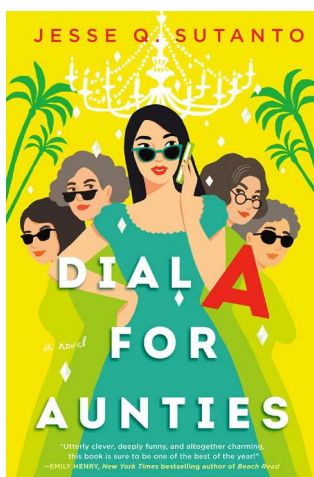

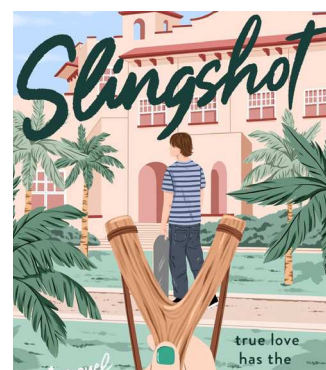

# “Seja Monna Ga se Mo Fetse,” Boitshwarelo Gobolotsemang

**W**e are leaving in a century where one would hardly see an aspiring writer be all about the Setswana language with everything becoming global, the writers aspire to keep up with the trends and stick to the global language, English. This is a whole different story for the young author, Boitshwarelo Gobolotsemang, a lad who chose to stick with the native language. As young as he is and of this generation, he uniquely chose to stick to being a Setswana novel writer.

The aspiring writer is aged 23 and originates from Eretsha. It is a village in the Northern

part of Botswana where he grew up and attended schools. He would later go on to pursue Broadcasting and Journalism at Limkokwing University, where he is currently studying. Boitshwarelo grew up with a passion for journalism. He began writing when he was still at secondary school and has been an author for over six years now. His first book is titled “Seja Monna Ga Se Mo Fetse”, which he wrote while still studying at Secondary school and the book finally made it into publication in 2020.

“Seja Monna Ga Se Mo Fetse” is based on the Setswana proverb which translates to tough times never last. The idea was to show that perseverance for those

that are going through hardships can be worthwhile and there will always be a better tomorrow. The book is meant to show that challenges and problems are just temporary. “I grew up as a journalist aspirer so when I started perusing it I chose to do so in Setswana unlike one would have expected for a young man like me, this is why I wrote this book in Setswana,” mentioned Boitshwarelo as he was talking about the book. He said writing in Setswana with him is just one of those things that you find yourself embarking upon as a path aligned to you by God.

Boitshwarelo also said that when he wrote the book he was inspired by his life and the way he grew up, mostly the life of his father as well. His father had a tough childhood and he would always tell them about the stories of his growth. These stories are the ones that led him into writing the book as they were quite emotional for him and he would express that through writing. He would go on to commit to writing a book that would be inspirational for everyone going through challenges and hard times. The inspiration was also beefed by the fact that he was also in love with writing and aspiring to pursue journalism, having grown in a society where they hardly accessed other newspapers or magazines apart from the Daily newspaper. To him, writing was to train himself for the time he started to pursue journalism professionally.

In talking about the book’s distribution, Boitshwarelo says its distribution has been running slowly as it was released in such a tough time of the Coronavirus pandemic. He said he is currently in talks with many bookshop managers to buy and sell the book. However, in February he received requests for the book from Mafikeng but currently in Botswana he has been selling it himself. When asked about having plans to approach the government for talks to have the book being used as part of the school syllabus, Boitshwarelo said that when he started writing the book, his focus was mainly students and he wanted to have talks with the government, but as for now he had not due to the pandemic situation. He said he feels the book would be good for the Setswana syllabus.

Writing the book was a challenge for him and took him a lot of time to finish it as he started writing the book during his secondary schools days when he also had to focus on the final examinations. However, he never gave up on the mission and finished up the book. It took him time to publish it, but says he is grateful as many have also been receptive of the book. At the moment Boitshwarelo is working on the new content. He advises aspiring writers to believe in themselves and work hard on their ideas.

# Lady Gee Releases

## Hosana

**A** gospel artist and music promoter, Gaone Selebo aka Lady Gee who grew up with the love of singing is expected to release her new album before end of this month (April). The album is called Hosana and it comprises afro gospel music with eight tracks. It was produced by MSquared and its video is currently out as it already plays on Botswana Television, local radio stations and social media.

The versatile Lady Gee also owns a promotion company called Lady Gee Promotions. Lady Gee who grew up with a good heart and a helping hand, came with a concept of the company which started last year in September with the aim of promoting local artists and helping them realize their dreams. At present, the company has nine local and international artists who she promotes with different genres, including one author, a TV presenter and an actress. The Shoshong native is also an event organizer and she organizes local events such as Annual Gospel Awards which was formed by Mr Joel Keitumele and Mr Bafana Pheto; and Glitz Awards formed by Mr Nkgopolang Tlhomelang. Glitz Awards was launched in March 2020. She is also a committee member of Glitz Awards and organizing team member of Annual Gospel Awards. They host music shows every year and invite some local and international artists to perform at the shows. The last music show was held in 2019 but due to the covid-19, they did not hold any show last year and hopefully this year around August they will succeed.

