



Mogomotsi Kefitile trusts that poetry is important for the growth of individuals and the public. He describes it as an instrument to spread knowledge altitudes and something to value as Batswana.

Magalaotane, as he is affectionately known grew up citing poems at school and even at home. He started poetry when he was doing standard 6 and his talent was recognized by teachers so much that he would be called to perform during school ceremonies. Poetry has kept him strong and he has never allowed any trials to suppress the pleasures that it has given him. He got tougher with every experience.

> The 22 year old Molepolole lad is also a creative poet writer who cites his poems in Setswana language only. According to him, his first competition was at junior when he was a form 1 student, he won position 1 in the school competitions. He has the 2016 Dithubaruba event in and at the 2018 Miss Setso.

Magalaotane said he got position 2 at the 2018 tertiary schools competitions and the same position in the regional competitions that were held in 2019. He once performed at Maru-TV on a program called Kgwana tsa Setso. So far he has worked with the University of Botswana, Dithejwane and Kgarisechele Junior Schools in Molepolole where he is usually called to perform during the events.

Magalaotane said that New Era College has been giving him support since 2017. He also said most of the time when the school hosts events, they contact him to perform at their ceremonies. Talking on the uniqueness of his poems, Magalaotane said that he uses exclusive Setswana language and he spices it up as well as choosing a unique item or person to cite a poem about.

As a responsible and caring citizen, Magalaotane has two kids that he voluntarily teaches poetry. Besides poetry, he has a tuition called Star Keepers Tuition Centre where they tutor kids from primary, junior and senior schools. This platform gave him the responsibility of being the founder of a group called The Realm of Glory, which deals with empowering Christian youths. He has partnered with another Motswana to form it. So far they have helped some of the members to sit for their road theory tests and they have successfully passed them and others have magnificently opened their small businesses.

He went on to build a career that is doing very well today and he is currently working on an epic second album with many big names internationally too, collaborating with him on the album. He came for another chat with CW recently.

You once got featured by the magazine before, so what's happened for you since then? Yah I have been featured before,

it has been beneficial because ever since, I have been getting exposer from far places away from my circle.

What are you currently working on?

I am currently working on my album namely Be Strong Fear Not.

Now that all has opened up since the Covid-19 struck last year, how are planning on getting up to business as a

performer?

I have booked couple of places that I am planning to host events on, I don't want to relay on promoters to book me, I am doing my things but regardless of that I'm still up for bookings, festivals, clubs, weddings and parties. Also I have opened digital store account you can now download my songs on iTunes, Amazon, Apple music.

Are there any gigs lining up for you?

Yep I will be performing at Far Garden on the 30th, Maun on the 6th, Space lounge Gabs on the 13th, Miss Takatokwane Contituency, Miss Tlokweng, Tropical party etc.

What about international ones?

I will be performing at South Africa, Ganyesa on the 26th at Hats& Shades, been a guest artist at the same event for the past 3years except last year.

So during this pandemic with the state of emergency in place, how did you keep afloat?

I never stopped pushing my craft, I've been performing on Tv shows to keep my fans entertained during the state emergency. I've performed at Flava Dome, The Hot Basement, Mokaragana. And my song" Ha Gole monate" have been doing quite good on radio stations, also I've been shooting music videos of my songs.

And as for your other businesses apart from music, how where they affected?

Beside Music I do Printing, I have a printing company and I run clothing line, it's been affected big time, the business was running slow and I was forced to close my office and run from home.

Have been able to bounce back from it all?

Slowly but sure I will say I am bouncing back. Not yet settled but it will get there.

Let's talk more about you second album, when is it coming out?

All I can say is that its dropping early next year haven't set the releasing date but expect something different, something breathe taking. On the album I am working with locally and international artist and producers. What are you anticipating in terms of its reception from fans?

My hard work will speak for myself.

If you are expecting good results from it, what is the main reason as do why you do? I have worked with several good producers and artists country wide and internationally, good sound good quality, and I took my time before I can release this second album, which means I have gained experience and knowledge about music industry and creating a good music.

Any prominent local artists you have worked with on the album?

BABY ILLNESS

Scabies

Scabies is a skin irritation caused by tiny parasitic mites that burrow under the skin. Scabies won't harm your baby, but it can make him itchy and uncomfortable. The bumpy rash you can see on your baby's skin is actually an allergic reaction to the eggs, saliva and poo the mites leave behind.

Symptoms

If your baby gets scabies, he'll develop an extremely itchy rash.

You may see wavy, lightbrown or silvery lines where the mites have burrowed under your baby's skin. He may also develop little pustules or pimples, or small, fluidfilled blisters. The itching may be intense for your baby after a warm bath or at night, and it may keep him awake. Nasty-looking scabs may form over the areas your baby has scratched.

