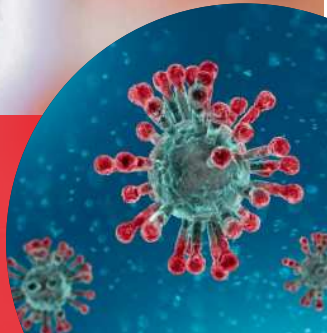

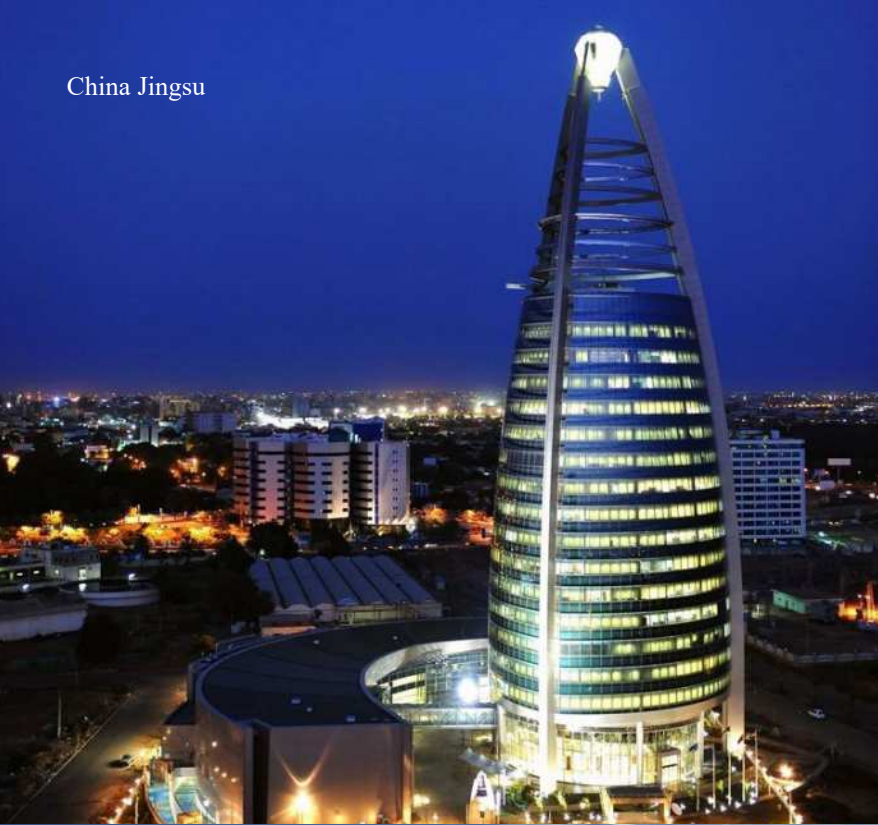

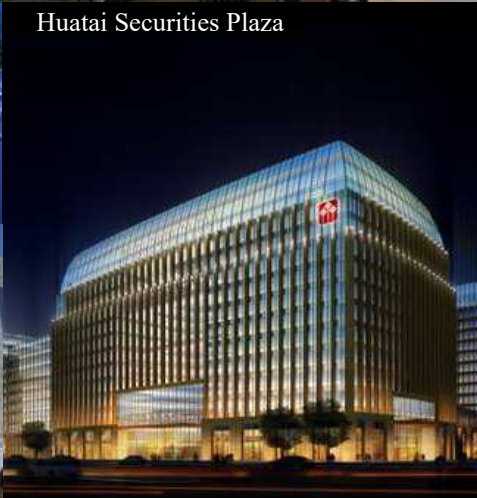

Baratwa Expresses Emotions Through Her Song Maikutlo

According to Baratwa music is a universal language that brings healing, peace, happiness to one and what other better way could there be to share messages of hope, love, faith and express what is inside of them. Baratwa Phuthego came with her third Dance hall single titled "Maikutlo" release in. She is a musician, actress, model and dancer from Latin dance to contemporary dance. Baratwa is a degree holder in Fine Arts Theatre from the University of Botswana (Performing arts).

