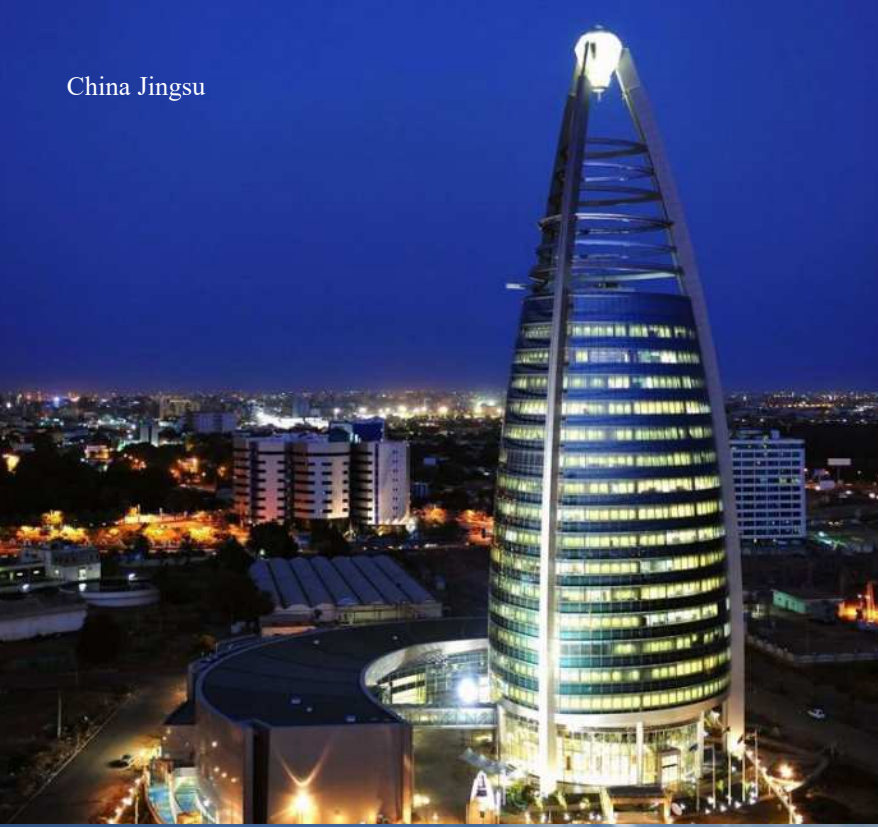

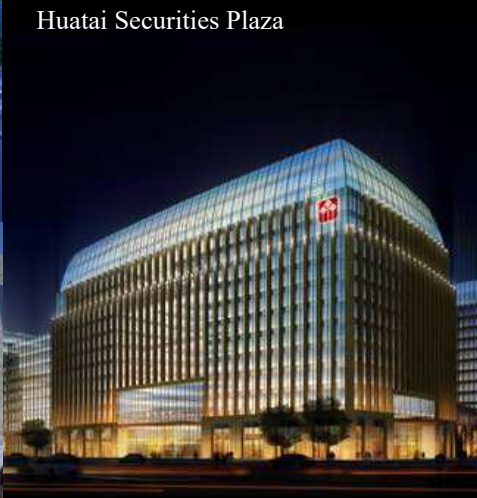

Letsweletse Speaks Out

This month CW magazine features one of the LGBTI members, Letsweletse Motshidiemang who came out to speak about his homosexuality as Motswana. In 2016 Letsweletse filed a petition against the government of Botswana regarding the Botswana Law Sections that he believed violated his right and freedom. This is what he had to share with our readers;

I realized that I was homosexual when I was about 12 years, when I couldn't make decisions at all so there is no how I could have made a decision to be gay.

My family knew about my sexuality before I could even tell them. I disclosed my sexuality after taking the government to court. I told them that I will need their support, especially my mother. When I told them about my sexuality they were not surprised or shocked because like I said they knew about it. They could tell from my young age that I was different from other children at home.

Although religion do not support homosexuality and as a homosexual man I truly have nothing against religion just because it discourages homosexuality. It's my feelings before religion and I am a Christian who believes in God, I hope that one day other Christians will accept us.

