

Being in the industry for only five years without much background in acting and film however has not limited the comedian to become the best he can be. He is now a producer and scriptwriter who has made potential productions that can be notable in the country's film industry. Of recent, he has produced a new production that is called "Matholwane". The promising production is a drama series that he produced looking at the current Corona virus situation and how much life it has cost hence the film, Matholwane being a name commonly given to sacrificed children. The story line is about a family consisting of a father, mother and a child, and due to the hardships of the current situation the father goes on to sacrifice the child for enrichment. The whole production is also set on the Covid-19 times where there are protocols followed for the Covid-19.

The production unlike most of his works as a comedian, was not a comedy but a drama series. He says that he submitted the production to the local big online Tv, Upic TV but was unfortunately unsuccessful with the transaction as they were told they failed submission. When asked why it was not successful he said that they were told that their submission had expired when they submitted it. He further went on to say whatever the reason could have been as to why they could not successfully submit it, he was rather not demoralised on getting it to

otswana has proved to be filled with raw talent in the comedy industry. The country has seen so many talented comedians who have been celebrated even internationally emerging from all corners of the country. What seems to be inspirational with these comedians and viners is that each and every one of them has their own angle of comic genius that makes them unique and different from all the others. Everyone has their thing which draws us to them and love them each differently. In this edition we have yet another unique and renounced comedian, Xolo Black. The young Selebi-Phikwe born who grew up in Mochudi has been doing some sensational work in the industry, coming up with the Charlie Chaplin inspired kind of comedy with some other inspiration from the Mr Bean.

The comedian ventured into a career of comedy in 2018 when he started at the same

time as another one of the country's comic giants, William Last KRM and they were both doing collaborations. The two met at Poetic Records. With a record stand of five years along the industry, Xolo has worked with many other known comedians in the industry in his journey of building a profound comedy career. Besides William Last KRM, he also got to work with some comedians like Maatla Ephriam Basha, Troy April, Pompi and many others. Xolo said that he has always been a comedian from his school days although he mostly performed as a dancer. He would perform to fellow students and entertain them through dancing and eventually became the comedian he is today.

The comedian who is also an actor, social media influencer and brand ambassador has grown to a place that he never thought of as he had a challenging start off to his journey. He came up to the industry without any background of being an actor as he was never part of the school drama clubs. He

has done a lot of work that is actually similar to that of Keitumile as the famous Ntsoro.

'Matholwane' is currently Xolo's biggest project that he had to make of all his products and remains his best project with 13 episodes. He has another project that he submitted with BTV called 'Bokgeleke'. The project which is a sitcom was submitted to the station around January this year and got a confirmation on its press validity. Apart from these two he also has more projects he is working on as well that are at the writing stage. When he went on further to talk about the 'Matholwane' project and its message, and what he wants people to get from the drama was that since we are living in the tough times as to the ones in the Covid-19 era, it is important that people do not take or make decisions that are not right in the moral sense and ethical ways. We shouldn't make horrible decisions like the father who had to sacrifice his child.

The project did not have much assistance




and sponsorship in its production, but there were some individuals in the community who helped him with things like transport. Nonetheless, he used his own cameras. One other person who helped him through is also Joel Keitumile who offered some agent assistance for the project. He also worked with some other small productions in Mochudi including Dj Citi Slicker who helped him with sound production.

When talking about his ambitions as a comedian, he said that he dreams to go all the way out there in the industry to international levels and have major projects that would be internationally aclaimed. He says it is his dream to work with big people in the industry like Rowan Atkinson. As his comedy gets inspiration from him and that of Chaplin, he would like to work with them or get to just meet them. He further said it is the kind of comedy he believes will one day be feeding him and grow him.

ven though he has been able to brand himself through the industry, it is has proved to be a tough industry to make a career from. According to the comedian, the industry of Botswana is yet a growing one and it is a tough one, especially if one is not patient enough to get through it. He said that one needs to be patient and well preserved to get to make it through the industry of Botswana. The covid-19 as well has made things even more difficult for an artist in the country. Even though there also can be a challenge of feuds among artists and entertainers it is very rare as they are usually supportive of each other. Xolo is personally preserved and always tries to stay away from unnecessary fights and guarrels as he wants to have focus and build himself.