Lady Gee started out as a backup vocalist for other artists until she released her first single in 2017 called Re tla Thaba. She does singing as a passion and it's a gift she was born with. She has so far shared the stage with international artists like Benjamin Dube. Lady Gee grew up loving music and involved in it to extend that she quit her job in 2005 to focus on producing her own music.

Her vital goal is to become a renowned artist who can feature international artists and be featured as well.

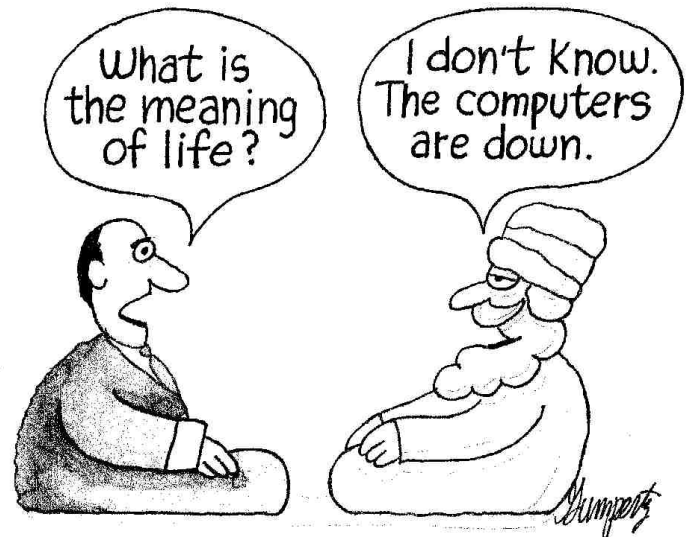

# Elon Musk Officially Name Technoking Of Tesla

**E**lon Musk is not your typical CEO. He has a new title now to prove it. Tesla disclosed that Musk is adding the title of "Technoking of Tesla." It also said that Chief Financial Officer Zach Kirkhorn had taken on the title of "Master of Coin" and each executive will keep his more standard title as well.

Musk once had the title of chairman of Tesla, but he was stripped of that title in 2018 in a settlement with the SEC over deceptive tweets he sent out. He had said that "funding secured" to take Tesla private at \$420 a share, when, in fact,

he had only had discussions, not a firm agreement, on such funding with a Saudi sovereign wealth fund.

The SEC originally sought to strip him of his CEO title, but settled for having him pay a \$20 million fine and give up the chairman title instead, a position now held by Robyn Denholm.

The bizarre title changes overshadowed a separate filing, which disclosed that Jerome Guillen, who has been president of Tesla's automotive division, "transitioned" last week to president of Tesla heavy truck.

The electric-car maker did not elaborate on the reasons for the cryptic new titles in a pair of the statements they gave out. Last month, Tesla also revealed it had purchased \$1.5 billion of bitcoin and would soon accept it as a form of payment for cars, sending the price of the world's most popular cryptocurrency soaring. Musk's recent promotion of dogecoin on Twitter has also lifted the price of that cryptocurrency.

Bitcoin hit new highs of near \$62,000 over the weekend but retreated around 5% early in the European day on Monday.

# The Music Industry Plays A Big Role In Our Lives - DJ Split



**T**habo Schele who is affectionately known as DJ Split is a House DJ based in Gaborone. The artist has been a DJ since 2012 and has played at various events and clubs such as Lagos and Trekkers. The Orapa native has lived most of his life in Gaborone. The young artist has released many singles of which always get airplay on local radio stations. He said in the interview that he is currently working on a new single, "Phusha Vakente" which features Gimaro Miles and Thintee. He also got to share his opinions about the local music industry in his interview with CW.

**You are a DJ, what led you to that path?**

Music has always been in me ever since. In a way it helps me to forget all the problems of life and keeps me happy. I used to listen to music years back around 2011 but then on the way I was inspired by few DJs from South Africa named "DJ Kent & DJ Crystal" as they played along with songs through mixing. This therefore opened my eyes inspired me to also know and teach myself

more on how to mix songs in 2014. I was a fast learner, so I was able to do well and I was now ready to share what I did to the world. On the other hand, it was a tough journey as I did not get enough exposure but I did not quit, rather I pushed hard. Having the love for music is the reason that led me to become a DJ.

**How long have you been a DJ?**

Referring back to when I started, I have been a DJ for about nine years now.

**So as a musician do you only do Deejaying?**

I'm not only focused on Deejaying but I am also a House Music Producer. At this point, I'm now able to make my own songs and to mention more. I am working on my new single to be released soon which is titled "Phusha Vakente" featuring Gimaro Miles and Thintee.

