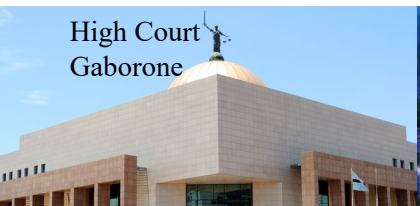

The young fellow who is a musician and famed Face booker or Feleb as is the common word for the Facebook famous folk is not just a joker in Facebook. He is an entrepreneur and a musician as well who has great opportunities in the music world within as short of the time as an upcoming artist. We recently had a chat together;

So who is Oska Bora Teachere?

Terrence Motlhalefi also known as OSKA BORA TEACHERE is a young boy aged 24 years from Molepolole doing music, comedy and entrepreneurship.

You are an artist, how long have you been?

I've been in the game since a laiti but became a professional artist I think 2/3 years ago and still killing it.

Why the name "Oska Bora Teachere"

The name OSKA BORA TEACHERE is a message to my students and fellow musicians to learn to respect their TEACHERS like me because all day all the time I'd be preaching nothing but FACTS unto the world and I know the truth hurts huh.

As musician what inspires you in making your music?

Hunger and Pain (I've been thru all and seen it all you know. But seeing myself not happy and hungry forced me to go in and win it all to help myself)

And speaking of music, what kind of music do you do?

As long as its good music I serve my fans but most of the times I'm into Gospel Rap and Trap music.

To this day how many songs have you released?

Approximately I have released close to 50 songs from my album that everybody knows, did an EP with my big brother (BIGRAWW) and I got too many features with other BW artists as a way of promoting UNITY.

Which one are you most famous by?

KE KGATHETSE mp3 from my album. The song also has a remix and music video. Performed it a couple of times on our national TV.

How is your career as of current in music?

My career so far is so good and I'm aspiring to become the artist I said I want to be when I started. Thank you God Always.

Being an upcoming artist, what are you doing to penetrate the music industry?

Hard work and determination to me means it all. Having faith in your own abilities and believing in yourself is nothing you can't accomplish.

What challenges have you gone through so far?

Being an independent artist with no start up capital and management is the worst because you are treated like a fool and you are treated like nothing.

How do you work by tackling them?

So far I have few individuals who believe in me and helping me achieve my goals (Individuals like Daniel Kenosi, Charma Gal, Berry Heart, Ron James to mention few) and also shout out all the fans out there you guys is my MVP'S.

What can you say as an artist you stand proud having achieved?

I have been to TV, Radio ,Big stages with the big dawgs, I have collaborated with the likes of Kast,Legacy DG ,Yung Amazing(From Khiring Khorong,I wear the most expensive Suits than no other did, had a lot of views on Overview podcast and the famous smash or pass by Latty) .THE LIST GOES ON.

As for your ambitions, what is your biggest ambition as an artist?

My ambition is to become an international and professional musician.

What projects are you at the moment working on?

The second album is dropping soon this time around we take it to channel O .

Any last words?

Everything is possible, don't you lose hope because Somebody said you can't do it...Wake up and go get it...Tell them that the only Teacher made it out the struggle and now I shine like the sun up.





A Gospel Artist Not Bound By The Rules

It is a known fact that when you a gospel artist there are ways you are expected to do things, or do your music. There places you are limited to perform and here in Botswana those rules seem to be strictly adhered to by the gospel artist. Well that has been the case until new kid on the block and hit maker arrived to the industry. The 24 year old gospel singer, Ezra Neethings as he is commonly known aside from being called the Danko artist, the hit song we all know him by came into the game but to be a little different than the others. The star has defied the rules by oddly performing in clubs, shows with no gospel artist and all through that he has experienced nothing but love from everyone and has surely impacted many.

According to him in the latest interview we had with him the gospel industry need to allow artists to be their creative selves while still spreading the word of God and spreading positivity as well. The afro gospel singer also has faith that he has yet to be a part player in rebranding or developing the industry and is yet to experience so much as an artist.

Tell me more about your background generally.