1. When did you start music and what were your early influences?

I started singing at a young age and TV being my biggest influence because that's where I got to see super stars like Brenda Fassie and many more. Then like any other singer when you are young church is always the first place where you develop your talent of which I sang and also learned how to play an instrument, guitar. I started to do music professionally 2017 where I took it upon myself to learn everything about music through books and the internet

2. How many singles /albums do you have?

I have 3 singles which were all produced by Joe Luda from Joe Luda Music Production. My first single was a duet with Oba featuring D-Funk came out in 2018 then another single titled, "Mosadi Wa Gago" which was released in 2019.

3. Did you always know you will be here in music career?

Yes. Because music has always been part of my dream from a young age.

4. What do you do apart from music?

I am actually an Arts practitioner, volunteering at the University of Botswana under the Culture sports and recreation department where I learnt so much which contributes to my career as a musician. I have a dance company called Baratwa Dance Movement which focuses more on children's talent development by providing training for different kinds of dances. Our main focus being Latin dance (Ballroom Dance) and traditional Dance. I also do modelling of which my recent work is with ebony Hair Botswana of which I am one of the brand ambassadors.

4. How would you describe your own development as an artist?

The only way to develop for the better as an artist is to grow mentally, read and listen to personal development material.

5. What were some of the main challenges and goals when you starting as an artist and how have they changed over time?

My main challenge was I could not get access to music studios where I could do my work professionally due to lack of funds. My goal was simply to be able to do things in a professional manner knowing that as an artist I am also a brand.

6. What is your best motivation?

Do not go where the path may lead, go instead where there is no path and leave a trail by Ralph Adolph Emerson. "Those who hope in the Lord will renew their Strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint." Isaiah 40:31. That quote and that verse are my motivation. I always keep them in my mind in everything I do.



THE RISE OF DJ SKILLASH

DJ Skillash started disk jockeying back in 2009, where he was still at school. He was working with some of Digawana DJ's. He then came to Gaborone in 2013 where he meet various DJ's and artists who helped him to grow in music production.

Who is DJ Skillash?

Im from Digawana village in the Southern district of Botswana. My birth names are Thabo Loti. I am a producer, song writer and a DJ.

What motivated you to join the music industry?

I would say music has always been my passion. Nothing beats passion hence I follow what my heart wants. My music interest developed more after being inspired by DJ Kooly K and Noveshi, and I thank them for that.

Do you play one specific genre or you mix all genres?

I am more based on Amapiano, which is the most dominant genre in the music industry now. However I also do commercial house and deep house. In most cases it depends on what the occasion is all about for instance if it's a wedding I flow with afro pop, if it is a farewell party I flow with classics.

What other things are you specializing in apart from being a DJ?

I am also a professional graphic designer.

What can you say about the DJ industry in Botswana?

Being a DJ in Botswana is actually not easy; the competition is very high because there

are so many DJ's hence less opportunities to be successful. You will find out that there are some DJ's who actually charge lesser than you hence they get more bookings. For you to be recognized is when you actually charge your services below standard and this has affected our industry in a very bad way. I personally advice Botswana DJ's to unite and help each other grow; this spirit will make us to be recognized in other countries.

Have you collaborated with any local artist?

Yes, I have worked with Mod Erykah and Noveshi on a single called "Zakara" which was produced by Suffocate in 2014. I also produced another single titled "Di Doubts" with Coast and Yun Tornardo.

Any highlights of your career?

My biggest highlight is when I was performing at a Captive Eye event about Anti-Drug and alcohol abuse, held at Fairground Holdings. I was performing alongside the prominent DJ's in Botswana. To me it was a great achievement.

What is your next move?

I am looking to drop my second single featuring Mc K.OD from South Africa. I am actually aiming higher and intending to have my own studio to work with international artists.

It was not easy because sometimes he would skip school to perform in other schools.

Coast recorded his first song "Dikgang tsa divorce" featuring Lil Brown Tiger in 2013. His second album "Fine like this" which he featured Magdon from Nigeria was released in 2018. Recently he dropped yet another single "Di doubts" which was produced by DJ Skillash at Chain Gang Records. He is focusing mostly on Motswako, Afro Pop and Amapiano. Big L Wasekai is one of the people who inspires him; one person he sees as a role model. He described Big L Wasekai's music as unique and fashionable. The Serowe-born artist said apart from music he is also a softball player. His message to other artists is support each other and spread the spirit of love in order to make the music world a better place.