**Being an artist always requires some form of inspiration to your works, what is yours?**

Deejaying skills in terms of mixing and also being able to see people enjoy ones

work on stage through dancing helps me to learn more and come up with different ways to become different from other artists.

**What do you love about being a DJ?**

Deejaying is one thing I love especially at events, night clubs but basically where there is a crowd as I will be able to serve people with good music for them to dance. Seeing people smile and enjoying themselves dancing to the music I play makes me happier.

**Who is your inspiration?**

At this point, I am inspired by some international DJs such as DJ Shimza & Black Coffee just to mention a few. They are the ones that help me to work hard.

**So let's talk about your music, how is it currently doing out there?**

My music is currently doing well and yes, it is being well received as a lot of people are able to listen and download my music mixes and single releases through social media, local radio stations and other platforms.

**Do you have an adequate fan base?**

**What are your achievements?**

With all the hard work I have been putting, I am able to be booked to play at big events and also to produce instrumentals for other artists around Botswana. This is a great achievement as it shows that people are able to hear my music locally and internationally.

**Since things changed due to the COVID 19, how have you been selling your music?**

COVID-19 has affected us, now it is tough to DJ or perform released singles at events as the entertainment industry has been affected too. In this way, I use digital platforms such as Spotify and more to earn from my music.

**Are you profiting as adequately as before?**

Due to COVID-19, I have been affected as an artist, because events and night clubs are closed therefore I am not making profit like before.

**You are a musician, what is your opinion on how things should be done to get the music industry operational once again?**

The music industry has a positive impact on people which include event organizers and also artists including DJs/performers

in a way that it helps to put food on the table. Some people are unemployed and therefore have attained on having degrees. If at all the music industry is not put back, it brings along negative impacts to people as they will suffer due to lack of money. On the other hand, I understand that COVID-19 is also present and implementation of rules to protect people from the pandemic should be present to make sure that event organizers comply with the COVID-19 rules.

Another point is that to my own understanding, I think night clubs should also be opened as it does not occupy a large number of people comparing to big events that could be made at national stadiums.

**Would you say the music industry has any role in the economy of the country?**

Yes! The music industry plays an important role to the economy as it helps to bring entertainment and helps people to be able to generate money for them to put food on the table.

**The quality of music in Botswana has been improving regardless of the situation at hand, had the COVID 19 not been there do you think our industry would have been somewhere far ahead in terms of quality content?**

Quality contents could have been far because reflecting to today's situation that COVID-19 has affected the music industry, artists now struggle to produce good quality content as some artists only depend on getting income through

bookings to perform at events, night clubs and more. Therefore they are unable to have enough money to invest on their music in terms of making music videos for their music and more.

**What can you say to fellow musicians?**

Music yes, is another way that one can make money through but I just want to let people know that engaging through music is not that simple because one needs to go through a lot as they may take a long time to get exposure and that they should have passion for music.

# Ndinaye Chengeta

## *The Go-Getter*



Celebrity World caught up with an ambitious and passionate local business man, Mr Ndinaye Changeta who owns Youth Development Farm (YDF) that lies between Molepolole and Thebephatshwa. The former teacher came up with the YDF initiatives in 2020 to help Batswana who wish to venture into farming.

Ndinaye Chengeta is a former teacher of English and Guidance & Counselling. When interviewed, he said, from the time he quit teaching, he realised that a lot of people were not doing enough in terms of molding the younger generation in Botswana. After six years of teaching he decided to set a record so that he could show people what he believes the world should be like, that's when he realised that the industry was already congested and it required that the kids he was teaching needed to be inovative for them to fit in today's world. So in venturing out, he decided to take multiple risks in venturing in areas he has never done before. At that period he had already started to run a popular bar and a club

in Molepolole where he worked as a self taught deejay (DJ) and at some point someone approached him looking for a videographer and a DJ. As a risk taker he took that risk and covered the wedding of which the client was happy about it, that's how Changeta's Productions started.

He then came to Gaborone in order to try his luck with top dogs. His first business was in Commerce Park and he was running a popular modelling agency called CEP Super Models. He launched it and it was very competative with other modelling agencies but then he realised that it could not give him a future because he was more ambitious than that modelling agency. He then decided to run an airtime credit service which is what in the here and now Mascom, Orange and BeMobile calls for top ups "Nzamela", he started that. Then the problem came in when they were supposed to be paid and the type of contracts that they had signed were against them, so they liquidated and he had to start business from scratch.