My name is Ezra Neethings, but formally I am called Esere Diloru and I was born on the 30th of August in 1998 from a Town named Selebe Phikwe.

When was your love for music discovered?

The love for music came when I started singing in church and that was around 2015. That's when I started feeling comfortable enough behind the mic and growing up I do not remember thinking if I was capable of singing, I was just a love developed from singing in church.

As a musician what inspired you to choose the gospel genre?

I love the gospel genre because it is true to me and since I developed that love in Church.

And speaking of the genre, what type of gospel do you make?

I actually can write any type of genre and types of gospel because it is broad, but when I started I started off with soft rock. I then shifted to the genre I do now which is Afro Gospel that has afro beats. The genre originates from Nigeria

Any particular reason behind that?

I chose that because it kind of resonates with a lot of people is common to a lot of countries in the African continent.

So as a recording artist how many songs and albums if there is any have you released?

I started my music in 2019 when I moved to South Africa and since then I have managed to release one album and the went on to release a since and I still have an EP on the way to be released soon which is called "The Neethings"

You became quite popular amongst Batswana through the hit, Danko, so what's the story behind that song?

Well there is not much of a story behind the song Danko which of course was released early this year, it is only that the word "danko" is a very commonly used word and I decided to make a song around the word just like that. I did have to use a sound or melody that kind of resonates with everyone.

How did it come by gaining so much popularity and love even among non-church goers?

Well as I said the song's melody kind of resonates with everyone, everywhere even in clubs and being recognised by everybody that's when you know that you have made good music as an artist which amazing which why afro beats is for me one of most comfortable zones I found in my music career.

So you stayed in SA for some time, was it for you to grow yourself musically?

Well my stay in South Africa was to go there to do music and ministry. As for now however I am really invested mostly into music and it's not that I have abandoned ministry, my music still serves as a way of ministering because there is positivity in it.

What is it you learnt on your stay in SA?

What I learnt in South Africa well there actually not much I can I learnt there apart from having had the opportunity for real exposure I my music as an artist and into many things and having a better view of how things are looking at how more developed a country like South Africa is.

Now coming back to our local music especially gospel, what can you say about it?

Well the gospel music industry in Botswana has so many rules, I think there just so many rules governing the genre here and when



you are a gospel artist you shouldn't have rules. You need to break out of the system and be able to explore greater heights, which is what I did with Danko. That when you know you will be stuck forever if you cannot break the rules in your creativity as an artist

Does it have the potential or it has a long way to go?

There is a lot of potential here and a lot that can be done but the thing is they are still tied to rules. We need to not be chained to anything in order to break free and do the best of our art as musicians.

What exactly is it that can be done to make the industry as big as just like it is in countries like South Africa?

Basically break the rules, as you know I can perform to clubs and the likes. Also gospel music is a very broad genre, its sometimes singing positivity not only always " God is," "father I pray" sticking by such rules, but once we decided to free from these kind of rules that is when the gospel genre will grow, which is what I try to do even with the song Danko.

What are you as an artist trying to do that is different in order to make the gospel industry better than it was yesterday or today?

I break the rules, the same way I perform in bars and not doing thing as is the norm in the gospel industry.

One notable thing about you is that unlike other gospel artists, you actually do perform in what could be considered bizarre places for gospel artists to perform, let's talk about that.

When I perform my music in different places I do so the way people are willing to accept it the way I give it out. Right now the song Danko has been able to reach 7.7 million streams, which quite huge especially for a gospel song. I do not think there has been any other local gospel song that has had such a huge success and this is only just a foundation not something I would consider the peak of what I can achieve, so do expect great things.