Should I take my baby to the doctor?

See your doctor if you're worried your baby has scabies. The sooner he's treated, the sooner he'll be more comfortable and no longer infectious.

Can my baby go to nursery if he has scabies? Your baby can return to nursery after treatment. It may be worth letting your baby's nursery know that he has it, so they can inform other parents.

How can I prevent my baby from getting scabies?

Avoid contact with anyone who may have it. This can be tricky, especially if your baby is around other children. If your baby has been in close contact with another child who has scabies, treat him straight away, even if he doesn't have the rash.

otswana, a landlocked small populated country is often times hardly given a second look in its efforts, especially the and in the creatives industry. But nonetheless, there are times when the

entertainers, actors or films makers make head-turners that go along to be hat tipped, and from those kinds is our own cinematographer/videographer, Jack Bohloko.

He is a videographer born and raised in Gaborone. He grow up with a lot of passion for the arts and loved local music. He actually makes musical rhymes during his lonely times. Couple that with the fact that his passion for film making went on to be discovered when he was still in senior school where he would take pictures of students, then you have the birth of one of the best music videographers the country has come have. During the times he discovered the love for shooting he had bought a camera which he used to take pictures and sell them for P6 to fellow students. He said that he usually took random activities at school like school fights, funny and naught moments happing around the school. That came to be the moment he used the camera and fell in love with it.

Jack says that his way of filming that went on to be notable for came through an inspiration from a feeling he had. He says that he always felt like there was a loophole with the local music video industry. So what he went on to do was try and play around with the video production so one thing he did was adding up more shorts to his videos which gave a video that vibe and musicality to it. He added



more shots and avoided the lack of camera movement for the camera, he made sure there was more movement to avoid shots that where still which make a video look bad. His approach went on to work and he has in his portfolio, the country's best music videos that put Botswana's music videos in the maps and internationally competitive. But of course even though he came to be a game changer, his start-up was not as easy. He like anyone starting up something had quite the challenge with business, people were not willing to pay and the toughest challenging was trying to get to shoot for someone big in the industry so that he could be taken as serious in the industry. He shoot 15 music videos for free before he could start getting the pay checks. It goes to show and inspire others out there that at times you do not have to rush for the money. It's making your mark that matters and once you have it all comes in flooding.

"it won't be fair to only say Jack Bohloko is the only one who changed the game, I had my time when I was on fire and I love the fact that the upcoming videographers are taking it to another level," said the videographer when asked if it would be fair to say he single headedly helped shape the way of music shooting into what it is now. He went on to note that he really respects the work being done by the likes of Director Mo, Cyc Jouzy, Local Coner, Black Pixel and Re Mmogo Visuals among others. He said that the film industry is growing in terms of the products and filming and that the only thing that was left behind is the support especially from those who are able and can assist financially. He said that there was however a challenge that also limited the growth to the full potential of filmmaking in Botswana and that was of course the population but also the laws of the country. In Botswana, for example one is not allowed to use a police van or attire on a video. He said he has written endless letters to the police with no reply.

hen talking on his relocation to South Africa, Jack Bohloko said that his move was due to the fact that he felt too comfortable in Botswana and his creativity from his perspective was down. He went to South Africa to get to challenge himself. He said that now that he is in South Africa he feels like the Lord sent him there to get to learn from the industry that side so that when he came back home, he be well equipped to turn the industry around. He said although for sure the money flow in South Africa was better than in Botswana in many ways. However, for him it was like he was an upcoming videographer and so he is at the moment working on attracting more business. He went on to say that he was not there to even get to compete with the known local productions but he was going actually learn from those big companies as a videographer.

Relocating to another country has to be one the tough things one has to go through and it's been the case for the star and at some point he actually considered coming back home as he found it hard and he barely had customers. But through pushing he now is in a position to say he won't come home any time soon until he gets what he to do over there. He went on to say that the one in his working there that he can say he brought something different to the local norm, he has some kind of working relationship with his customers that none has. He is the kind of person who allows other people to share their ideas during work and he says it makes up great work.

The filmmaker is currently at works with Lesotho's Ntate Stunna and they are working on a series of videos which they are to release in time. The stars have been for the champ who recently got a gifting from YouTube. This is something given to a YouTuber who has surpassed a 100k subscribers as an appreciation and it is called Silver Plaque. He said that being the first Motswana to receive the plaque just showed him that anything is possible and the sky is the limit.


BAHAMA LOUNGE

The name Skwena means a life style that generalizes that of a Mokwena in a proper way that is acceptable in the society of Bakwena. I made it unique by taking out the letter (E) in the Sekwena word.

What was the motive behind your business?