The young man says he is aiming to perform in international stages and collaborate with more local musicians. His vision is to take the music industry to another level. Moreover he believes that he is finally living the dream. As an upcoming artist Coast said he has encountered financial challenges, managing family time and music as well as finding slots in popular events. Currently he does not have a manager but he is willing to have one as time goes on. He said since he joined music at young age he received criticism from different individuals who believed that music will disturb his studies and his life in general. However he said he used those criticisms to gain more strength. "I am one person who believes that criticism makes you strong because you would want to show those against you that you can make it." he said. Furthermore he pleads with parents, friends and colleagues to support their loved ones to pursue what they like rather than criticizing them.

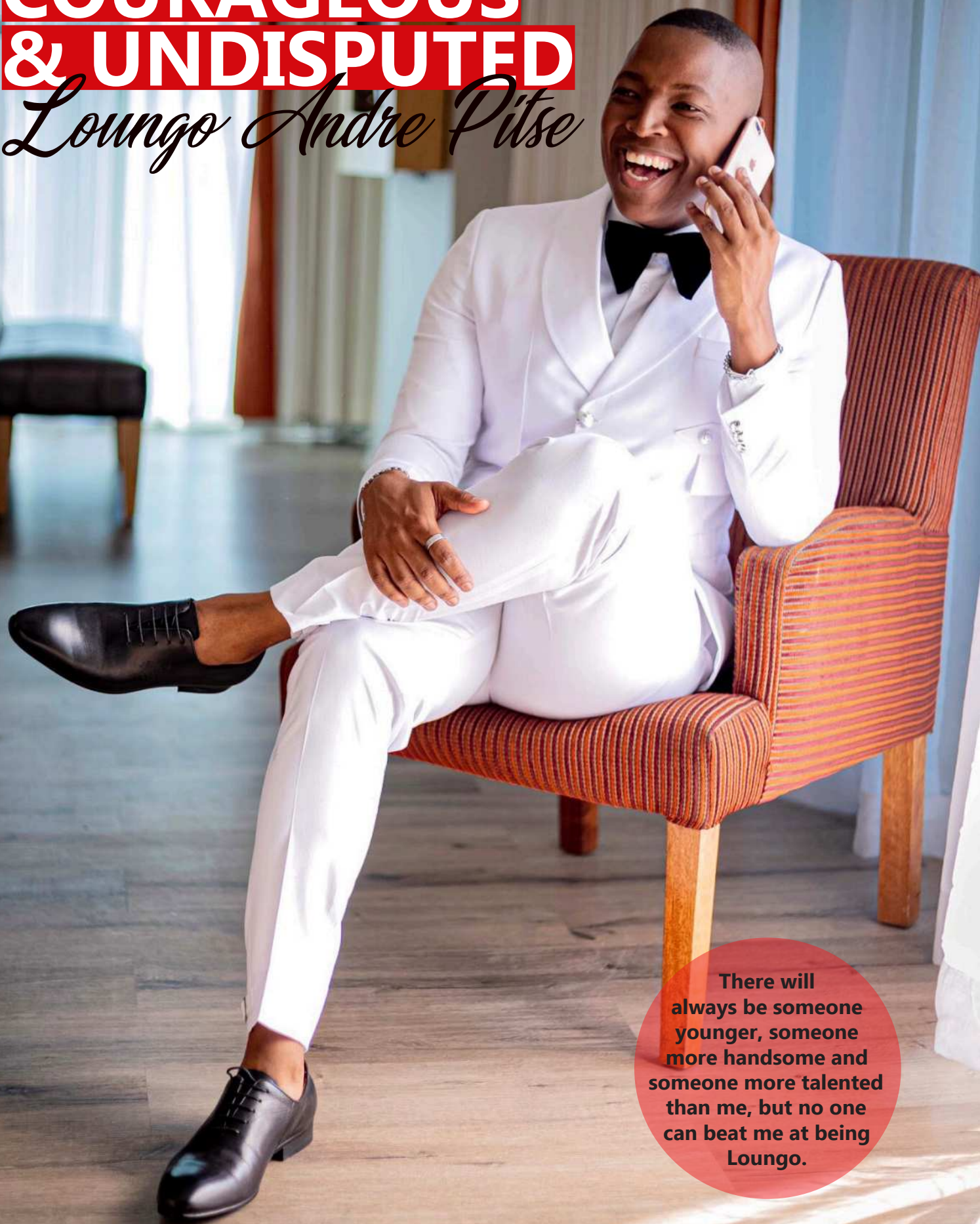

Last year the government brought Steve Harvey in an awakening attempt to motivate the arts and performance industry. What do you think still needs improvement in our country?