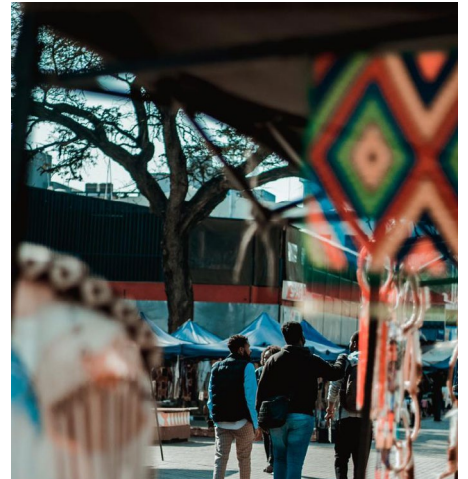
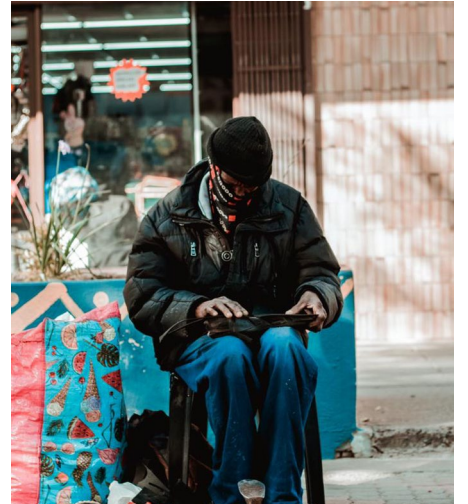

The Reign of Queen Elizabeth II

Elizabeth II was Queen of the United Kingdom and other Commonwealth realms from 6 February 1952 until her death on September this year. She was queen regnant of 32 sovereign states during her lifetime and 15 at the time of her death. Born Elizabeth Alexandra Mary in 21 April 1926 Queen Elizabeth reigned as the queen of Britain for 70 years. She reigned as the longest of any British monarch and the longest recorded of any female head of state in history.

Elizabeth was born in Mayfair, London, as the first child of the Duke and Duchess of York, later King George VI and Queen Elizabeth. Her father acceded to the throne in 1936 upon the abdication of his brother, King Edward VIII, making Elizabeth the heir presumptive. She was educated privately at home and began to undertake public duties during the Second World War, serving in the Auxiliary Territorial Service. In November 1947, she married Philip Mountbatten, a former prince of Greece and Denmark, and their marriage lasted 73 years until his death in April 2021. They had four children: Charles, Anne, Andrew, and Edward.

When her father died in February 1952, Elizabeth—then 25 years old—became queen of seven independent Commonwealth countries: the United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Pakistan, and Ceylon (known today as Sri Lanka), as well as Head of the Commonwealth. Elizabeth reigned as a constitutional monarch through major



political changes such as the Troubles in Northern Ireland, devolution in the United Kingdom, the decolonisation of Africa, and the United Kingdom's accession to the European Communities and withdrawal from the European Union. The number of her realms varied over time as territories gained independence and some realms became republics. Her many historic visits and meetings include state visits to China in 1986, Russia in 1994, and the Republic of Ireland in 2011, and meetings with five popes.

Significant events include Elizabeth's coronation in 1953 and the celebrations of her Silver, Golden, Diamond, and Platinum

jubilees in 1977, 2002, 2012, and 2022, respectively. Elizabeth was the longest-lived British monarch and the second-longest reigning sovereign in world history, behind only Louis XIV of France. She faced occasional republican sentiment and media criticism of her family, particularly after the breakdowns of her children's marriages, her *annus horribilis* in 1992, and the death of her former daughter-in-law Diana, Princess of Wales, in 1997. However, support for the monarchy in the United Kingdom remained consistently high, as did her personal popularity. Elizabeth died aged 96 at Balmoral Castle, Aberdeenshire in 2022, months after her Platinum Jubilee, and was succeeded by her eldest son, Charles III.