Chengeta said he was lucky because during that time he met Norman Moloji during the time he was shooting Thokolosi part 2 and he asked him to allow him to be part of the project which he now learnt through film production. After Thokolosi aired, he became recognised by Botswana Television, that's why he decided to make a proposal to film the first movie in the country which was called Four Thirty. After shooting the movie it went international and Chengeta took the platform to be able to grow his film production company. That is when he invited Makgabaneng and government offices to showcase his work at the Capital Cinema. He then wrote a proposal for Makgabaneng TV program which was against the radio drama and they asked him to bring a sample. They went to American World Bank and they were funded with about 7 million through NACA. Unfortunately for them, when the money arrived it was supposed to be dispersed through NACA, so instead of getting a direct procurement they had to go through tender process. Chengeta said he tendered like everybody else,



fortunately he had the product whilst others had only the samples and he won the tender. Four months along the line when they were supposed to be paid for production they were told that the tender should have lasted for 3 weeks, so they lost it. They had to re-tender and they won again since they came back with more episodes. They shot Makgabaneng and managed to make 52 episodes, that's his journey into film.

With the above said, on his Youth Development Farm initiatives, Chengeta said after filming Makgabaneng which was then called Mareledi on TV he realised that the film industry was not competitive and was very slow. He also came to realize that the approach towards it was going to get them in trouble, therefore he decided to take his money and ventured in the YDF initiatives. Chengeta said with that money, he bought a farm between Molepolole and Thebephatshwa and when he purchased it, his plan was to revolutionize the farming industry. He therefore made a promise that he will help the youth of the country

by the time he quit teaching. He made an assessment to say the government spend a lot of money sponsoring the youth and the Ministry of Youth Sport and Culture spends huge budgets per year to fund youths in order to start projects. Fortunately, for Chengeta during the last lockdown, he came to realise that the country was now in trouble and there was no money so it called for him to jump start what he had been planning for the past years and protect the government funds as well as to help the youth. Chengeta then speeded up the motion in order to create facilities in the same farm that he purchased. He had to make sure that the farm had to accommodate as many people as possible and in doing so, he launched the initiatives.

According to Chengeta, the first initiative is called The Goat Initiative, what happens here is, he provides the kraals, water and labour to the youth who form groups of twenty in order to utilize the facilities. He said the other initiative is The Poultry Initiative, just like with the goat initiative,

where he provides the youth with units, water and labour. The other one is the sheep initiative and it follows the same methodology as the goats. He said at the moment, he has around 600 members in the goat initiative, 1000 members in the poultry initiative and 1000 members in the sheep initiative, so in total he has 2600 members in these initiatives and still growing. To date Chengeta is joined by the Ministry of Agriculture which generally supervises the intire projects and makes sure that the projects runs well without experiencing high mortality. Their duty is to commercialise the products that they are producing.

Also, they are supported by the Ministry of Trade and Industry and their job is to find the market for their products as well as to guide and assist in terms of skills share and mainly assist members in registering their incorporatives. He added that they have the Ministry of Youth, Sport and Culture and their target is for the ministry to fund the youth to utilize the farm and make sure that their projects are protected for the whole year in the incubation format so that the government money is used correctly whilst projects are being protected.

When asked to break it down on the process of contribution by the members, Chengeta said, "What happens is that all our members for the goat initiative were contributing P3000. Out of that money they were put into groups of 20, which means each group utilize a figure of P60 000 and out of that P30 000 is utilized for purchasing of goats. In issue of sheep, P30 000 is used to purchase the sheep, P18 000 is used by the groups to buy the feeds whilst the P12 000 is utilised to pay for the labours at the rate of P1000 per month, so by the time we are done we are at zero balance. For the poultry is the same process again, they pay P2 500 for the whole three months and their groups make a total of P50 000. Out of that P9 000 is used to buy the layers while P29 000 is used to buy feeds, whereas P12 000 is used for labour at the cost of P1000 per month and we reach zero balance again." Initially these initiatives were formed for the youth, now other parents are joining to supervise their children. Retired people who are interested and have too much ample time are also catered for.

Talking about his benefits on the initiatives, Chengeta mentioned that he usually doesn't disclose how he benefits because the project is far from the beginning and where they are now they are just beginning and what he benefits is at the far end because this project was built on a platform of credibility to do business at a larger scale with the government of Botswana and that is where his money lies. On the mission, vision and goals of the

initiatives, Chengeta stated that they are far from launching the farm and it will be launched once all the projects are active. He said their idea is to be able to draw in embassies from other countries that is to be able to buy into this methodology for their own youth in their countries. He also said, in short, their products' vision in the end is to provide food security and contribute to the supply chain in the country. "We produce a lot of food more especially in egg production. I want us to become a hub for small stock and be able to supply big numbers to other countries. I also want to give foreigners in our country a competition, so I want to break a norm that no Motswana can do it and succeed even without much knowledge. I am a true living testimony that I didn't go to school to engage in film production, DJ and farming but I still persuaded them," he added.