Since I didn't do well at school, I have always wanted to do something that will leave a mark in the industry that I grew in, which is the entertainment industry and I wanted to have something that will give me dignity.Before I introduced my brand to the industry, I was a traditional dancer and I worked with the likes of Ditiro Leero, Matsieng and Mmurubele doing the phathisi dance.

When did your business start?

I started my business on the 14th of July, 2018.

How is your business doing in the market?

The business has been doing well because people like the brand and its uniqueness. The only problem is the national crisis of Covid-19 pandemic, my business has been affected too due to closing of the entertainment industry but hopefully things will go back to normal because we have now resumed sales.

Why did you choose this type of business?

I chose it because I grew up having love for branding specially clothing, now am happy that I used my own image to make it.

Who sponsored you to start this kind of business?

The leopard can, however, grow much larger. The ground colour is typically yellowish above and white below. Dark spots are generally arranged in rosettes over much of the body and the size and spacing of the spots vary greatly. As a result of these differences in pattern, several races of leopard have been named.



Here are some common (and not-socommon) signs of emotional cheating:

- 1. Your partner tells the outside person things that they don't even tell you.
- 2. 2) They're more irritable toward you after connecting with the outside person.
- 3. They have a hard time tolerating brief periods of frustration, loneliness, or emotional discomfort within your relationship.
- 4. They often/always turn to the outside person for comfort when you're unavailable.
- 5. They seem to connect with the outside person more often after unresolved conflicts with you.
- 6. They've been increasing the frequency of connection with the outside person.
- 7. They drop hints that they wish you were more like the outside person.
- 8. There are gift exchanges between them and the outside person.

- 9. They try to prevent you from seeing texts on their phone.
- They compare your emotional capacity to the outside person's emotional capacity.
- 11. They seem more detached from you after connecting with the outside person.
- 12. They want a lot less sex.
- 13. They want a lot more sex but seem detached during sex with you.
- 14. They act differently when talking about the outside person.
- 15. They've stopped expressing their needs.
- 16. They've stopped communicating with you about deeper issues.
- 17. The relationship with this outside person acts as an "exit" from connection with you.
- 18. They seem to have given up on facing and resolving issues with you.
- They use inappropriate terms of endearment with the outside person, such as "love you," "miss you," "baby,"

"sweetheart," "honey," etc.

- 20. They minimize, deny, or mock your complaints about the outside person.
- 21. They get reactive, judge you, or emotionally distance from you when you request they create stronger boundaries with the outside person.
- 22. They tell you you're too sensitive about their relationship with the outside person.

No single item on this list means your partner is emotionally cheating. But if you're noticing that multiple items on this list are at play, it could be a sign that there's a degree of emotional cheating occurring. It could also mean that you've stopped prioritizing the intimacy between you and your partner, and it's time to recommit to one another—to lean into your feelings and vulnerabilities, despite fears or obstacles.

Warning: You shouldn't use accusations of "emotional cheating" as a way of justifying



forced, controlling, or manipulative behaviour toward your partner. If you or your partner have any major concerns about the dynamic between you—or if your behaviours are consistently hurtful and/or damaging to one another—you may want to seek professional counselling.

Emotional cheating versus friendship.

What's the difference between friendship and emotional cheating? The short answer is that with friendships, there are different boundaries than in a main attachment. When a romantic partner becomes a priority in your life, it's important for friendships to bend and give, even as they remain present and supportive. This allows more space for your relationship to develop as your main source of closeness and support. Opening up to depending on a romantic partner fosters bonding, trust, love, and intimacy.

How do you know whether an outside connection is a friendship or "emotional cheating"? Here are methods you can use to help you figure it out:

Ask yourself: Am I oversharing with this outside person? Disclosing too much? Strengthening an outside heart-connection at the expense of my partnership? Check in with yourself by change in to your body. Notice any subtle signals—sickness, tension, tightness in your chest or throat. Chances are, your own embodied intuition "knows" the answer and will tell you, if you create the space to listen.

Imagine that your partner is seeing the interactions between you and this friend, hearing the conversations, and maybe even picking up on your feelings of relief, excitement, or pride. Consider how your partner would feel. Would it make them uncomfortable? Would they feel hurt or betrayed? How would you feel if the tables were turned, and your partner had this closeness with someone else?



Why emotional cheating happens.

If your partner is emotionally cheating, you might be wondering: Why are they doing this? Is it because they're secretly in love with this outside person? Have they stopped loving me? Is it because there's something wrong? Is our relationship over?

Sometimes, the independent decision by one partner to "emotionally cheat" is consciously and strategically made, but more often than not it's about small, increasing, perhaps well-intentioned, and unconscious boundary slippages—something that a partner thoughtlessly indulges in when they regularly share thoughts, hopes, dreams, feelings, frustrations, passions, or other aspects of their inner world with someone else, unbeknownst to their partner.