Cream Tea Scones

Preparation time: 7 mins

Bake time: 14 - 15 mins

Ingredients

3 cups (360g)

1 tablespoon baking powder

1 teaspoon salt

1/4 to 1/3 cup (50g to 67g) granulated sugar,
to taste

1 teaspoon

1 1/3 to 1 1/2 cups (301g to 340g) heavy
cream or whipping cream

Additional heavy cream, for brushing on
scones

Coarse sparkling sugar, for topping

Instructions

1. Preheat the oven to 425°F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
2. Whisk together the flour, baking powder, salt, and sugar.
3. Combine the vanilla with 1 1/3 cups cream. Drizzle the liquid mixture over the dry ingredients, tossing and stirring gently all the while. Add enough cream to make a cohesive dough, using up to 3 additional tablespoons if necessary. There shouldn't be any dry flour in the bottom of the bowl, but the dough shouldn't be particularly sticky, either.
4. Lightly flour a clean work surface. Divide the dough in half, and gently pat each half into a 5 1/2" circle about 3/4" thick.
5. Brush each circle with heavy cream, and sprinkle with coarse white sparkling sugar.
6. Place the two circles of dough on the baking sheet, and cut each into 6 wedges. Pull the wedges apart a bit, leaving them in a circular pattern with about 1" space between each wedge.
7. For best rising, place the pan of scones into the freezer for 15 minutes, while you preheat your oven to 425°F.
8. Bake the chilled scones for 14 to 15 minutes, until they're starting to brown, and they're baked all the way through, without any wet dough in the center.
9. Remove the scones from the oven. Serve warm, split and spread with a bit of sweet butter and jam or preserves.

Croatia, the Country worth Visiting This October

Croatia, officially the Republic of Croatia is a country at the crossroads of Central and Southeast Europe. It shares a coastline along the Adriatic Sea. It borders Slovenia to the northwest, Hungary to the northeast, Serbia to the east, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro to the southeast, and shares a maritime border with Italy to the west and southwest. Croatia's capital and largest city, Zagreb, forms one of the country's primary subdivisions, with twenty counties. The country spans an area of 56,594 square kilometers, hosting a population of nearly 3.9 million.

The Croats arrived in the late 6th century. By the 9th century, they had organized the territory into two duchies. Croatia was first internationally recognized as independent on 7 June 879 during the reign of Duke Branimir. Tomislav became the first king by 925, elevating Croatia to the status of a kingdom. During the succession crisis after the Trpimirović dynasty ended, Croatia entered a personal union with Hungary in 1102. In 1527, faced with Ottoman conquest, the Croatian Parliament elected Ferdinand I of Austria to the Croatian throne. In October 1918, the State of Slovenes,

Croats and Serbs, independent from Austria-Hungary, was proclaimed in Zagreb, and in December 1918, merged into the Kingdom of Yugoslavia. Following the Axis invasion of Yugoslavia in April 1941, most of Croatia was incorporated into a Nazi-installed puppet state, the Independent State of Croatia. A resistance movement led to the creation of the Socialist Republic of Croatia, which after the war became a founding member and constituent of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia. On 25 June 1991, Croatia declared independence, and the War of Independence was successfully fought over the subsequent four years.

Croatia is classified by the World Bank as a high-income economy and ranks highly on the Human Development Index. Service, industrial sectors, and agriculture dominate the economy, respectively. Tourism is a significant source of revenue for the country, which is ranked among the 20 most popular tourist destinations. The state controls a part of the economy, with substantial government expenditure. The European Union is Croatia's most important trading partner. Croatia provides social security, universal health care, and tuition-free primary and secondary

education while supporting culture through public institutions and corporate investments in media and publishing.

Tourism

Dubrovnik is one of Croatia's most popular tourist destinations.

Zlatni Rat beach on the Island of Brač is one of the foremost spots of tourism in Croatia. Tourism dominates the Croatian service sector and accounts for up to 20% of GDP. Tourism income for 2019 was estimated to be €10.5 billion. Its positive effects are felt throughout the economy, increasing retail business, and increasing seasonal employment. The industry is counted as an export business because foreign visitor spending significantly reduces the country's trade imbalance. The tourist industry has rapidly grown, recording a fourfold rise in tourist numbers since independence, attracting more than 11 million visitors each year. Germany, Slovenia, Austria, Italy, Poland and Croatia itself provide the most visitors. Tourist stays averaged 4.7 days in 2019.