Challenges are there for everyone to tackle, and just like any other business person, Chengeta encountered some challenges since the inception of the project. He said in social media, attacks are the biggest challenges that he has ever come across, adding that these pages could be a platform that can be used for good but they are being misused. He also said formulation of stories that are unverified find their way through those pages and therefore he strongly believes that these platforms need to be monitored closely and should be platforms that could be used for good and not bad. "As I expand in that, social media through the groups formed can make or break a product. Another challenge is trust, a lot of people have cheated others and it's very fortunate that I am the type of person that I am since I have built credibility in what I did," he said.

About having sponsors for the initiatives, Mr Chengeta said he doesn't have any stakeholders nor sponsors. He also said he uses his own money, and has built those structure with no one's help, adding that there is only one gentleman to have helped him to excavate a dam. Other than that he has paid for everything in that farm.

Chengeta is happy that as a family he is able to manage his time for business, family and other errands. He further acknowledged the fact that he married a

military wife because she is disciplined, therefore he doesn't monitor her because he prefers that they both live their own lives and do the things they like. Therefore, when they get home that happiness is still there and more importantly they will unite it to their child. He said, "Most of the time I am very busy and also my wife is, so I utilise the time when she is not around to put pressure in everything that is required from me so that when my wife is around I have to be around too. I also utilize the times when she and our kid are asleep to really push business. My duty is to make sure that my wife doesn't realise that I don't exist nor my kid, I always have to make sure that I am there throughout."

The project's aim is to expand to many Batswana across the whole country. They are going to expand and have already got an initiative that is purchasing and selling of land. He said they are not only going to focus on farming but his vision is to self contain the country. "I can only sell the concept to other countries not expanding my business to them, he added."

As a responsible citizen of Botswana, Chengeta has shown his helping hand by giving back to the community. According to him, in December people in the village come to the farm to have free meals then they move around donating clothes. He said there is an issue of employment again, the welfare in Molepolole village and shortage of water, so he supplies almost the whole village with water from the farm. This versatile man, is also a counsellor by profession, he therefore counsel people for free on social media and all these shows that he has changed a lot of peoples' lives.

Mr Chengeta advises other emerging entrepreneurs by saying, "When you have an idea don't try to fine-tune it, just start and don't think too much about it because when you start there are dynamics that keep into place but if you are going to sit on an idea and you do not implement, you will not succeed. Most importantly have faith, look into me, who would have thought that the government will step in my idea?"



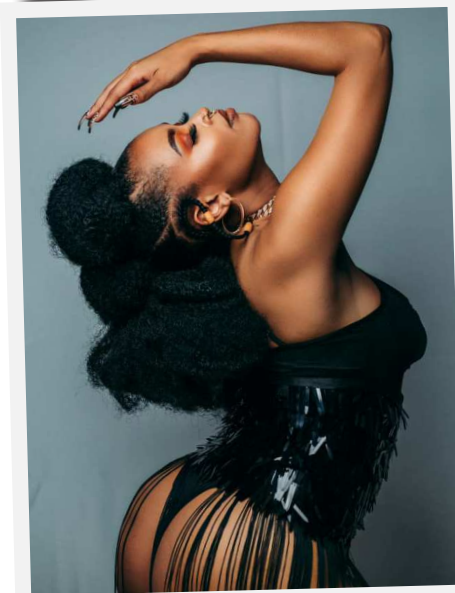
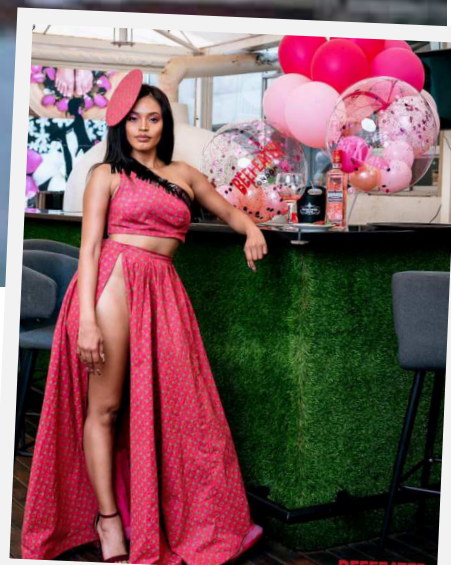

# Best Trees For Indoor Use



**Rubber Tree** – this plant can grow to a height of about 10m, however as a house plant it should be small. This plant can tolerate direct bright sunlight. It is advisable to keep it out of children's reach as it is poisonous consumed.

**Dragon tree** - they prefer bright indirect light, though they can adjust to medium to low levels of light. Make sure that you keep them out of harsh direct sunlight because too much of it can burn their leaves. Avoid overwatering them, watering them once a week is usually advisable.

**Schefflera Tree** – this plant acts as a natural air freshener and detoxifier. Schefflera leaves release oxygen but they also absorb pollutants from the air. This plant is toxic to pets, like cats and dogs.