Letsweletse Vs The Government

I was only 21 years old when I decided to take the government to court, it was back in 2016. All I wanted was for my government to decriminalize homosexual acts in our country. The judgment was passed on the 11th of June 2019 which I won.

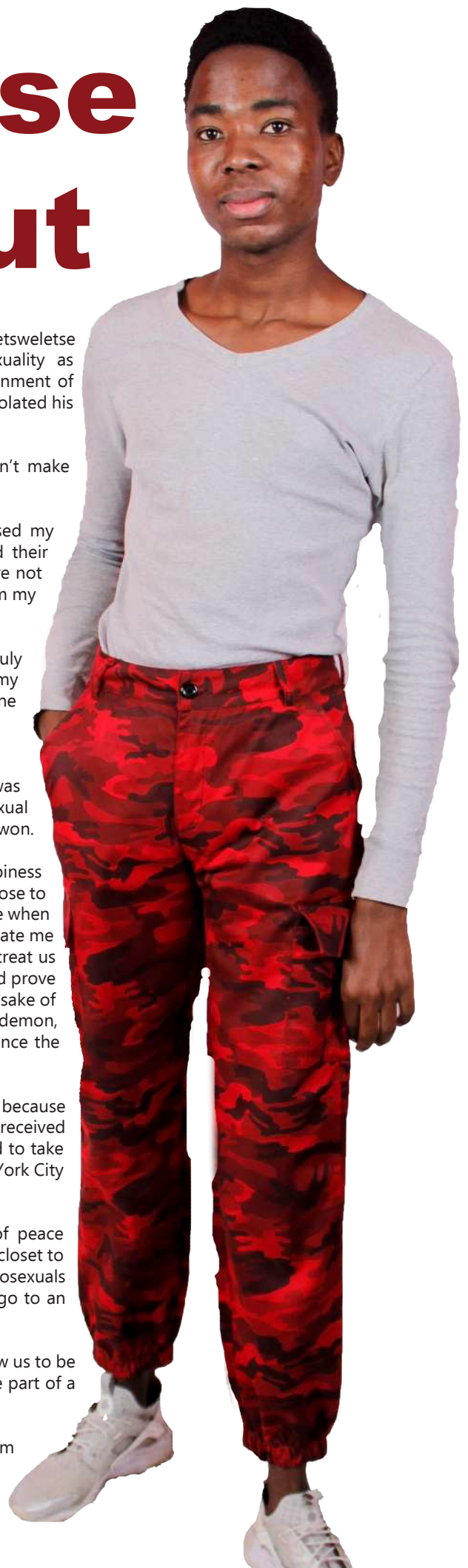
Discrimination is still a worry in our society but I do not allow that to ruin my happiness or even kill my joy for life. Therefore I try by all means to keep people who are close to me informed about homosexuality because people can only accept and tolerate when they understand how we feel as homosexuals. I have few friends who used to hate me but accepted me with time. So it is our responsibility to teach people how to treat us as homosexuals rather than being mad at them for discriminating us. We should prove to them that we need love through educating them about our sexuality for the sake of the coming generation of homosexuals because as much as people think it's a demon, they are still more homosexuals to be born and I don't want them to experience the very same challenges we went through even though it might not be easy.

The reason why I wanted our government to decriminalize homosexual acts is because of the love I had for myself and the LGBTI community. After winning the case I received invitations from other countries to speak about my experience when I decided to take the government to court. The invitation I have already honored was from New York City in October, 2019.

Our communities should treat us homosexuals with respect for the sake of peace amongst societies, not only that but also for other homosexuals who are in the closet to be free and have peace of mind. It will also stop depression because some homosexuals become unhealthy mentally when the society neglects them and some even go to an extent of committing suicide.

It is a good move that most churches accept us even though most of them allow us to be part of them hoping that we will change. It's a good thing to be allowed to be part of a certain church as a homosexual.

I will support the motion of LGBTI history to be taught in schools because I am pretty sure that students at villages don't know much about LGBTI. I grew up at a village and it is funny how I thought I was the only one who felt the way I felt about boys. Maybe it's because I was never taught about homosexuality. Teaching students about LGBTI is also important as it allows children to grow up to accept homosexuals.