Much of the tourist industry is concentrated along the coast. Opatija was the first holiday resort. It first became popular in the middle

of the 19th century. By the 1890s, it had become one of the largest European health resorts. Resorts sprang up along the coast and islands, offering services catering to mass tourism and various niche markets. The most significant are nautical tourism, supported by marinas with more than 16 thousand berths, cultural tourism relying on the appeal of medieval coastal cities and cultural events taking place during the summer. Inland areas offer agrotourism, mountain resorts, and spas. Zagreb is a significant destination, rivalling major coastal cities and resorts. Croatia has unpolluted marine areas with nature reserves and 116 Blue Flag beaches. Croatia ranks as the 23rd most popular tourist destination in the world. About 15% of these visitors, or over one million per year, participate in naturism, for which Croatia is famous. It was the first European country to develop commercial naturist resorts.

Languages

Map of the Shtokavian, Chakavian and Kajkavian dialects in Croatia by municipality Croatian is the official language of Croatia and became the 24th official language of the European Union upon its accession in 2013. Minority languages are in official use in local government units where more than a third of the population consists of national minorities or where local enabling legislation applies. Those languages are Czech, Hungarian, Italian, Serbian, and Slovak. The following minority languages are also recognised: Albanian, Bosnian, Bulgarian, German, Hebrew, Macedonian, Montenegrin, Polish, Romanian, Istro-Romanian, Romani, Russian, Rusyn, Slovene, Turkish, and Ukrainian.

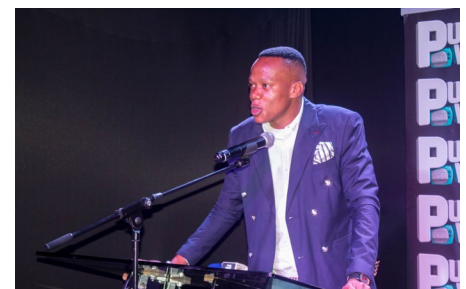

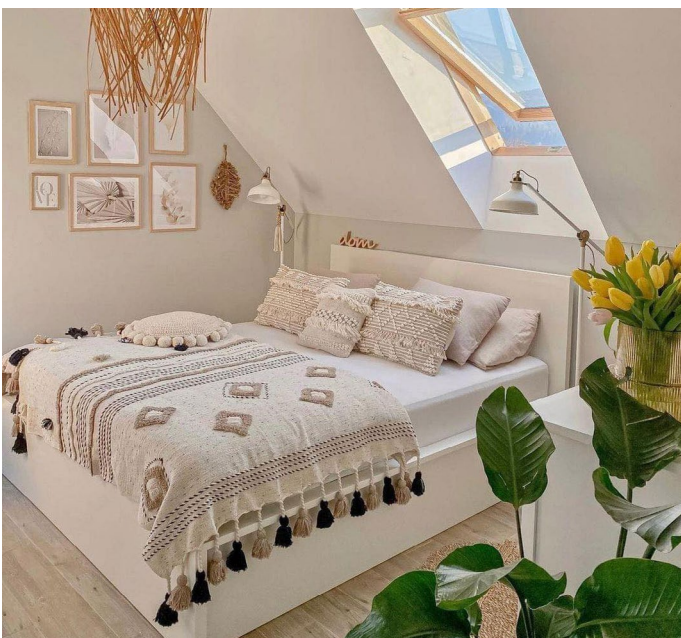
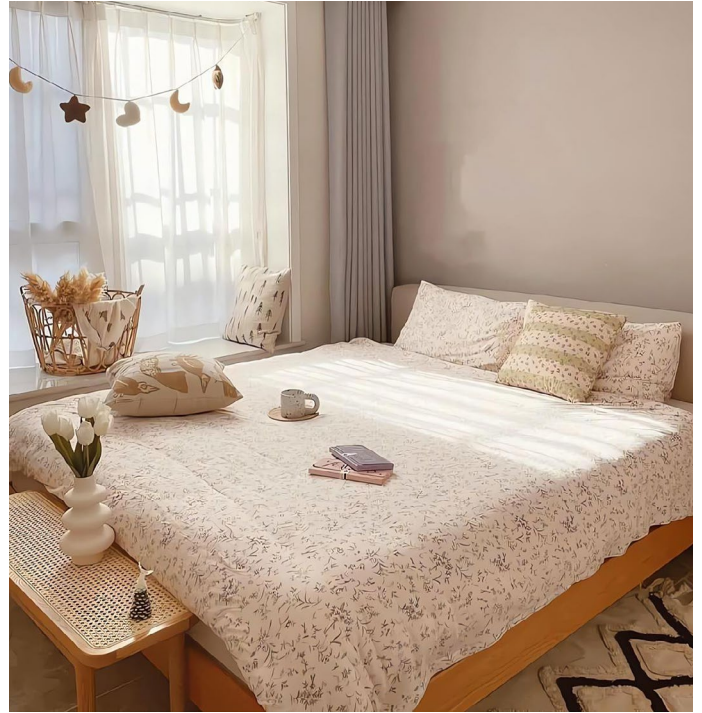