**Guiana chestnut tree** – Whether indoors or out, the Guiana chestnut tree likes consistent watering with good drainage. When choosing an indoor location for this tree, consider the fact that it grows in full sun to partial shade and also grows well in bright but indirect light indoors.

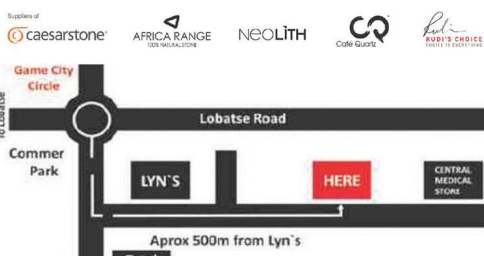
**Norfolk pine tree** – this tree prefers bright light. To stimulate its faster growth, move it outdoors to a shaded or partially shaded spot during the summer season. Water it every one to two weeks and allow the soil to dry out between waterings. Norfolk pine tree prefers average room temperatures and hate cold or hot drafts when grown indoors.

**Lemon tree** – heights for indoor lemon tree is 3 to 5 feet. This plant requires slightly water drainage. Remember, lemon trees like plenty of water, so once a week, deeply water your indoor lemon tree.

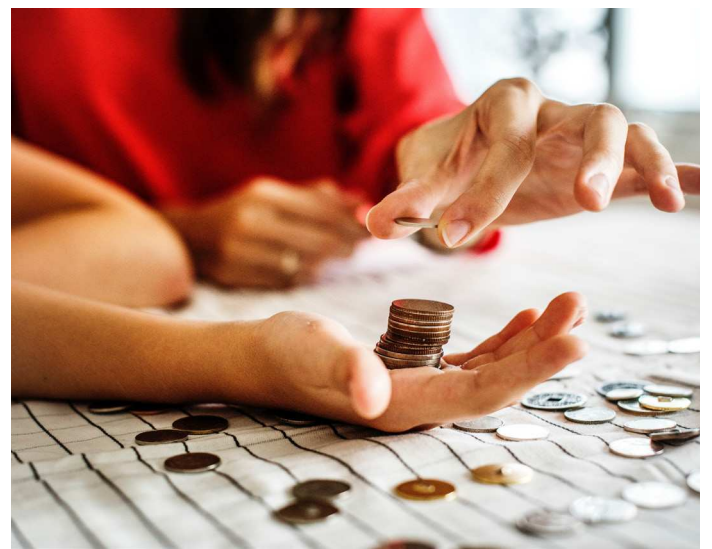

# BOTSWANA'S TOURISM AMID THE COVID 19



In 2020 the world was hard hit by the COVID-19 pandemic and it saw many of national economies crumble to the ground. The sectors that many countries including Botswana relied upon economically were hard hit to the extent that they went on complete shut-down. In Botswana tourism has for many years always been the biggest sector of economy and has always been part of the country's economic development. When the pandemic hit last year in 2020, it majorly affected the industry in many ways. It went on full shut down although locally the industry did later on try to get back up, it has not been easy.

The hospitality and tourism industry in Botswana has already suffered substantial losses of business and value with hotels operating at 10% capacity. Most of the citizens guest houses and campsites have closed because of limited business. But since the festive season they have been trying to get operational with safer ways that do not go against the COVID-19 regulations. These are strict regulations which go against the ways hotels and guesthouses function making

them not efficient enough. With guesthouses, there has been a light of hope as they can operate solely due to the fact that they mostly provide sleeping accommodation to mostly local citizens who would be in business trips or weekend or night getaways.

Botswana's tourism mostly relies on foreign tourists who come from all ends of the world for its vast safaris and wildlife. Most of its revenues are international, every year thousands of tourists pay big money to enjoy the beauty of nature that Botswana offers. When the coronavirus hit, it restricted international travels hence a major loss for Botswana's tourism.

According to a survey made by SafariBookings.com, the African Safaris Industry which makes billions of US Dollars has seen a major decline since last year and even since this year began. This saw Botswana's prideful safari industry going completely out of business.

In the survey, Mr. Fred Msami of Savanna Safaris & Tours said, "When we started this year, 2021, a number of guests who had a safari booked in 2020 were very active and wanted

to have their safari dates fixed, but since the second wave, at around mid-Jan, most of them became silent and perhaps planning for 2022. Regarding new enquiries, most guests are undecided. Firstly, they can't book their flights at the moment, and the fact that the second wave is here, has put all plans on hold. In early January we had enquiries, but by end of January to the present day, enquiries have gone silent." Isa Sathaba, whose business is Extremely Wild Safaris also said the pandemic is affecting his business badly as he couldn't do trips anymore, he

said this pandemic has been the toughest experience ever.

Reports have also indicated that the wildlife as well has been massively killed, especially the endangered game like Rhinos. Poachers have been easily killing and dehorning rhinos since the protectors, wildlife rangers have been not as operational as before. And with not much force to take care of the wildlife due to the COVID-19 regulations, poachers have thrived and game been massively killed. The pandemic really took a toll on Botswana's tourism.