Also, I support homosexual marriage because it will only allow us to have special bonds as homosexuals, and not just known for having sex without commitment or anything that officially make us partners when we are in love.

People should pour out their love to homosexuals, as well as albinos, mentally disturbed people, disabled people, e.t.c. Pouring out love will turn the world around positively. If we are to start talking about love the very same way we talk about HIV/AIDS, people will pay attention and will see the importance of it.

The LGBTI community is facing challenges that only us can solve. We need healthy minds and we have to be positive to overcome every challenge that comes into our way.

I have started a new project with the aim of teaching people how to love one another and to preach love to the world. As Homosexuals, it's important that we teach people how to love and treat us. Trust me; Preaching Love to the world will save the LGBTI community and the world in general. The moment we start claiming to be the only ones hated and expecting people to love us no one will pay attention, so let's start by encouraging people to love everyone. The world shouldn't change our focus as homosexuals, let's lead when it comes to love. People should see love in us. Let's not respond to their hate with hate. Why am I encouraging love? Because our brothers and sisters have committed suicide as a result of self hate. Let's scrap hate out of our minds and everything will fall in place.

We should not let people change our inner peace just because we are homosexuals. There are some homosexuals out there who still want to change to become heterosexuals because of hate and discrimination. All they need is love. Let's start pouring out love today.

Daniel on Touching Souls Through Gospel Music

Being raised in a strong Christian background has paved a way for Daniel Oletile's music career. His entire family is well known for their melodious voices when it comes to praising the Lord. This has motivated him to form a gospel music group called City Boys Gospel Choir. The Sefhare native is also the founder of Dano Music Productions, producer and a song writer. His voice has warmed many souls which made it easier for him to enhance his music career. He has won the Best Live Band Category on Presidential Competitions Awards in 2018.

Among the good Samaritans who helped him with his music career was the late Wilfred Khola, Jopi Tambona, Lucky Khuta and the late Oleseng's back-up vocalist Mpho Kgomosutu. He has recorded four albums with City Boys Gospel Choir between 2010 and 2016, which includes Hauhela, O mamele, The Best of City Boys Album. They consist of songs from previous albums as well as music videos. Moreover, he has two solo albums namely; Morwalela (released in 2016) and Ke Morena (released in 2019). The "Hauhela" album was recorded at D.N.C Studio in South Africa, the second album "O mamele" which was highly welcomed by local fans was recorded on 2017 at Galaxy studio in Gaborone. Dano Music Productions has organized more than six Gospel Shows country-wide, in which they shared stages with international artists such as Matlakala, Nkosana as well as Innocent Mxolisi. When it comes to song writing Daniel revealed that he writes songs based on his dreams, life experiences and spiritual incitements. He grew up looking up to the late Oleseng Shuping and learned a lot from him in terms of singing and portraying song messages.

Patience and humility are major qualities that have contributed a lot in Daniel's music journey. He highlighted in an interview that being a gospel musician is not an easy journey. "My duty as a gospel artist is to save souls through music". Therefore being a gospel artist requires spirit filled individual who trust and praises God no matter the situation. Gospel music is different from other music categories, it is mostly based on spiritual jurisdictions than money," he said. On the other hand he has pleaded with local gospel artists and groups across the country to unite and work together regardless of categories they offer. He pointed out that "There is a tendency among gospel world in which one category organizes their own shows and excludes others, for instance a case whereby the "tap and clap" gospel category has strictly tap and clap groups and artists performing in one show". Daniel said this has totally wiped out gospel bound in Botswana and believes only cooperation and unity can bring improvement in the gospel world. He is working on a new album to be released before end of this year. Currently Daniel is working with two bands namely, "The stream jazzcrew" and "The city of jazz crew".

