

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
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
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Sour Man Bw

Takes Traditional Music to a Whole New Perspective

is passion, if you have a passion for something you will create the talent". This has been the case for a Tswana dancehall artist known as Sour Man Bw.

His passion for music started at a tender age when he was a traditional dancer for his junior secondary school. In 2007, Sour Man Bw joined a group called "Sebabatsane" as a traditional dancer and later on joined several other community groups like Ditholwana, Molodiwakoma, Gatalatau, and Sedimo sa Koma.

As part of Sebabatsane, Sour Man learned a lot about the music industry as they got to share the stage and performed alongside legends of the industry like Shumba Ratshega, Cultures spears, Doctor Vom, Alfredmos, Ditiro Leero, etc. For more than 4 years working as a traditional dancer for several groups, he developed an interest in producing his own project that went on to be recorded in 2010 at Meds I records by Lejohman. This was a traditional music album titled "Panyapanya" and featured a beautiful and talented lady called Segametsi.

he album presented him with many prospects even though he had to make connections first. It took the passionate lad a full two years to try and figure out the momentum of the industry as a solo artist. However, the album did well in terms of getting him known and led to him working with local and international artists.

In 2015 he met up with the producer Bullet Ketshabile who recorded his second traditional dance album which was titled "Bonka go thusa" featuring Segametsi. The album did well and branded his name as an artist. He then made yet another "Panyapanya" album. Through album, he had the privilege of travelling around to perform and share stages with other known local artists. He was also interviewed by various radio stations and even performed at Mokaragana, Maitisong festival and also got to perform on SABC 1's the Roots Programme alongside Mmausi in Johannesburg which was a dream come true for him.

During his journey in music, Sour Man Bw started listening to different types of music and fell in love with Zimbabwean dancehall especially Tocky Vibes's music, a famous Zim-dancehall artist. He revealed that after an encounter with that music, he was fond of the genre and wanted to try it. he went back to the studio and incorporated traditional music into dancehall. The album came out titled "Dancehall Pot" and featured Lejohman. It was recorded at Meds I records and was produced by Lejohman. That is when he officially named himself SOUR MAN BW. The album was a hit and went viral which in turn created new connections with other international dancehall artists.

His transition from traditional dance music to Original Tswana Dancehall opened his eyes and taught him that as long as you are in the creative industry, you must not limit yourself and you should challenge yourself always.

Sour Man says he aspires to see himself working at an international level. He also hopes to inspire the younger generation and ascertains to help those who are passionate about their talents as well as helping our nation with job creation.

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n 1995, the small town of Selibe Phikwe was blessed with the birth of a young Jazz maestro Obolokile Mompoloki also known as Lokile. Some people are born with many talents and Lokile happens to be one of those people. Apart from Jazz, he is also a drummer, keyboardist and actor.

He started his trade as an avid drummer at an early age and in secondary school he took his drumming to another level by picking up another musical skill as a singer and learning the keyboard. Lokile went on to follow his dream of music by studying Engineering at Botswana's prestigious arts and technology school Limkokwing University.

As he was studying in Limkokwing, lokile started to seriously pursue a career as an Afro-jazz artist and began to record his own originally composed music. In 2018 he released a 7 tracks album titled "Lorato Loeto". He has since been doing live performances at many different venues like Bahumi Lounge, the first Jwaneng Galaxy Club Live Jazz Festival in 2018 and Limkokwing University. He has also shared shows with other Jazz artists like Nono Siile, Jomo Chawilane and Travor Mabua. In this edition, CW had a chat with the artist about his music.

Can you tell us a bit about your type of music?

Lokile is an artist who ventured into Afro Jazz. My music is written in the mother language and I have an album with seven songs.

What inspired you to choose this particular genre?

I was inspired by a South African Afro Soul artist known as "Presss". His skills built a tower of interest in interpreting the afro jazz alongside his Afro Soul sounds.

What other genres have you ever ventured into apart from this one?

Other than Afro Jazz I have also ventured into Afro Soul and house music, doing covers.

In your line of music what are the challenges you have encountered?

The first thing would be marketing; the

lack of proper marketing has been a big stumbling block due to fewer funds hence less reach of followers. Another challenge is the lack of resources, due to lack of funds we find ourselves in a state where we can't provide ourselves with the relevant equipment.

Do you ever find resolutions to those challenges?

Yes, my team and I do manage to reach out by utilizing the use of social media platforms like Facebook, Instagram, and others.

We are in a time where many have been affected in their hustles and businesses by the Covid-19 pandemic, how has it affected you and your music?

No income, we are all at our homes with no sources of income due to Covid-19 restrictions and it is sad that the government is also not assisting the Creative Industry at large.

How have you been trying to keep up amid the challenges brought by this

The struggle is real, we are still failing to adapt to the new normal lifestyle since we can't generate any source of income, we are just putting our trust upon the Lord.

So what are we to expect from you in the near future?

I am currently working on my single, titled Basadi. The single is expected to be released early 2021.

