained the 2-in-1 form factor and offered support for Universal Stylus Initiative (USI) pen on the new Chromebook. Further, the Galaxy Chromebook 2 comes in two distinct colour options to choose from and have Intel Celeron and 10th-generation Intel Core i3 variants, and it has also dropped the price significantly.

Samsung Galaxy Chromebook 2 price

Samsung Galaxy Chromebook 2 price starts at \$549.99 (roughly Rs. 40,300), as reported by The Verge. The pricing is significantly lower than the Galaxy Chromebook that debuted at \$999.99 (roughly Rs. 73,300). The Galaxy Chromebook 2 comes in Fiesta Red and Mercury Gray colour options. The Samsung Galaxy Chromebook 2 features a 13.3-inch full-HD (1,920x1,080 pixels) QLED display with touch support. The Chromebook comes in 64GB and 128GB storage options — along with expansion support via microSD card.





f your baby weighs much less than 2.5kg, midwives may describe her as having a very, or extremely, low birth weight.

What Causes Low Birth Weight?
 Your baby may be small simply because it runs in

your family. Parents who are shorter and weigh less, or who were themselves small at birth, may have smaller children.

If your baby was born prematurely, and didn't have enough time to grow.

- If you had twins or more, because they are often born early, and don't have as much room to grow in the uterus (womb) as single babies.
- If your baby has an inherited medical condition.
- If there were problems with the placenta, which

reduces blood flow to your baby as this can restrict your baby's growth, because not enough oxygen and nutrients can get through.

If you had high blood pressure in pregnancy, as this can also affect the flow of blood through the placenta to your baby.

How Could Having A Low Birth Weight Affect My Baby? It's different for every baby. How your baby is affected depends on what caused the low birth weight. However, some problems may happen if you have your baby prematurely, such as your baby having:

- Breathing problems, called respiratory distress syndrome
- An increased risk of infection
- Low blood sugar and problems with feeding
- Difficulty with keeping warm

Positive Steps To Improve Your Baby's Chances Of A Healthy Start:

- Breastfeed your baby. This is one of the best things you can do to help her grow up to be healthy.
- Make sure your baby has all her growth and development checks.
- As she gets older, keep an eye on your baby's weight gain, as rapid weight gain early on could lead to problems for her weight and health in adulthood.
 A nutritious diet can help your baby to grow steadily, but use caution with nutrient-enriched formulas.





An allergy is a reaction by your immune system to something. People who have allergies are often sensitive to more than one thing.

Types of allergies

Food Allergy - are estimated to affect 4 percent of adults.

Skin Allergy - Irritated skin can be caused by a variety of factors. These include immune system disorders, medications and infections.

Eye Allergy - occurs when something you

are allergic to irritates the conjunctiva. This is the delicate membrane covering the eye and the inside of the eyelid.

Pet Allergies - Pet allergies can contribute to constant allergy symptoms, such as causing your eyes to water, or causing you to start sneezing.

Insect Sting Allergy - Stings from five insects - honeybees, hornets, wasps, yellow jackets and fire ants are known to cause allergic reactions to the venom injected into the skin.

Drug Allergies - If you develop a rash,

hives or difficulty breathing after taking certain medications, you may have a drug allergy.

Valentine's Day Swirl Cookies













Ingredients

2 cups flour, plus possibly a few more tablespoons

1/2 tsp baking powder

1/4 tsp salt

2/3 cup powdered sugar

1/4 cup granulated sugar

2 1/2 sticks unsalted butter (cut in chunks)

