

## Onzima Keeps Kwaito Legacy Alive

any upcoming artists to this day may seem to be headed towards hip-hop, Rnb and amapiano. It is very rare to find music talent who want to venture with passion into the Kwaito genre, but that is a whole different case with the humble Onzima. Having grown with the love and passion for music, he decided to take to the music world as a kwaito music maker. Born and raised in Molepolole, the artist who always had a passion for music decided to get into the industry back in 2014 when he became a crew member of a group called Amayandal which is a kwaito crew.

Born Elias Samo, he decided to become identified by the stage name "Onzima." When asked why the name he said that when starting his music career, things were hard for him and he had not managed to do well at school so referring to the situations in a Zulu term "kunzima" which means it is hard. That was how the Onzima name was birthed. When starting off as a musician he was part of the Amavandal crew and they released some songs but he eventually had to part wavs with the crew due to certain differences. He then went on to release some singles as a kwaito artist that featured some local and South African artists like Skeatman and from all those songs the one he had so much success with was "Oketsa" the song that he worked with featuring Skeatman.

The artist also said that he is currently working on an album to be released anytime soon. He has collaborated with various local artists and others from South Africa. He said that however things may be, it is very tough for him in the industry and having to market himself or building a brand is a very hard thing to do. Over that, the Covid-19 which seems to be here to stay also has affected his music. Although things are not easy for him,

the artist said he is trying all every means possible to grow his brand. He usually does clips singing to his songs on social media platforms and seems to work out for him in branding himself.

When talking about his music, and genre, he said that his was a different kind of Kwaito genre. It is the kind that has some afro-pop to it with rap as well which makes it to have a different sound over all the traditional kwaito songs one may be used to. The kwaito maker said his journey came through inspiration from listening to the old school kwaito as he was growing up. He also said that he used to listen to South African artists like Zola, Kabelo, Mapaputsi and many others and they made him grow in love with the genre. "The songs were great and even had a message to pass on," he said. From them all all-time favourite was Zola he loved the way he sang and rapped which was unique and really inspired him.

Onzima also went on to say that at the moment he and aspires work with many renounced artists in the kwaito industry like Family, Dlala and Zola.

single was released on May 28, 2021 it is an inspiration to everyone who struggles with the hardships of life.



# Mosu Matsie 585 Studios Dedicates To Help Struggling Talent

n 2020 in the middle of a world affecting crisis, one man found this an opportunity to be a servant of hope. Rapula Motlhanka started up a studio that would go on to help young aspiring artists without the means to make it in the industry finance wise. When asked why he named the studio by the name Mosu Matsie 585, he said that it is because of the location to the studio. The studio is in a resident plot numbered 585 and there is a Mosu tree in the compound, the ward or the neighbourhood to the place is known as Matsie and all that give out the names to the studio.

The studio has more than 20 artists under it who are mostly young and aspiring artists and there are veteran artists as well whom the studio is working with. They have been working on a project as a studio called AFRICA, an album expected to hit the market anytime soon next month. The album has

13 songs in it and has been composed by all the different young artists working with the studio and these also include one South African who once worked with Zahara.

When talking about how he came up with the vision he said that the primary idea for the studio was to start recording artists but the whole idea was diverted to what is now the studio's norm when the Covid-19 hit. Since people were highly affected by this Covid-19 business wise, he decided to help out those who were extremely disadvantaged and incapable than the rest among musicians. That is how the project to help young artists who are out there struggling got birthed. He says that he started scouting for young talent and started in Mogoditshane looking for guitarists and those who play folk music, he found them and other musicians. "I found it fit then commit to this as a community based project knowing that it is one thing many may fear to embark on," said Rapula. He also said they looked into getting out there

and locating young under privileged talents outside Gaborone.

Although this grand gesture to the community has been good for young people out there and taking them off the streets, they admitted that it is not an easy and simple thing to do especially financial wise. Mothanka said that the competition out there is too much and they in the other hand are part of the game yet not gaining financially. He went on to emphasise the need they had with financial assistance from enterprises and local companies out there, the government included too. He also said that most are youngsters without any studio experience and some have talent but not the creativity to compose ideas.

Motlhanka finally said that he did call out for helpers out there to also land a hand in the project so that he may also finally be able to manage and carry the project among other parts of the country.

his is a quick and easy ground beef skillet dish with Greek style seasonings including spinach, olives, feta, oregano and plenty of fresh herbs!

It is super simple, throw together, recipe for a fast meal and it's basically a one-skillet ground beef dish with some of preferred Greek inspired flavours and ingredients. It starts out with cooking the ground beef along with onion followed by adding spinach that wilts in the heat, and then olives and feta. The dish is seasoned with plenty of herbs including oregano, parsley, dill and mint and a hint of cinnamon. This dish only takes about 20 minutes to make so you can easily cook some rice or pasta to serve it over. It is great with a side of Greek salad, but it slaps with fat cakes.

**Prep Time:** 5 minutes **Cook Time:** 15 minutes **Total Time:** 20 minutes

Servings: 4

#### Ingredients

1 pound ground beef (and/or lamb)
1 onion, diced
3 cloves garlic, chopped
1/4 teaspoon cinnamon (optional)
2 teaspoons oregano
4 cups baby spinach
1/3 cup red olives, sliced
1/3 cup green olives, sliced
1/3 cup feta, crumbled
Salt and pepper to taste
3 green onions, thinly sliced

2 tablespoons parsley, chopped 1 tablespoon mint, chopped

1 tablespoon dill, chopped

#### **Directions**

 Cook the ground beef and onion in a large skillet over medium heat, breaking the beef apart as it cooks, before draining off any excess grease.

## Beef Skillet



- Add the garlic, cinnamon and oregano and cook until fragrant, about a minute.
- Add the spinach, mix it in and cook until it wilts, about 2-3 minutes.
- Mix in the olives and feta before seasoning with salt and pepper to taste.
- Mix in the green onions, parsley, mint and dill and enjoy.

Option: Replace the spinach with kale.

**Option:** Add 1 large diced tomato and bring to a bli before adding the spinach.

**Tip:** Cook rice or pasta while the beef cooks and it will be done at about the same time.


## What are your last words to other young artists hoping to make it in the art industry?