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A DOWN TO EARTH KING OF ARTS

"Music is therapeutic," says the talented Tafadzwa Busani Nazare commonly known by many as Tafnaz. He considers himself a therapist for those who deal with emotional ills. As a singer, Taf believes he is not just an entertainer, he is an advocate for positivity and an emotional healer.

Coming from humble beginnings,

he grew up in the second capital of Zimbabwe in a city called Bulawayo. He was brought up in the musically inclined seventh day Adventist church so harmony has always been a part of his life. Raised by a music-loving aunt and a plethora of Disney musicals like the lion king and many other known Disney Blockbusters, music was an active ingredient everywhere they

went. From Joe Thomas filled road trips to Craig David and Usher Sunday, Boyz II Men, Dru Hill, *NSYNC, and the Pied piper of RnB R.Kelly. Of course, there were a lot of other artists they listened to but he remembers these ones vividly because they took up most of his singallong memory space.

Tafnaz stated that he has been singing



for as long as he can remember, however, he only took notice of this when he was in Form one during his second term as a high school student in a boarding school when a friend turned rival challenged him to a sing-off. As the dorm gathered in his favor, they were astonished by his effortless performance. That was the day Tafnaz realized he actually has a gift.

He went from singing in the shower to singing with older gospel groups as expected of an Adventist boy. Acapella became his go-to music as he sang with bands. The warm feeling of vocal unity made him feel like this is where he belonged. This went on for a long period and brought with it, the age of evangelism. Together with his group, they would visit other churches and events to grace them with their music in a bid to spread the gospel through the art. Like all good things, this phase came to a halt when like every other teenager, his "voice broke". Being unable to sing led him to the discovery of poetry and gave way to his Rapper phase. He went from a man of the gospel to a street poet with "Bars".

All of this, opened up a whole new side to him because he grew up as a creative writer. Fast forward to his voice coming back in the 4th form, the RnB in him returned when Usher dropped the second "Confessions" album. Taf says that he used to wow the ladies, but annoy the gents, he couldn't stop singing. He went from editing love letters to writing love songs. In 2008, after high school, he was flown to Malaysia for university, and there amongst

other creative people, he found music still waiting for him alongside brilliant musicians, namely Jonah Sithole and Philo. They formed a trio and dubbed "Beat Harmony" that went on to blow away all competition and it was their first-ever in Malaysia for them to win the famed intertertiary MTV world stage competition.

In 2009, he became part of the Heal the World initiative which saw them performing in front of a crowd of well over 7000 people. As a student at Limkokwing University, they were tasked to form the first Sound and Music academy which brought about the musical revolution that has become the pride of the institution. After touring with the fashion shows and recording the first solo pieces they had to part ways.

To keep his passion alive he uses his other God-given talent which is photography. He runs a lucrative brand called Bornaking Photography and funny enough some of his clients don't know about his musical career, the look on their faces is always the same when he reveals his other identity. It feels like he is Clark Kent. When it comes to his fans, he is still Taf... "I have never really considered myself to be a celebrity, I feel like our population is too small to try to live that kind of lifestyle," he said. The same people you meet on stage are the same people you're with in church and at shopping malls. Besides, he is a servant of humility.

In terms of sound, he comes across as different because he is not loyal to any

genre of music, he is willing and able to dabble across various types of music. During our chat with him, he told us that when it comes to collaborations, he wants to collaborate with everyone because making music isn't about status, he views music as a culture, a tradition that must be shared.

Tafadzwa says he wants to work with people and artists from all different wakes of the musical world. He writes all his music and in terms of genre, his primary sound is Afro, RNB with an acoustic soul fusion. He has also explored other genres like Hip-hop, House, Electro, Afro Pop, and dancehall and has written and performed a few ballads.

With access to the internet and YouTube, he has further developed from just an artist to an actual engineer. His fans are kept entertained online with an endless release of chart breaking singles and collaborations with amazing artists and producers. He will forever be grateful to his very supportive family who have never missed a single event nor radio/ TV performance and constantly urge him to push the passion.

Though his music is non-vulgar, he still has a parental advisory sticker on it because some of the lyrics are for a sensual adult audience, and it is made for radio. Concerning acknowledgments for his successes he indicated that it would be selfish of him to single out individuals because he says it takes a village to raise a child.

His journey as a musician is a mixed masala of influential passion farmers. His friends, both current and former have played major roles in whom and where he is today. If he could be open to working with any international artist he says it would be Frank Ocean because his music inspired part of his writing style.



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Bacon Parm Crackers

INGREDIENTS

1 package bacon strips, cut in half 32 Club Crackers 1/2 c. freshly grated Parmesan Freshly ground black pepper Ranch dressing, for dipping DIRECTIONS

FOR OVEN

Preheat oven to 350° and line a large baking sheet with parchment paper.

Arrange crackers on baking sheet and sprinkle with Parmesan. Tightly wrap each cracker with bacon and place seam-side down, then top with more Parmesan.