Speaking on the support from the government side, he said government does not really have much of an impact in trying to transform and help grow the industry like one would expect. He said they are slow towards helping the especially growing comedy industry that has proved to have so much potential of making the industry a beneficial economic sector as well. The comedian also elaborated his disappointments towards the decision that went on to be made to rather have an outsider, Steve Harvey given an opportunity that could have been given to



the locally capable personnel in the country.

He concluded by saying that he is currently working on a project that he wouldn't yet disclose, that will be aired to the television along with 'Matholwane'. Xolo also said he was grateful for the support he gets especially on social media where he has a follow ship of more than a hundred thousand on his Facebook page, Xolo Black. He encouraged young and upcoming comedians to have patience in the industry and always have faith in whatever they do.

To him, music is more like a calling and he said that he actually does it with passion, adding that he once thought of taking a break from it but he failed.

He encourages Batswana to take music as a hobby or a side hustle rather than a career and if it pays off, that would be a bonus to them. Aobakwe aspires to have his own record label and own studio in the near future to help the upcoming artists who looks up to renown local artists like Vee, Charma gal and others. Besides music he is passionate about his work since he is a professional driver and he is also a university student. Aobakwe is defined by his music content, it is one thing that makes him unique from other local artists. He said that his music is based on true life events and his experiences.

So far he has worked with a quite different local artists like Girly O Dibody and they've released a song called Ifonkong which its visuals are already playing on BTV. They have performed on Flava Dome and they had a couple of interviews together on local radio stations. He has also worked with people like Rolen X in a song titled 'On my way', UriBW, Zwai\$ of Amanandos in a song titled "Bow Down", as well as Honestbeatz. He appreciates the help he got from Girly O Dibody by saying, "She made me who I am, and she helped me with a lot of things. Meet The Zealous Motswana Motorcycle RCCCC

Doctor. That's where the Dr in his nickname came from. He says over the years, parents and society would tell us that motorcycles are dangerous and he was divorced from his love for motorcycles as he listened to his parents who wanted to keep him safe. His passion was reignited in 2019 when he had to learn how to ride a motorcycle to do a job. The moment he got on it, all those childhood dreams of one day racing at MotoGP came flooding back and here he is. Featured here is Temogo Pilane, a Motswana born citizen who lived, schooled and grew up in Botswana.

Tell us about your first motorbike

My current bike, still my first, is a gorgeous red 2007 Honda CBR 600RR. It was a preowned bike and I was lucky enough to have found a pre-owned bike that was still in near

It's been a childhood love for him and it got stronger during his early varsity days. He is a huge fan of Valentino Rossi, aka The

mint condition. The moment I laid eyes on her, I knew she was mine and we would be together forever. She had very little mileage and was mechanically perfect. I rode over 20, 000km in the 1st year of owning her, I couldn't get enough of her and I still can't. I named the bike Ahmya, she is the love of my life. Honestly, the day I took her home for the first time was arguably the happiest day of my life. August 11th 2020, we were hit by a car she and I. She was a wreck but I still couldn't and wouldn't part with her. I bought her from the Insurer and sent her to my brother in Pretoria for repair, rebuilding and conversion into a race bike. We are still together Ahmya and I. It's safe to say the Honda brand stole my heart and you know what they say, first cut is the deepest. Who knows, maybe someday I may ride another brand but it would be such a dream come true if I could race for Honda my entire career.

What can you tell us about your racing career?

Well I'm a rookie in the truest sense. I have zero races under the belt but we all have to start somewhere and this is my start. I was so fortunate to get the attention of the owners of REDSTAR RACEWAY. It's a race track facility in Mpumalanga, South Africa. They invited me in December 2020 and treated me like royalty. That trip changed my life. I experienced track riding for the first time and I was lucky to meet Steven Odendaal. He's currently racing in the WSBK SSP class and watching him has changed me forever. Sadly, South African MotoGP racer Brad Binder didn't show up. That would've been crazy to meet both on my first track visit. I knew then and there that I want to race superbikes for a living. I caught the eyes of a lot of instructors there who said I have a lot of potential and it can be developed into something. They are eagerly awaiting my return so as soon as I am able to, I have to head out to RSRW and start putting in work.

What do you hope to accomplish?