## Miso

Miso should be your new best friend. You can buy organic, gluten-free miso paste and add it to everything from salad dressing to dessert. Miso is a fermented paste made from soybeans, barley or rice, and is best known as the broth for miso soup. Miso makes a probiotic-rich alternative to salt with the benefit of adding umami flavor.

The fermented food trend means you can now find brightly coloured lacto fermented veggies, slaws and pickles in most grocery stores. But it is also easy to make your own.

## Easy Lacto Fermented Veggies Recipe

- Assemble several glass jars with lids.
- Select veggies for brining. I love carrots, cauliflower, green beans, celery and radishes.
- Slice or halve veggies to fit snugly into glass jars.

- Dissolve 3 Tablespoons kosher salt in a quart of water.
- Pour water into veggie jars and completely cover veggies.
- Add spices or herbs (I add dill and peppercorns) and seal jars. Store in a cool, dry space.
- "Burp" jars every 2 days to release excess pressure. Taste after a week.

**Note:** Fermented veggies can be stored in the refrigerator for several weeks.

According to Baboloki, the Art market in Botswana is there and if we are to scale it on percentages, he would say it's at 80%. Currently you cannot go to school and make a life out of drawing except if you have good marketing strategies. It is not every day that people buy art works but on a daily basis you need basic needs of life. He said in Botswana, the profession is still growing although we are not yet there but we will eventually prevail.

Currently, limitations that he has falls under material wise because the materials that he requires are not available in Botswana. The only materials you will find in Botswana Art shops were used back in 2009 but we are in 2021. The challenge he has now is to opt for buying outside through online. Now it's even hard for him because the Covid-19 pandemic has taken a stroll and online buying takes time more than it normally takes thus leaving him with lack of material as the limiting factor. Another thing is that, since this pandemic has erupted presidential competitions have stopped but the government is their biggest buyer so everything is actually on hold.

He said his biggest achievement hasn't arrived yet but he has so far done postage stamps for Botswana Post and there were three of them, having done a commemorative stamp for Sir Ketumile Masire. That is one of the pillar goals in his profession and its currently circulating, the second and third are for the Kalahari invertebrates. Another one is that he was the first student to receive an award for the very first time when Excellence Awards were introduced.

In his art works, his great master piece is an art work, where a white lady was holding a black child. He describes himself as someone who condemns racism and discrimination and believes children see colour and love from the people that are taking care of them.

# The Self-Aspired Artist

**C**elebrity World reached out to the talented Baboloki Somolekae who was born and raised in Molepolole, to share his artistic skills and journey in the arts industry.

Initially, Baboloki started developing passion for art at a tender age when he was at primary school up to senior school, still out doing the most in the arts field. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial Design from University of Botswana. He loved art and had a motive that it is possible to draw something the way it appears. Currently, Baboloki is an assistant teacher at a junior school, helping students with drawing techniques and wish to have an academy in the near future where he can aspire artists that it's possible to make a living out of fine or visual art.

Mostly, the medium that he uses in his profession comprises of pen and coloured pencils as his strongest field. He said in the business sense, people would request him to draw them for a fee, but it ranges from A4 to A0 being the largest size.

When asked how long he has been in this profession, Baboloki said when he started drawing as a profession in 2012. His art work was part of some exhibition in 2010 and someone had loved and bought it after seeing it. At that moment, it didn't come to his mind that one can actually

draw somebody and people can pay for it. He was just drawing for fun. In 2012, somebody from the museum told him that he can make money from drawing people, then that's where it all started.

Baboloki also said that he didn't choose his profession and it's what he always tell people although others get shocked. "I say it's like a curse because when you are doing visual art, especially when you are drawing, painting or sculpturing with love and passion, you can never go a long period of doing it. You will just wake up, it will tell you in your spirit or soul and you will eventually find yourself doing it," added Baboloki. Moreover, he said when you are doing art you will never understand as it comes naturally and the motive behind is not to make money but at the end someone will come and pay for the final product.

For him, in order to make a living through drawing, with strategies in place, and since we live in the modern days, you have to manage yourself and resources because out of the drawing you had made, you have used materials to reach to that end product. Therefore you have to replace and market your work. In that way, he said if more people know about you, and having an idea of what you deal with and the importance of it, it's possible to make a living out of art works.

## BUCKINGHAM PALACE'S SKELETONS OUT OF THE CLOSET

Buckingham Palace is said to be braced for a string of historical bullying complaints after allegations against Meghan Markle reportedly "opened up a can of worms." The Duchess of Sussex has denied the bullying allegations as Buckingham Palace launches a review into the claims.