1 tsp vanilla

1/2 tsp of red food coloring

1 1/2 cup Valentine's Day colored sprinkles

Cooking time: 15 to 17 minutes

Directions

- To begin with, in the bowl of a stand mixer, combine flour, baking powder, salt, and sugars with paddle on medium until well blended. Slowly add the butter, gradually, and continue mixing. Add the vanilla extract. Finally, continue mixing until the dough forms a ball.
- Remove all the dough and divide into two equal parts. Return one portion back in to the mixer and add the red food coloring. Mix until the color is spread out evenly and the dough is completely
- Using a rolling pin, roll out each portion of the dough, between two sheets a wax paper until it reaches about 11 x 9 inches and is 1/4 inch thick. Finally, slide both layers unto a baking sheet pan and chill in the refrigerator for at least one hour. When firm, remove the top sheets of wax paper from both layers.
- When firm, remove the top sheets of wax paper from both. Brush the uncolored vanilla dough lightly with water using a pastry brush. Then flip the colored dough onto the vanilla uncolored dough so they are stacked atop each other and even. Press the edges lightly with your fingertips to seal them together.
- Using a small knife, trim the edges of the dough to make straight, even lines.
- Slice your dough into 1/4 inch slices and bake on parchment lined baking sheets in a preheated 350 degree oven for 15 to 17 minutes or until the edges are starting to turn golden brown.
- Let the cookies rest on the baking sheet for about 5 minutes. Then move them to a cookie rack to finish cooling.



Meet Wilberforce Dolph Ntsenang from Rakops village in Boteti region. He was born and raised in Orapa, he also schooled in Orapa and attended tertiary education at Gaborone Technical College. His business started in 2010 when he was still working for a company called Tau Steel Enterprises. As it is said that 'you start small', he started by buying the equipment then he came up with new ideas in steel work, and God answered him. This is what he shared when we interviewed him;

How is your business doing in the market?

So far my business is doing well, despite the fact that when I come up with a new idea some boiler makers buy my products, copy and design them for selling. But I still receive so many orders around Botswana, e.g the steel wood stove will be distributed and end of this month, I already have over 100 customers interested in the wood stove.

How different are you from your competitors?

I am very different from my competitors because I work hard to develop my products. I work hard to market my products and I even goggle on the internet to ask Chinese craftsmen ways to develop my products. It's the reason my business performs better in steel industry. I also price my products reasonably despite steel prices go up every day.

What has been your greatest achievement to date?

I have achieved so many things through my business. I have managed to buy a farm with savings from my business.

What strategies do you use to keep the business going?

I always make sure that I buy enough materials well in time so that my customers find ready made products and this strategy keeps the business going.

What is the most difficult part about your business?

It is when I initiate innovation and people start copying it including the name and claim that it's theirs. As Batswana, we can't grow if we are going to take that root and I know that soon many people will claim this wood stove is their own concept.

How To Remove Dark Stains From Glassware

Make a bleach soak – If your drinking glasses have dark stains, soak them in a bleach solution. Add one tablespoon of chlorine bleach to a gallon of warm water. Use rubber gloves and protect your clothing from contact with the bleach while cleaning.

Soak your glasses - Gently place your drinking glasses in the bleach solution. Allow them to soak for approximately thirty minutes. Remove and rinse the glasses in cold water.

Scrub glasses with baking soda - If any stains remove after soaking, sprinkle the glasses with baking soda. Wet a clean sponge and gently scrub the glasses. Rinse them thoroughly and let them air dry.

Use toothpaste - As an alternative method of removing dark stains, use basic white toothpaste (that does not contain gels, breath freshening ingredients, or other additives). Use a clean, soft-bristle toothbrush to gently spread the toothpaste all over the inside and outside of the glasses. Rinse thoroughly with warm water and air dry.

Circuit Train

Circuit training pumps up your heart rate and builds strength in a short amount of time.

To create an at-home circuit, first choose three to four cardio exercises like jumping jacks, jogging in place, step-ups, mountain climbers, burpees, and jumping rope. Then choose three strength training exercises like push-ups, planks, abdominal crunches, tricep dips, wall sits, lunges, and squats. Alternate between cardio and strength training exercises. Do 30-second bursts of each for 3 to 4 minutes. Repeat this circuit two to three times.

Jump Rope

Jumping rope burns calories, elevates your heart rate, and improves coordination, muscle elasticity, and brain function. Plus, it's fun, easy, and takes up very little space. After a short warm-up, do 30-second intervals of jumps, followed by 15 to 30 seconds of rest. Mix it up with a combination of single-leg jumps, split-leg jumps, and wide-to-narrow jumps, running in place, and taking off and landing on both feet. Bump up the time as you get better. Cool down with calf and quadriceps stretches.

Boxing or Kickboxing

Boxing and kickboxing are stellar conditioning workouts you can easily do





at home while channelling your inner aggressor and relieving stress. Fire up YouTube or on-demand TV for a wide range of boxing and kickboxing workouts to follow along with at home. Or create your own. Alternate 1-minute intervals of jabs, crosses, and kicks and 1-minute intervals of active recovery like shadow boxing, jogging in place, or skipping rope. Gradually increase the time of your active intervals.