I love my country so much and I want to make it better. Motorsport is the tool that I intend to use to make my contribution to Botswana. I want to inspire other bikers and Batswana youth to pursue motorsport as a viable career option. I want to vivify motorsport into a thriving part of the private sector. The spill over benefits are obvious. It is my dream to someday race internationally and raise the Botswana flag high. I would love to see the Botswana flag on the MotoGP and WSBK rosters. I may not be the one to but if I can inspire someone to dream that big and make it there, my service to my country will be done.

What do you do when you're not riding bikes?

I'm a regular guy, you know. I like playing games on my PS4, I love movies and series but mostly I love learning. I watch videos a lot on YouTube, about how to be a better superbike racer or learning about health



and how to better take care of myself. I'm antisocial so I don't go out much or interact with a lot of people. I really love my own company the most.

What's the scariest thing that has ever happened to you on a motorbike?

I almost died in an accident involving a car on August 11, 2020. A motorist assumed, as they always do just before killing a biker, that I was far from an intersection and at the last second decided to dash in. Sadly they hit me square on and almost killed me. I suffered multiple injuries, broken bones, torn ligaments and lacerations. It was a pretty traumatic experience that landed me in hospital and psychological therapy and it's been a hard road to recovery. I almost lost my life to a moment of impatient carelessness and my dreams almost never came to pass. They would've died with me together with all the things I wanted to accomplish through them. The thought of that hurt more than the physical injuries.

Pretty please, to all motorists on the roads, KEEP A LOOK OUT FOR BIKERS. OUR LIVES MATTER.

What's your dream bike?

Oh man, it is definitely the 2020 Fireblade RR-R SP!! Honda went all out with this one and built an absolute track weapon! It is so very much modelled on their MotoGP machine and its design is primarily high performance track racing. A lot of reviewers complain about the comfort of the ride regarding the foot pegs are too high so it bends the knee too high. I say, keep it to the race track then. If you want comfort, get a cruiser. It does not only boasts an amazing amount of power but just the aesthetics of it from the livery to the lines and profile. It makes my mouth water just thinking about it. What does it take to be a superbike racer? An insurmountable amount of physical fitness. Naturally I am a fit person, I took after my dad who is a retired army officer from Botswana Defence Force. Training was his life so like father like son and that's been it for me. I thought I was in great shape untill I went to Redstar Raceway and got to experience track racing. It is literally a brutal assault on your physical conditioning. A few laps around the track left me winded and I wondered how MotoGp and WSBK athletes manage 20 laps. That's when I realized the difference in levels between leisure street riding and track racing. I had to step up my training a lot ever since then. The training is intense and its non-stop and I continuously push my limits as I aspire to someday race in world class leagues. I can't afford not to.

Any last words?

Dreams do come true. Everything is impossible until it's done. You don't have to know how it's going to happen, you just need to know that it will. Take small steps towards your goal. It's allowed to take rests and recharge. Resting, assessing, evaluating







the way and the tests are everyday because quitting is always an option but every day you have to choose going after your dream. To parents, please try to be more open minded about your children's future. The go to school, get good grades, get a good job and retire scheme may have worked then but it doesn't work now. Nurture their dreams, support them with a clear goal and semblance of a plan, I'm happy to help with the little I know.



Getting into the world of music, what was the inspiration to all that?

I would say the inspiration came from the environment that I grew up in. My father was a singer at church, my aunties, sisters and cousins as well. We are all singers even though they are just gospel singers whereas I ventured into a more broad musical space.

Which of your songs identifies you?

Yoh! That's though to pick, but from my album I would choose three songs, 'I am free', 'Lockdown Engilozi' and the one I have just dropped recently titled 'E Tlaa Fela', it's a song that talks about the pandemic.

Do you have any released full album?

I have only had one album that is made up of six tracks which I released this year in April.

You mentioned that you are a producer, who have you worked with?

I have worked with a couple of artists, the likes of Malembe, Pastor Avumile Dube, Xwala da Cash, Eric Eq Maeba of Radio Botswana Ienaka la sechaba fame by HT Tautona.

As a singer have you had any collaborations?

Not yet but I have a couple of lined up callabos coming very soon, one with a South African artist and a couple here at home.

Are you working on anything at the moment?

Yes! I am, there is a single coming very soon in a short while, it is done and we are just finishing up a few corners here and there.

Where do you draw inspiration from?

I draw my inspiration from other artists and the circumstances around our lives, you know.

Let's talk about the reception of your work, how well has it been among Batswana?