More often than not, emotional cheating is a way that one partner is trying to get a deeper need met—or to protect themselves from a feared scenario. Why aren't they trying to get this need met with you? How come they don't just share their inner world, their fears, and vulnerabilities with you directly rather than cultivating a close bond elsewhere? These are big questions with complex answers that vary. Maybe they've tried to get close to you, but you've been dismissive, judgmental, or unavailable. Maybe they themselves are afraid of driving you away with their "neediness". Maybe depending on you scares them.

Maybe they're mad at you. Or maybe they don't see emotional cheating the same way you do. Maybe they need lots of connection with a wide variety of people, whereas you don't. There could be a lot of reasons, and these reasons could overlap and shift with time.

Strong attachments activate a web of old wounds and longings mingled with present-day desires and fears that influence how we try to defend against painful or overwhelming emotions within us, and/ or against potentially uncomfortable experiences with an intimate partner. Emotional cheating is often one way we or our partners try to stay in control.

Not using tap water

Today's irons can handle tap water better than older models could. Unless your area's water is extremely hard, there's no reason to use distilled water. For areas with very hard tap water, mix it 50/50 with distilled.

Robert John Downey Jr. born April 4, 1965 is an American actor and producer. His career has been characterized by critical and popular success in his youth, followed by a period of substance abuse and legal troubles, before a resurgence of commercial success later in his career. In 2008, Downey was named by Time magazine among the 100 most influential people in the world, and from 2013 to 2015, he was listed by Forbes as Hollywood's highest-paid actor.

At the age of five, he made his acting debut in Robert Downey Sr.'s film Pound in 1970. He subsequently worked with the Brat Pack in the teen films Weird Science (1985) and Less than Zero (1987). In 1992, Downey portrayed the title character in the biopic Chaplin, for which he was nominated for the Academy Award for Best Actor and won a BAFTA Award. Following a stint at the Corcoran Substance Abuse Treatment Facility on drug charges, he joined the TV series Ally McBeal, for which he won a Golden Globe Award. He was fired from the show in the wake of drug charges in 2000 and 2001. He stayed in a court-ordered drug treatment program and has maintained his sobriety since 2003.

Initially, bond completion companies would not insure Downey, until Mel Gibson paid the insurance bond for the 2003 film The Singing Detective. He went on to star in the black comedy Kiss Kiss Bang Bang (2005), the thriller Zodiac (2007), and the action comedy Tropic Thunder (2008); for the latter he was nominated for an Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor. Downey gained global recognition for starring as Tony Stark / Iron Man in ten films within the Marvel Cinematic Universe, beginning with Iron Man (2008). He has also played the title character in Guy Ritchie's Sherlock Holmes (2009), which earned him his second Golden Globe, and its sequel, Sherlock Holmes: A Game of Shadows (2011). He became one of the highest paid actors through his pay checks from the MCU films he made.



The post was met with angry comments and some went on to state that the artist was not as good as South Africa's Makhadzi. They said her songs were too slow to get them grooving but Amantle would later on go to send another clarifying post to say that hers was not a post of jealousy nor was she against Makhadzi headlining a show and matter of fact she too was excited



that Makhadzi was coming to Botswana to perform. She said rather that she wanted to indicate that promoters should have local artist headlining the shows too as they were as much deserving.

The artist later that day dropped a single titled "Mjolo" and it went viral gaining her more views in a matter of hours than any other local artist had ever accomplished even in South Africa as well. However the people later on went to turn against Makhadzi after a fake post that circulated stating that she had turned down her coming to perform locally due to complaints by local artists. true pull-up begins in a dead hang. When you hang from the bar, your arms should be fully extended with your core engaged and shoulders back. Build strength by keeping form in mind

as you pull—it'll help you avoid swinging, kicking, and jumping, which means that you'll be using your muscles, not momentum, to master the move.

Get a Grip

Stand under the bar and grab it with both hands. Your palms should be facing away from you with hands shoulder-width apart. If you can't reach the bar, get a boost from a bench, stool, or box. Use a standard overhand grip, wrapping your thumbs around the bar so that they almost meet the tips of your fingers.

Pull (Up)

Initiate the actual pull by squeezing the bar with your hands while engaging the muscles of your upper body and core. Imagine pulling your elbows down to your sides as your entire body travels toward the bar. Resist the urge to strain your neck in an attempt to break the plane of the bar with your chin. Continue to pull until your chin clears the bar with ease, at which point the upward phase of the pullup is complete.

Get Down

You nailed the up part of the pull-up. But you still have to get down. The trick is to return

to the dead-hang slowly. Maintain a firm grip on the bar while allowing your arms to straighten as you lower. Once you return to the dead-hang, you can count your first rep. Cue shouting "Nailed it!" high-fiving yourself, pumping your fist triumphantly, all of the above, etc.