Manyana Rock Paintings

Manyana is one of the few rock art sites that make us think beyond Tsodilo Hills in terms of rock art. It is one of the most accessible sites in Botswana. The significant thing about Manyana is that rock paintings are very rare in the southeast of Botswana.

Manyana Rock Paintings is situated 35km on the west of Gaborone, in the outskirts of Manyana Village. The paintings were declared a national monument and are well preserved. The rock art depicts various animals like the rhino, antelope and gemsbok amongst others.

Possibly the most visited rock painting site in the Gaborone area, the paintings are spread over five separate areas of rock cliff face. Images include giraffe, antelope, human figures and geometric designs, all of which date from between 1100 and 1700AD. They were in all likelihood made by Khoe (click-speaking) herders. The site is fenced, and you can only gain entry through the custodian. At the south end of the village stands Livingstone's Tree, under which the great explorer is said to have preached. This old, massive fig tree – now fenced off, rests on its branches that now touch the ground.

Home Remedies to Get Rid of Acne Overnight

1. Garlic

Garlic has antiseptic properties that can fight off bacteria invading your skin. In addition to that, it also contains natural components like sulfur known to quickly heal acne. To use it as an acne home remedy, slice a garlic clove into two. You can then rub the garlic and its juice directly to your pimples. Leave it for five minutes before washing with lukewarm water. 2. Cucumber

Option # 3: To make a facial mask, mix grated cucumber with one cup of oatmeal. You can then combine this mixture with some amount of plain yogurt to give a smoother consistency. Apply the mask for about 30 minutes before rinsing with lukewarm water.

3. Toothpaste

Toothpaste basically works like your ordinary facial mask. If applied directly to the affected

area, the toothpaste will help in drying up the pimples and absorbing excess oil. This is a very effective acne home remedy for people suffering from mild forms of acne like whiteheads or blackheads. However, toothpastes made from gel or those containing whitening properties should be avoided at all cost. These products contain hydrogen peroxide and other chemicals that can harm sensitive skin.

Before applying toothpaste on your skin, apply an ice pack to the affected area just to soothe your pores. You can then apply small amounts of toothpaste to the pimples and let it stay for at least 30 minutes before rinsing.

4. Honey

To use honey as an acne home remedy, dip a cotton swab in the honey and then apply it to the affected area. Leave it for at least 30 minutes before rinsing.

5. Lemon Juice

Apple cider vinegar is best used for spot treating acne. Simply dab a few drops of diluted ACV on your pimples overnight and you'll be able to see a huge difference the morning after. Aside from pimples, this remedy works great on age spots and acne scars as well.


7. Green Tea

STEPS TO HELP KIDS RESOLVE CONFLICTS

Kids have become less adept at solving their problems and conflicts. They are quick to involve adults and call other kids names. That is why it is very crucial for parents to teach their kids on ways they can resolve conflicts as this helps them to thrive in relationships and life.