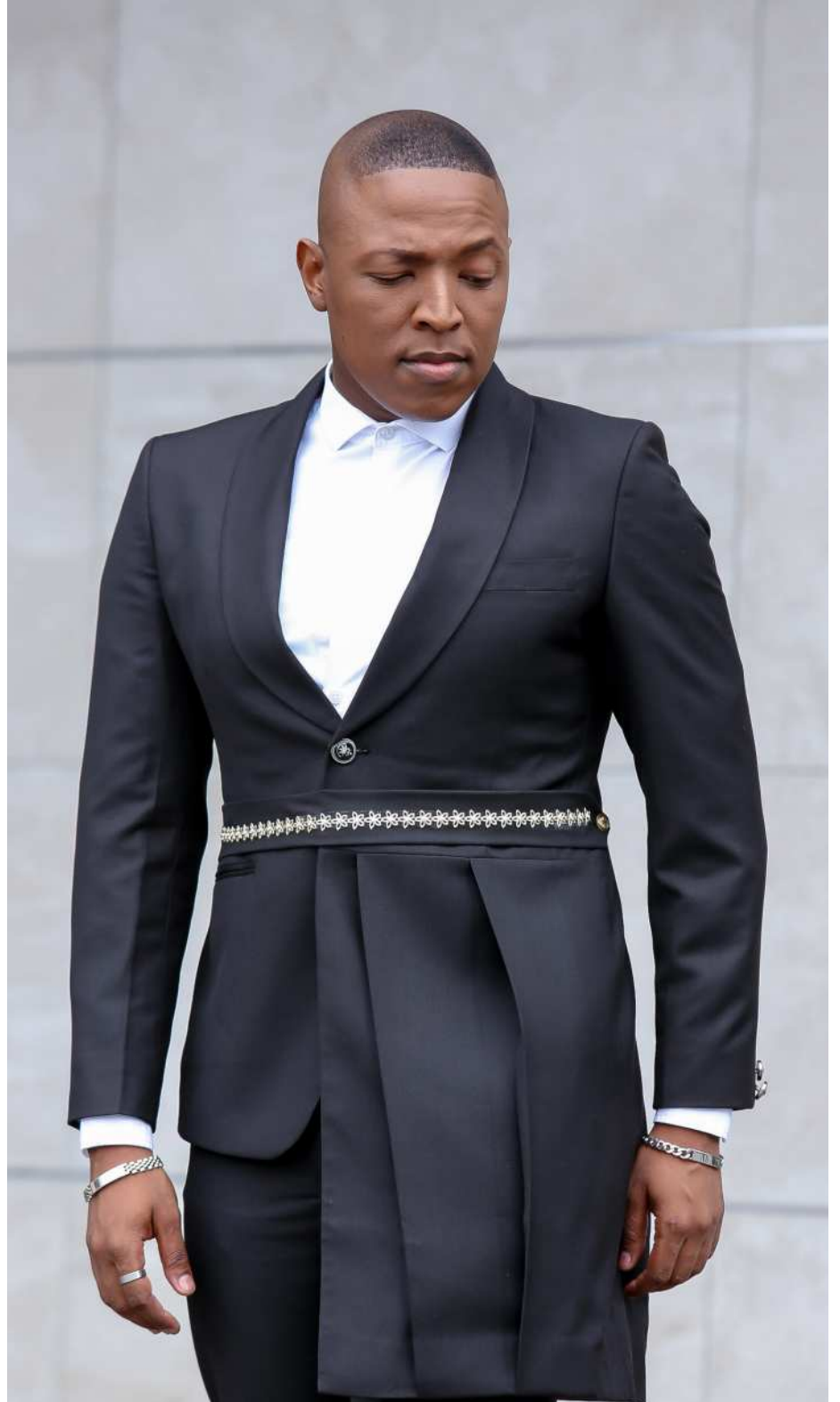

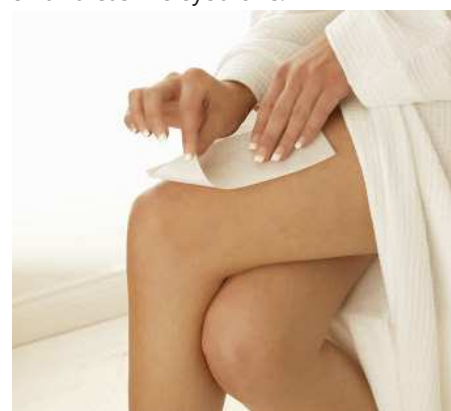

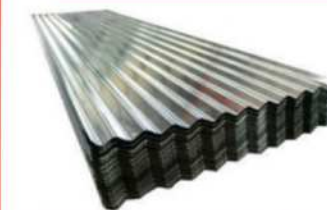

Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)