Now a number of former palace staff members are said to be considering coming forward with new complaints about the palace. The new string of complaints are said to allege a toxic "culture of bullying" in the royal household and do not relate to Meghan Markle. At least five historical claims made by ex-staffers may now be reopened in the wake of the palace's announcement. The complaints are said to have been reported at the time by workers against other members of staff. "There was a bullying culture existing among certain members of staff. But given the hierarchical structure people were scared to come forward," one said. It is said the complaints were issued and logged by email, letter or private consultation.

Another insider claimed Buckingham Palace's public statement over the claims against the Duchess of Sussex has "opened a can of worms." The Duchess of Sussex, Meghan, accused the royal family of "perpetuating falsehoods" about her and Harry. In a preview clip, Meghan said it was "liberating" to be able to "say yes" to Oprah Winfrey's request for an interview. "Also that we have the ability to make our own choices in a way that I couldn't have said yes to you then. That wasn't my choice to make. As an adult who lived a really independent life to then go into this construct that is...different than I think what people imagine it to be, it's really liberating to be able to have the right and the privilege in some ways to be able to say yes." Buckingham Palace did not want to comment.



## MEGHAN'S SISTER PREDICTS HER MARRIAGE TO PRINCE HARRY HEADED FOR A DIVORCE

Meghan Markle's half-sister Samantha claims Duchess and Prince Harry are heading for divorce and urges them to go on an 'apology tour'

Meghan Markle's estranged half-sister has launched another blistering attack on the Duchess of Sussex by claiming that her marriage to Prince Harry will end in divorce unless they get 'extensive counselling'. Samantha Markle suggested the Duke may already be 'questioning' the marriage and predicted it could 'get nasty' until he 'starts dissenting or pulling back from her'.

The 56-year-old American also called on the Sussexes to go on an 'apology tour' after the couple made accusations of racism within the Royal Family during their bombshell interview with Oprah Winfrey. Samantha, who has accused Meghan of having 'narcissistic personality disorder', also claimed that she 'did a lot of damage' to their father Thomas Markle and called on her half-sister to make a public apology to him.

Speaking to TMZ about Meghan and Harry's marriage, she said: 'I see it ending in divorce unless they get extensive counselling and can agree to work on being honest, to work on apologies to everyone that they've damaged in the course of this bull in a china shop two-year spiel. I mean, nothing about any of this has been honest, and the damage to the Royals has been massive - especially now.'

# Feel the Burn With These Arm Exercises



**T**hese five exercises with light weights make the exercise look easy, but the small moves ensure you feel the burn. Grab yourself one or one and a half kilo dumbbells and get going.

## Squaring It Off

How to do it: Sit cross-legged on the floor, and imagine you are in a box. Holding your weights so palms are facing down, extend your arms and lift them, imagining you are lifting them to the top corners of the box in front of you. Bring your arms down so they are reaching for the bottom corners of the box. Keeping your arms at the same level, shift them so they are behind you, reaching for the bottom corners of the box. From there, lift up your arms so they are behind and above you, reaching for the top corners of the box. Return to starting position. This completes one rep; do three reps of 10.

## The Triceps Push

How to do it: Hold your weights and kneel on your knees with toes touching the ground. Hinge forward from your hips, and bend your elbows at 90 degrees. Unbend your elbows, and extend both of your arms straight back, palms facing each other. Squeeze your triceps, and then return back to starting position. Repeat 10 times. Do three sets of 10.

## Right-Angle Bicep Curl

How to do it: A lot of times we do a full rotation for our biceps.

Instead of taking the exercise all the way, this exercise stops when your arms make a right angle. Sit cross-legged on the floor and, holding your weights, extend your arms straight in front of you with your palms up. Slowly pull your arms up into a right angle. Release them back into the starting position, and repeat for 10 counts. Do three sets of 10.

## The Bicep and Deltoid Squeeze

How to do it: Sit cross-legged on the floor and hold your weights. Lift up your arms and extend them to your side, palms facing forward and elbows bent at 90 degrees. Keep your shoulders down and your wrists in line with your elbows. Rotate your arms so your elbows are moving to meet each other in front of you. They should be perpendicular to your shoulders. Keep your muscles engaged, and move back to starting position. Do 10 counts, and repeat for three sets.

## The Deltoid Back Squeeze

How to do it: Kneel on the floor, and then sit all the way down so your lower legs are under your bum. Lean forward a little bit, making sure you are leaning from your torso and not just your neck. Then extend both arms so they are behind your bum, palms facing up. Make sure they are floating behind you, not touching your back. Squeeze your arms together so the weights almost touch, and then move back to starting position. Repeat for 10 counts; do three sets of 10.

During his professional boxing career, Hagler notched 62 wins, 3 losses and 2 draws, with 52 wins by knockout. He was inducted into the International Boxing Hall of Fame in 1993.

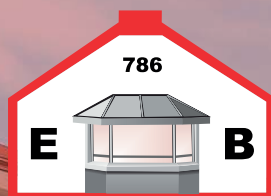