Calm Down

Give everyone a chance to take a breather from each other. Ask them each what they need to do to calm down. Like walking away and taking a break for a few minutes, counting to 10, or writing down some feelings. In any case, nothing coherent will come from trying to lead a discussion with upset, emotionally fragile kids. So, ask them to figure out the best way to calm down before attempting to solve the problem.

State & Understand the Problem

Once calm has prevailed, talk to each child

and help them state their problem. Stress the importance of being honest and admitting their role in the conflict. Encourage them to use "I" statements to express their feelings. For example, "I felt left out and hurt because he wouldn't let me play the card game, so I threw his towel to annoy him."

Apologize Well

A good apology will communicate three things: regret, responsibility, and remedy. Apologizing for a mistake might seem difficult, but it will help you repair and improve your relationships with others. Encourage each child or only one, depending on the circumstances to come up with a good apology. Writing it down before they say it can be a good start, and that letter can be given to the child with whom they are in conflict. Or, with a younger child, take some notes that they can then use as they apologize.

Promote Solution Finding

Empower children to brainstorm solutions to their conflict. It is so tempting as an all-knowing adult to generate solutions, but something the kids think up and agree upon on their own will more likely work. Encourage each child to listen carefully and to accurately paraphrase each other. Encourage them to speak honestly and kindly to each other.

Follow Up

Follow up with the children to see how they are getting along and if the solution they came up with is working. But if the talk together/work it out strategy is not working for this pair, it is best to find someone else to hang out with. Even if the kids appear to need a prolonged break from one another, they will still be required to speak in a kind and respectful way when they are interacting.