Since he started his career as a DJ, Otshepilwe's family stood with him from day one of his hustle and he is grateful for that. "My family supports my hustle wholeheartedly because at some point they benefit from it. They always give words of encouragement pleasing me not to lose focus. They would sometimes attend my shows, Kang's finest in particular," he said. Gaforwe continued "I want to believe that I've impacted positively in the lives of people in Kang. KHOISAN BRINGS OUT THEIR DREAM



Their sound is a fusion of indigenous sounds found right in the heart of Southern Africa with a twist of the modern day sounds. It brings new sounds all people could relate and vibe to. They were recently featured by Raptured Roots in a single called "Mosalagae", a song that represents the beauty behind the sounds of the Khoi and the San people. The duo have been working together for more than a year and with all the work they put in, they anticipate more years of working together.

"Mosalagae" song was derived from the storyline of a couple experiencing 'trouble in paradise' where both lovers betrayed one another by cheating and in this case the girl justifies her acts by telling the guy he was never around for her.

We had a chance to have one on one with the duo which comprises of Thabang Rasefako and Oratile Kofa and this is what they shared;

You have been releasing hit songs lately with Roc Lefatshe Recording studio label; do you see yourselves parting ways with them in the near future?

We had joined Roc Lefatshe with no experience or exposure in the music industry, this benefitted us a lot as we had chance to learn things like stage presence, vocal presence and control.

Is there anything good you benefited from this lockdown??

Well, to be honest lockdown toned down the pressure in a sense that we had plenty of time to create and inflate our roster of content; we also created more music. So we are more content about what we have at the moment.

How has this impacted your line of work due to the coronavirus outbreak?

It really hit hard. We were used to always going around and being busy but that all stopped when the virus was discovered here in our country. That meant no shows, no more gatherings or any event. All that stopped when everything got closed down.

How are you coping now since shows were cancelled due to the pandemic?

It's a struggle, a very big one for that matter. Fortunately we have a leader that advises us to always stream our income into different money generating paths and it's something that we did though we are not as comfortable as before, but we are sure that we can still survive from what we saved.

What's your direction as a team, are you seeking money or fame?

We seek verification. Meaning we aim to overlap the continent and even the greater world with Setswana. We want people out there to know that there's a language called Setswana that fits perfectly in nice, well-constructed songs and still makes sense. Fame and prosperity, to us, is just an incentive you get for pursuing and doing what you love most. We do our work with love and most importantly, we believe in moving as a team.

What advice do you have for aspiring artists who want to form their own group?

Truth be told, It's going to be hard, it is different personalities, behaviours and so forth that come together to work on a mutual plan. So there is going to be arguments, fights, misunderstandings and all, but remember why you started and you better start for the right reasons too. If they are not as solid, you won't see the need to persist when things don't go your way. You better give each other time to express themselves, always fix every problem on time, get rid of all your differences and have each other's back.

How would you describe your development ever since you worked with Roc Lefatshe Records?

In short, it's been upward and forward only for a label that prioritizes your work and craft above everything, there's bound to be progress only. Before the pandemic we were already used to a life of big crowds and stages, we were used to road trips out of the city, but because of the 'new normal' we had to adjust to the digital stage. With the lock down we were able to complete our album and even perfect our craft. It's no secret that it's tough, but we have the digital world to lean on, we try by all means to get our music on every digital platform for people to enjoy. We were able to complete our album and got a chance to be featured by great artists from Africa on a song titled 'Phumelela'.

Being under one of the recognized managers and record Label, what does that mean to you?

It means a lot, it shows that we have a type of potential as he was able to identify and even

and music. But we would say the greatest achievement of all, is bringing our dream to reality. We are aspiring and the most celebrated duo in Botswana, to us, it beats anything we can ever earn because it shows dedication and hard work as well.