RAISED BY A FAMILY OF SINGERS TO BECOME ONE

e grew up among a family of singers and went on to pursue a career in music as a vocalist and a producer. Kopo Sakuze who is better known by the stage name Kopo Guccie is a Motswana singer, performer and record producer. He was born in Shakawe and now lives in Maun. He has been referred to one of the most gifted vocalist to ever come out of Ngamiland and recently had a chat with CW.

Who is Guccie?

Well, Kopo Guccie is a prominent vocalist, born and raised in Shakawe. He is a music producer who wailed his way into the hearts of Batswana with his productions and his unique voice.

How long have you been in the Industry?

I have been in the industry making records for 5 years now, but I have been involved in Music from a very tender age. I was never dragged to church on Sundays because of my love for singing.

What do you do as an artist?

I am an Afro Pop singer by default and at times I fuse it with house music, but because when you are a producer you deal with quite a number of ideas, I have done jazz gospel, etc. Most of the time I like fusing stuff together and come up with something a little different. I do not believe in what others are doing, I just get ideas then produce what runs through my head and that's it. My work is really appreciated among Batswana, I actually never thought I would have so much of the support. I have been receiving a massive support and positive feedback.

Have you done some live performances?

I have contested at the Presidential Competitions by the MYSC for two consecutive years with very good results. I also perform at weddings.

Any achievements?

An achievement I am proud of is being the 2018 Presidential Competition Finalist.

What does the future hold for you?

I want to be able to penetrate the Market fully and have my clothing label.

Is there anything you want to add on?

Well, I believe Botswana has a massive talent but we do not do much to unearth it. I work with amazing people but still see them remaining in one place. These things happen because everything is centralized in Gaborone, imagine if we had just one radio station in the North, it would really help in captivating the talent.

awrance Fingi Bock was born Gaborone in but grew up in Digawana and did most of his schooling there. He is a university drop out who quit his studies intentionally





Hanging Garden of Vegetables





- 2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
- 2 tablespoons fresh parsley, chopped

1 teaspoon dried oregano 1 clove garlic, grated salt and pepper to taste


Directions

ince he started working on his personal collection, people have wanted to commission him for their portraits because they saw talent in him. The 20 year old Goratamang Ookame has a good hand when it comes to artworks and it's the reason why it has turned into a business. As good as he is with his artwork, he did not want to let his talent go into waste and he therefore chose to turn it into a business. "I m a non-stop person this work takes me time and I'm passionate about my work," so he said.

Goratamang who first discovered his talent at a tender age started at primary school where he drew integrated science diagrams and was the best student in class when it comes to drawing. After he proceeded to junior school, he realized his amazing skill and most of the teachers started to commission him for their self-portrait which they still do even nowadays. His skill was sharpened when he got to senior school and that's where he did hyperealistic drawing. He never won any award at school but according to him, he had always remained the best in class.

I used graphite pencils at school and even now I'm still using graphite and charcoal to create an artwork. Then I started working on my personal collection after finishing my last paper at Lotsane senior secondary school on the year 2019.



Zizo Ookame, as he is affectionately known is a pencil artist who aims to be a cooperative international artist and dreams to exhibit his artworks outside the country.

Talking on the challenges that he experienced since the inception of his art business, Goratamang said, "Since I started, the business did well before the Covid-19 pandemic, now our industries keep on opening and closing because of corona but I hope it will be better as time goes on."

On the selling strategies that he uses, Goratamang said, "When a customer commissions me for a work, it depends on if they need to see me first or what. Those that stay far from me are the ones that always order portrait drawings most."

According to him, most of his clients are from social media. So far he has sold around 40 to 55 artworks since the inception of the business and he has started working on his personal collection at the moment.

Although Goratamang is good in holding a pencil on paper, he hasn't received any award nor has he ever entered any art competitions but he hopes that one day he will receive one. He does hyperrealism Art, meaning the artwork that is like a photograph but it's done with a hand. His business currently operates in Maun under the name, Zizo Ookame.

His last words to other young artists hoping to make it in the art industry, "Be patient with

your work no matter how hard life may be, remember that the way we do things has completely changed. Learn from others. I've learnt a lot of things from other international artists even their words and quotes are still on my heart."

A PROMISING FUTURE FOR BOTSWANA ATHLETICS


he young a t h l e t e s who went to represent the country have proven just how much of a potential the