Bake until bacon is cooked through and bites are crispy, 45 to 48 minutes

Season with pepper and serve with ranch for dipping.

FOR AIR FRYER

Sprinkle crackers with Parmesan. Tightly wrap each cracker with bacon and place seam-side down on a baking sheet, top with more Parmesan.

Arrange crackers in basket of Air Fryer, working in single layer batches of 5 or 6, spaced at least ¼-inch apart, as necessary to not overcrowd basket. Cook at 350° until bacon is cooked through and bites are crispy, about 10 minutes, flipping halfway through.

Season with pepper and serve with ranch for dipping.














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his is one of the few places in Botswana where you would find a variety of wildlife and natural resources.

Animals are allowed roam freely in the sanctuary and this allows for a spectacular game viewing which is possible from your vehicle along the many roads in the Sanctuary. For safety reasons however one should remain in their vehicle at all times.

The sanctuary intend on bringing benefits to the community through tourism.

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DIY CHUNKY TASSEL BOOKMARKS

Materials:

- -scissors
- -cardboard
- -ruler
- -pencil
- -cardstock
- -Mod Podge
- -foam brush
- -hole puncher

STEPS:

STEP 1: Wrap yarn about 50 times around a piece of cardboard that's about 3.5 inches (8.89 cm) wide, then cut off the excess yarn.

STEP 2: Slide a piece of yarn under all the yarn wrapped around the cardboard, then double knot it at the top. Cut all the yarn on the opposite side, then tightly double knot a piece of yarn near the top to make the head of the tassel. Tightly double knot a piece of yarn underneath the previous piece of yarn and cut off all excess yarn and scraggly ends.

STEP 3: Measure and cut out a 4.5×6.5piece of cardstock. STEP 4: Fold the cardstock in half length-wise. Apply a thin layer of Mod Podge with a foam brush on the inside of the cardstock, then fold it back and let it dry.

STEP 5: Punch a hole at the top of the bookmark. Double knot the tassel through the hole and cut off the excess yarn. Source: homeyohmy









chest means working out the pectoral muscles, better known as the "pecs." While the pecs are the largest muscles in the chest, there are actually several smaller muscles that support the pectoral muscles, including the latissimus dorsi muscles (or "lats") on the sides of the chest and the trapezius muscle around the shoulders. Here's a look at some top exercises to build your strength and size while helping support your overall daily movement.

1.Barbell bench press

1. Position yourself on the bench with your feet

- firmly on the ground and your back flat (the bar should be directly over your eyes, and your head, shoulders, and buttocks should be on the bench).
- 2. Grasp the barbell with palms forward and thumbs wrapped around the bar. Move the bar into starting position, with help from a spotter if needed.
- 3. Position the bar over your chin or upper chest, keeping your elbows and wrists straight.
- 4. Inhale and lower the bar slowly until it touches your chest below your armpits. As you lower, flare your elbows out slightly.



2. Pec deck

- Keep your feet flat on the floor, at least shoulder-width apart.
- 2. With your back firmly against the seat, lift your arms until they reach shoulder level (the angle of your elbows should be between 75 and 90 degrees). Place your elbows on the center of the pad on the wings of the machine.
- With smooth and slow movement, push the wings together, stopping just before they touch.
- 4. Reverse to the starting position slowly.

Bent forward cable crossover

- Begin this exercise either with your feet planted hip-width apart, or with one in front of the other as if you are walking.
- Grasp the pulley handles with your arms straight out and facing inward, making sure that your hands are below your shoulders and your elbows are bent a bit.
- Make your movements slow and controlled no jerking — as you bring your hands together and extend your arms. For a wider arc and more resistance, move your arms down first and then in toward each other to cross one hand over the other.
- Bring your arms slowly back to the starting position with control. Don't let your arms go back past the shoulders.











Chest press

- 1. Adjust the chest press bench so that you sit with knees bent slightly and your feet on the floor.
- Grasp the handles, and exhale as you push them away until your arms are straight out. Keep your elbows slightly bent.
- 3. As you inhale, pull the bars toward you slowly and with control, without letting the weights touch down.

Dips

- 1. Grasp the parallel dip bars firmly and lift your body. Keep your elbows straight, your head in line with your trunk, and your wrists in line with your forearms.
- 2. Bring one leg across the other to stabilize the lower part of your body, and pull in your abs.
- 3. Exhale, and bend your elbows to lower your body. Keep your elbows near your sides. Your legs should be directly under your body to avoid tilting or swinging.
- 4. Lower yourself until your elbows are at a 90-degree angle and your upper arms are parallel with the floor. Keep your wrists straight.
- 5. Pause, and then straighten your elbows, pushing into the bars with your hands, and return to starting position. Keep your body vertical and your wrists straight.

Pushups

- Tighten your abdominals, keep your back flat, your neck in alignment with your spine, and keep your elbows close to your sides.
- 2. With your hands directly under your shoulders, lower yourself slowly and with control, lastly, press up.
- The only equipment you need is the mirror, where you can admire your newly toned chest!