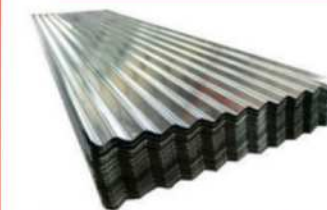

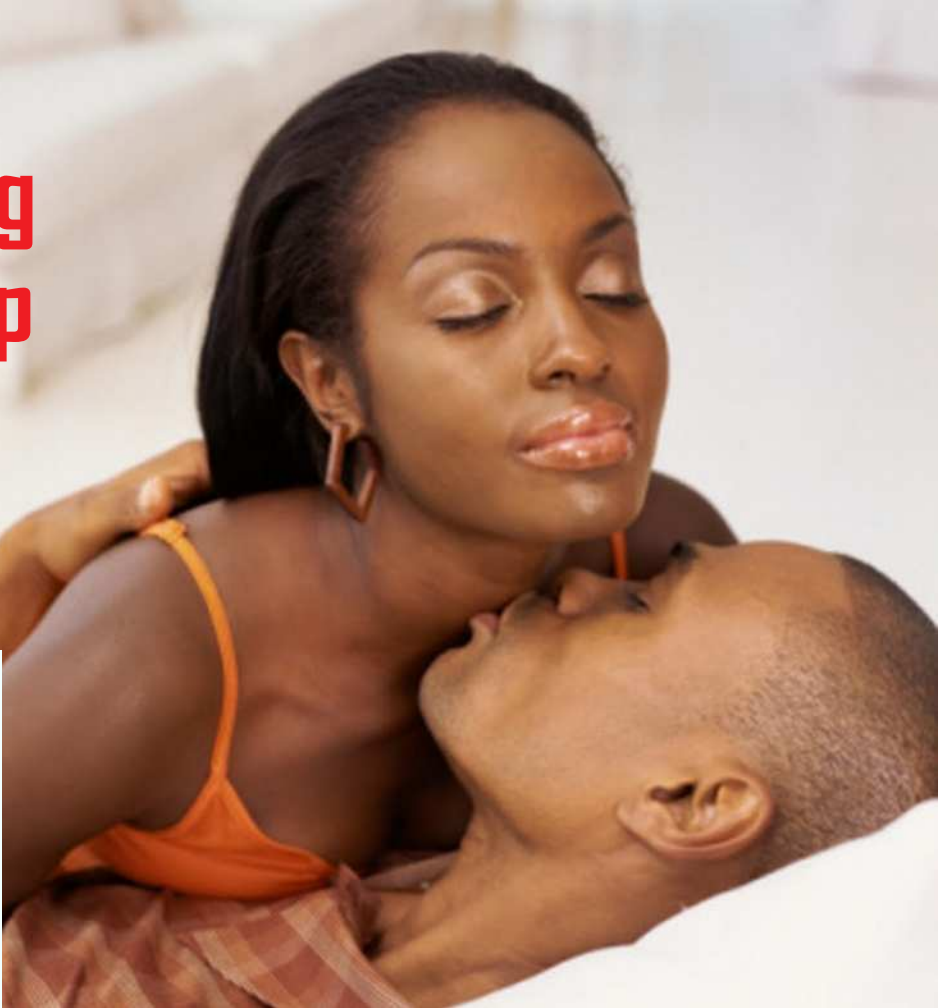

1. Baby eczema

Eczema is a dry, itchy skin condition that affects up to one in five children. It is most likely to appear for the first time before your child is five years old and almost half of cases start before six months.

If your baby has eczema, s/he will have areas of dry, itchy skin that can look red and cracked, and may even weep fluid or bleed. You're most likely to notice this on the creases around her elbows, knees, wrists and neck. However, eczema can appear on any part of her body, including her face.

There may be times when your baby doesn't have any symptoms at all, and times when her symptoms are more

noticeable. Most children who have eczema will grow out of the condition by the time they are in their teens.

Causes

Genes may play a role in causes of eczema. Most children have about a one in five chance of developing eczema, but if you or your partner has it, this rises to about three in five. If you and your partner both have eczema, your child has a four in five chance of developing it too.

Treatment

If you think your baby may have eczema, visit your doctor as early as possible. He can help you to find the right treatment for your little one, which will depend on how bad the condition is.

2. Allergies in babies

An allergy happens when your baby's immune system reacts to a substance that's usually harmless.

What are the symptoms of allergic reactions in babies?

If your baby has an allergic reaction, it will probably happen within a few minutes of contact with an allergen. Sometimes though, reactions can be more delayed, and take a few hours to develop.