A Coronavirus is a virus that is found in animals and, rarely, can be transmitted from animals to humans and then spread person to person.

In addition to COVID-19, other human Coronaviruses have included:

- The MERS virus or Middle East respiratory syndrome.
- The SARS virus, or severe acute respiratory syndrome, which first occurred in the Guangdong province in southern China.

Symptoms of Coronavirus

COVID-19 symptoms range from mild to severe. It takes 2-14 days after exposure for symptoms to develop. They may include:

- fever
- cough
- shortness of breath

Those with weakened immune systems may develop more serious symptoms, like

pneumonia or bronchitis. You may never develop symptoms after being exposed to COVID-19. So far, most confirmed cases are in adults, but some children have been infected.

What causes Coronavirus infection?

Humans first get a Coronavirus from contact with animals. Then, it can spread from human to human. Health officials do not know what animal caused COVID-19.

The COVID-19 virus can be spread through contact with certain bodily fluids, such as droplets in a cough. It might also be caused by touching something an infected person has touched and then touching your hand to your mouth, nose, or eyes.

How is Coronavirus diagnosed?

If you believe you have COVID-19, you should contact your family doctor immediately. Before going to the doctor's office, call with your concerns. This will allow the office to collect information and offer you guidance on next steps. To

diagnose you, your doctor may run tests to rule out other common infections. In some cases, your doctor may suggest you self-isolate to prevent the spread of infection.

Can Coronavirus be prevented or avoided?

Try to avoid people who are sick or meeting in large groups. Stay home if you are sick.

Cover your cough with a tissue or cough into your upper sleeve or elbow. Do not cough into your hands.

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty. Avoid touching your mouth, nose, or eyes.

Answer: She fell off the bottom step.

Hopefully, riddles for kids that feature scary scenarios aren't stressful, but rather help them learn how to problem-solve. Sure, that ladder's really tall, but under what circumstances could a fall remain safe? Help your child talk through the options until they hit on the answer.

I am often following you and copying your every move. Yet you can never touch me or catch me. What am I?

Answer: A shadow
 This is a great riddle for kids when they're playing outside because you can demonstrate the answer if the lighting is right.

Grandpa went out for a walk and it started to rain. He didn't bring an umbrella or a hat. His clothes got soaked, but not a hair on his head was wet. How is this possible?

Answer: Grandpa was bald
 Situation or story riddles for kids help them focus on details and develop logic skills. You'll enjoy watching them problem-solving and helping them out.

Khama Rhino Sanctuary is tourism attractive place in Botswana situated on the main road between Serowe and Orapa. According to Wikipedia "It was established in 1992 to assist in saving the vanishing rhinoceros, restore the historic wildlife populations and provide economic benefits to the local Botswana community through tourism and the sustainable use of natural resources. Covering approximately 8585 hectares of Kalahari Sandveld, the sanctuary provides prime habitat for white and black rhinos as well as over 30 other animal species and more than 230 species of birds".

The place is well equipped with showers and toilets; you are assured of enjoying the stay at Khama Rhino Sanctuary.

The Sanctuary's roads are well-maintained, compared to other national parks in Botswana. This makes them suitable for self-drive game viewing in four and two-wheel drive vehicles. Guided game drives, rhino trails and nature walks can be booked and are supervised by well-trained and very knowledgeable rangers. Morning drives and night drives are available.