Climb Stairs

Do you have some stairs in your home? Include them in your cardio workout. An at-home stair-climbing workout is about






as simple as it gets. Set a timer for your preferred workout length, walk up and down your stairs, and repeat until it beeps. Start with just a few minutes, then work your way up to longer stair-climbing workouts as you feel stronger.

Dancing

It will raise your spirits just as it raises your heart rate too. Dancing is universal, it does not matter which age group one is from. It also counts as a cardio workout. It can lower your risk of coronary heart disease and blood pressure and help you lose weight.

ASHLEY BARNES' late penalty condemned lackluster Liverpool to defeat, ending a remarkable sequence of Anfield dominance. The Reds had been unbeaten in their last 68 home outings in the Premier League, dating back to April 2017. On that day, Christian Benteke's brace on his return to Merseyside with Crystal Palace got the job done. That result, however, would spark a run of form at home only bettered once in Premier League history. To mark the end of what's been an incredible sequence, explore the five most imperious home runs in the history of the league;

5. MAN UNITED 1994-1996 - 35 games

By 1994, Sir Alex Ferguson had well and truly found his groove at Old Trafford, having won the last two league titles with the Red Devils. The Scot's bid for three on the bounce hit the buffers in December, however, when goals from Stan Collymore and Stuart Pearce helped Nottingham Forest to inflict a 2-1 defeat at Old Trafford. While their hopes of a title that season were dented by Blackburn, Ferguson's men would bounce back the following campaign, going the whole 1995-96 Premier League season unbeaten at home as they reclaimed their throne. The run ended at 35 unbeaten in November 1996, when strikes from Gianluca Vialli and Michael Duberry helped Chelsea to a 2-1 Old Trafford triumph.

4. MAN UNITED 1998-2000 - 36 games

Arsenal managed to interrupt United's Nineties dominance with a title triumph in 1997-98, but the Red Devils would reclaim their throne with a vengeance. Things may have got tricky, when Middlesbrough grabbed a 3-2 win at Old Trafford in December 1998. But as they tended to do, Ferguson's United regrouped, putting together a stunning run that culminated in an unprecedented Treble later that season. United's next home loss in the Premier League would come in December 2000, when Danny Murphy's first-half strike handed bitter rivals Liverpool a priceless win at the Theatre of Dreams.

3. MAN CITY 2010-2012 - 37 games

It would take more than a decade for anyone to beat United's record, but fittingly it was their 'noisy neighbours'. Newly-rich City had some growing pains at the start of the Sheikh Mansour era, and had already been spanked 3-0 by Arsenal at home prior to Everton's 2-1 win at Eastlands in December 2010. The growing pains would cease at this point, however, as by the next time City dropped a home league game, they had won the Premier League in dramatic circumstances in 2012. The run came to an end in December of that year, when Ferguson saw his side grab a crucial 93rd minute winner on his last trip to City before retiring at the end

of another title-winning season.

2. LIVERPOOL 2017-2021 68 games

Speaking of growing pains, it took a little bit of time for Jurgen Klopp to get it right at Liverpool. His gung-ho side entertained crowds in his first couple of years, but struggled to put together much consistency. After that loss to Palace, however, they clicked into another gear, with defensive rock Virgil van Dijk arriving less than 12 months later. The Reds swiftly became an imperious force at home, sweeping virtually all aside until Sean Dyche's Clarets came to town.

1. CHELSEA 2004-2008 - 86 games

Arsenal's Invincibles side won 2-1 at Stamford Bridge in February 2004, as Claudio Ranieri's Chelsea reign began to wind to an end. Jose Mourinho arrived the following summer, Roman Abramovich's purse strings were loosened and the Blues went on an astonishing run of their own. While being near impossible to breach at the back, Chelsea won back-to-back league titles, and remarkably didn't lose a single Premier League game at Stamford Bridge throughout the Portuguese's first tenure. Avram Grant came and went, before the run finally ended in October 2008, when Luiz Felipe Scolari's team were beaten 1-0 by Liverpool courtesy of a Xabi Alonso strike. Source: thesun.co.u