The symptoms of an allergic reaction can be different depending on what your baby's allergic to. For example, a pollen allergy may be more likely to give your baby a runny nose, while a skin allergy may be more likely to cause a rash. In general though, the following can all be signs of an allergic reaction: red, watering, itchy eyes, a blocked or runny nose, or sneezing, wheezing, coughing or shortness of breath, a raised, itchy rash, dry, red or itchy skin, swollen face, lips, tongue or eyes, nausea, diarrhea or vomiting. All of these can also be symptoms of other illnesses, so they don't necessarily mean your little one has an allergy.

How are allergies diagnosed?

If you think your baby could have an allergy, take him to see the doctor.

Brioche Bun

Ingredients:

- Flour - 250gm
- Sugar- 25gm
- Salt - 5gm
- Dry yeast - 12 gm
- Egg- (1 piece +1 yolk)
- Milk powder- 25gm
- Butter - 75 gm
- Water - 75 ml
- Lemon zest - 1/2 teaspoon

Method of Preparation:

- 1) Collect and measure all ingredients. Sieve the flour and keep it aside. Prepare yeast sponge by using all of the yeast, some water and some flour together.
- 2) Combine all ingredients except butter in a mixing bowl.
- 3) Allow yeast sponge to disappear in the flour and add the melted butter. Develop until dough takes on a silky sheen.
- 4) Add lemon zest. Keep the dough in the fermentation cabinet for 30minutes or room temperature to ferment at temp 35°C and humidity 92%.
- 5) After proofing, scale dough into 50gm per unit. Make form.
- 6) Place the dough in an oil greased mould. Keep in proofing cabinet at 35°C for about 30minutes for final proof.
- 7) After proofing, preheat the oven. Bake at 180°C for 10-15 minutes. After baking, oil brush or butter brush.