The camping and chalet facilities at Mokongwa Camp are a short drive from the entrance gate and are accessible without a 4x4 vehicle. There are rustic chalets which can accommodate four people. Each chalet has a toilet and shower in-

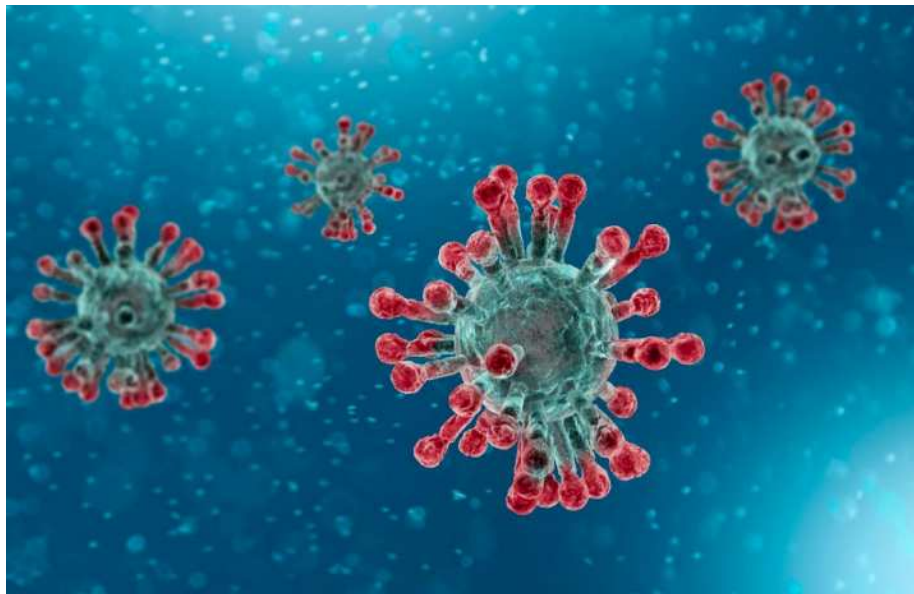

WHAT TO BUY FOR CORONAVIRUS PREPARATION, ACCORDING TO EXPERTS

As the Coronavirus continues to spread throughout the world and more people are being advised to self-isolate or to quarantine, people are advised to create a household plan in case there is an outbreak in their community. Keep in mind that while the virus is a serious health concern, it's important not to panic.

What you should do, however, is make some preparations. That means having basic essentials on hand such as food, medicine, and cleaning supplies. But being prepared does not mean stockpiling or hoarding. People should have sufficient quantities of household items and groceries in the event that they need to stay home.

Compiled here is a list of what to do and buy if you think you may be stuck at home due to the Coronavirus:

look for low-sodium versions, if you can find them.

Below are some items to use as a starting point for your shopping list, but keep in mind you should be buying foods you would normally eat:

Fruit and Vegetables such as:

- Canned fruit in water
- Frozen/dried fruits
- Canned vegetables Frozen vegetables (i.e, broccoli, cauliflower, asparagus)

Grains and Dairy such as:

- Whole wheat pasta or chickpea pasta
- Brown rice
- Ancient grains (i.e., quinoa, farro)
- Oats

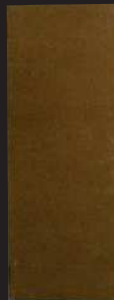

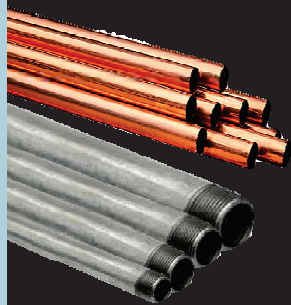

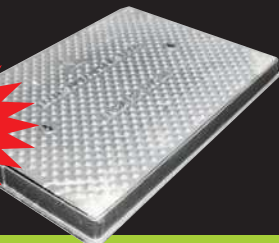

Below are some exercises by G-west Fitness squad ladies. One can do the exercises at the comfort of their homes using tires:

Tire (Box) Jumps

Lay your tire flat on its side like a box. Face the tire with your feet shoulder-width apart. Squat down slightly, as if you're going to jump straight into the air. Your arms will naturally swing backwards and return forward as you leap onto the tire. Both feet should land softly on the tire. While the tire has some give to it, landing too heavily can hurt your knees upon impact. Consider this practice.



Toe Touches

Stand facing the tire. Drive your left knee up and touch the tire with your toe. As your left knee drives up, your right arm will swing back, similar to a running stance. Return your left foot to the ground as you drive your right knee up, your left hand back, and your foot to the tire. Repeat. The key is to move as quickly and swiftly as possible. The lighter you tap the tire, the quicker you can switch feet.