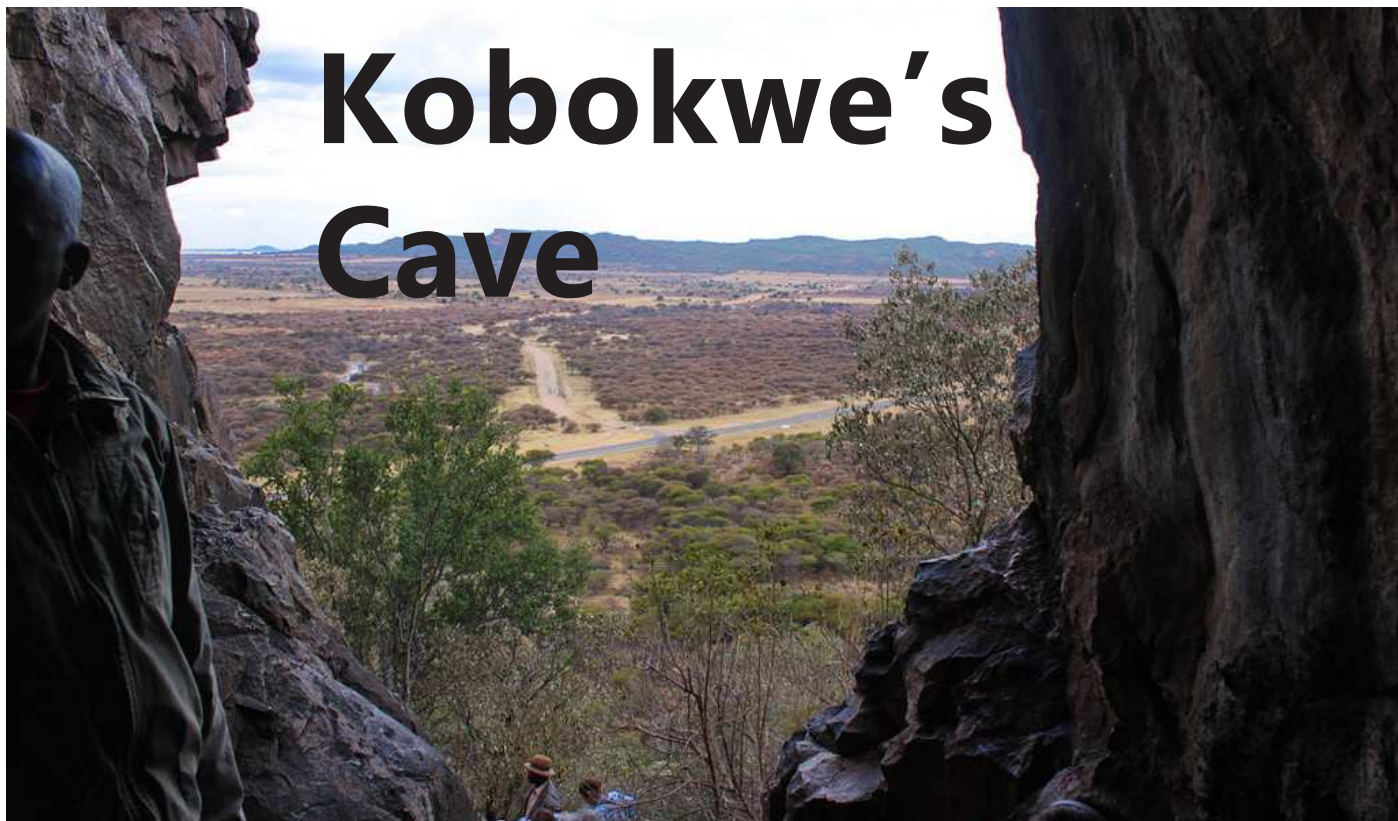

Kobokwe's Cave

The historic cave is both a symbol of superstition and black magic and inspired one of the early Christian converts in Botswana.

Kobokwe's Cave (Legaga la ga Kobokwe in Setswana) plays a dual role in the mythology of Botswana: It is both a foreboding symbol of superstition and black magic, but also as an essential part of the founding of Christianity in the country.

The cave is perched in the hills overlooking the village of Molepolole on the Thamaga Road. Local legend states that it was an execution site for practitioners of black magic, who were pushed off the execution rock nearby, though historians think this is unlikely.

So the story goes a witch named Kebokwe

was thrown from these rocks and used her magic to land unharmed. Since that time, dark spirits taking the form of giant snakes have haunted the cave and the surrounding hills. Regardless of its veracity, this legend was alive and well when David Livingstone, the famous physician, missionary, and explorer, arrived in Kolobeng in 1847. He convinced the Kgosi of the Bakwena, Sechele I, to convert to Christianity by spending a night in the cave to prove that the spirits could not harm him. After a restful night, Sechele became Livingstone's only convert to Christianity.

These days, the cave serves as a curiosity spot for tourists, and a pilgrimage for the faithful in Botswana. After turning off the highway, there is a 15 minute scramble up a well-used path to the cave. A Botswana Heritage sign marks the beginning of the path. The approach is littered with the remains of candles from midnight prayers, and the cave itself is rather small, but always cool with a breeze coming from deep in its chambers. From the nearby execution rocks, there is a view of the bush in the direction of Thamaga and Kanye.

Know Before You Go

Finally, there is a clearly-marked sign designating the cave and parking area. Driving from Gaborone, after arriving in Molepolole on the A12, turn left on the Thamaga Road (F11). Drive about five minutes. After leaving town, you will see the hills and the cave on your right. There is an orange sign labeled Kebokwe Cave pointing to your right. It's rather small, so you can also use the much larger sign for Moleps Poultry as a landmark. Almost immediately you will see a gravel parking area with a Botswana Heritage sign marking the beginning of the trail. From here it is about a 15-minute hike, with some scrambling at the top. If you have trouble finding the place, the locals of Molepolole will be more than happy to direct you. While you're in town, you should also check out the Kgosi Sechele I museum, which discusses the history of the Bakwena and the town, as well as the cave. It is housed in the colonial era police station, located right before the turn to the cave on A12. Ref: Atlas Obscura

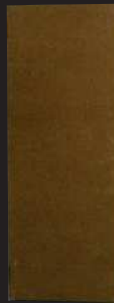

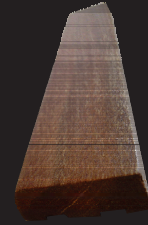