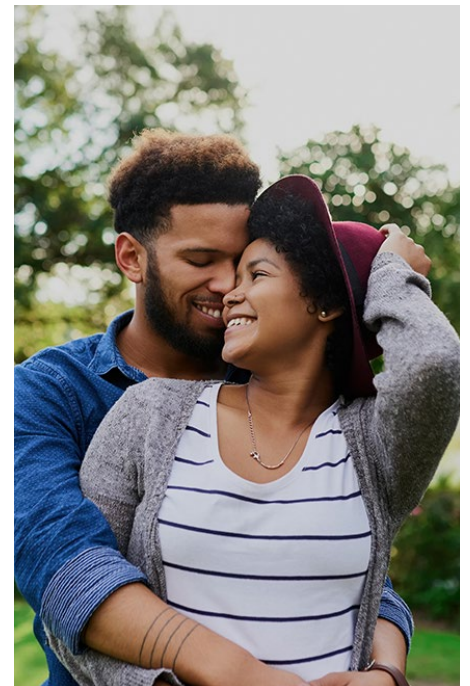

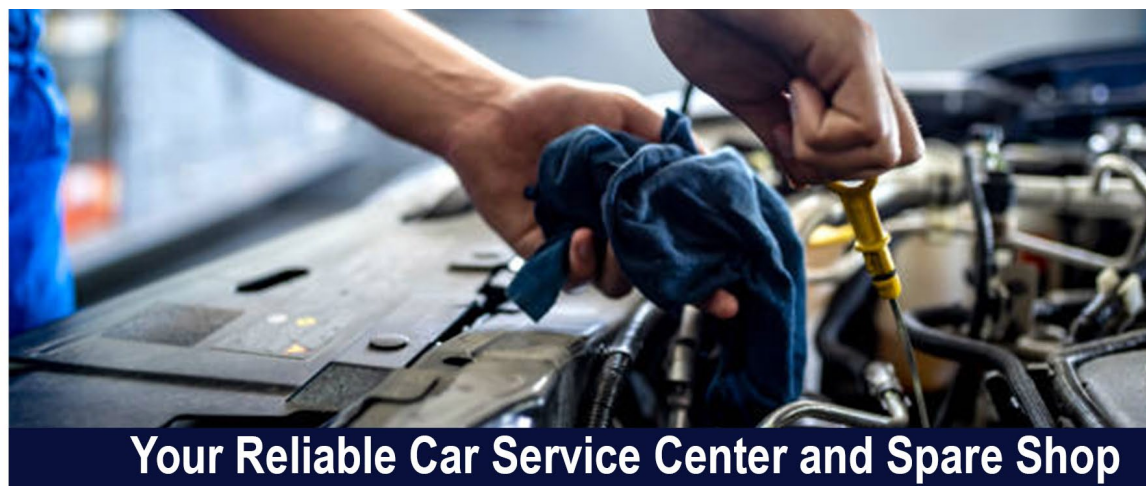

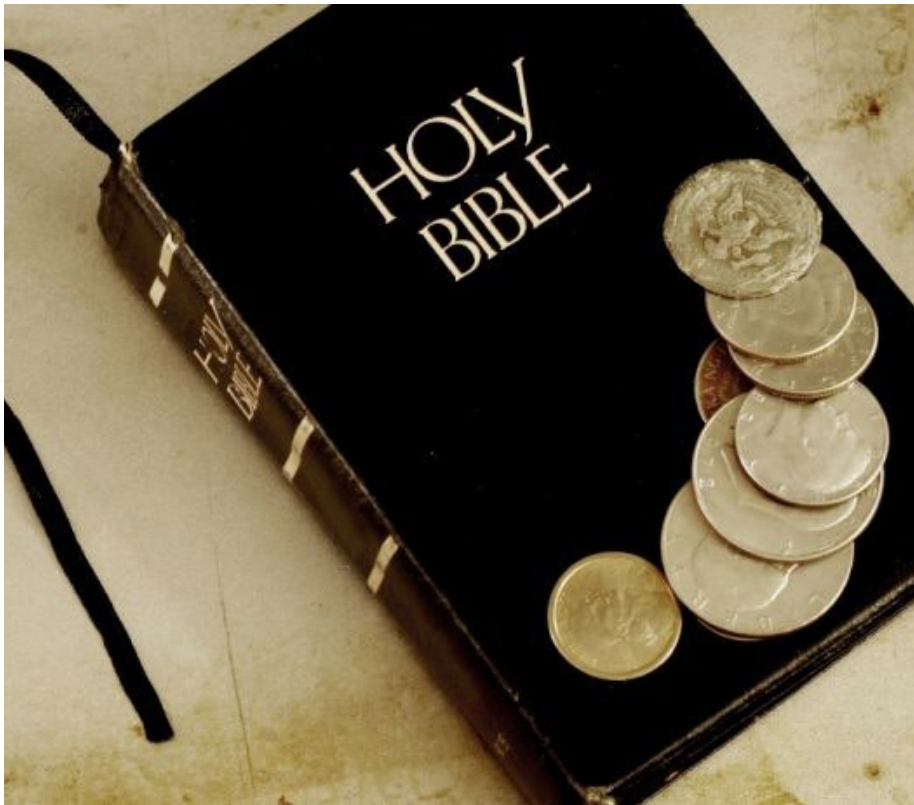

Money Is a Dreadful Master

In fact, money can provoke such all-consuming desire in us that Jesus describes it as a would-be master of our lives: “No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money.” It seems a bit extreme, doesn’t it? Can money really rule us? And who said anything about serving money, what does that even mean?

Well, consider what Jesus says just a few verses earlier: “Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”³² This concept is key: Money can control us by ruling over our hearts and dominating our desires. We invest in what we love and we love what we invest in. The more you strive to own money, the more money will own you.

The Apostle Paul makes a similar point when he writes, “Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.”³³ Idolatry is the worship of false gods. How, then, does covetousness equal idolatry? Because it involves directing the total devotion intended to be given only to God toward something that isn’t God. When you covet money or possessions, you can’t be satisfied without them. You’re effectively saying that God himself isn’t as satisfying as the thing you want—and obtaining that thing is more important than obeying or pursuing God.

This is how money can rule us. But money, with its empty promises, is a terrible master. If we seek satisfaction in money, we will never find it. And when it comes to saving, giving and debt, it’s no different. The world says one thing, but the Bible points to a better way—ways that glorifies God and actually helps us live fuller, more joyful lives (Galatians 6:8)! Hey, we get it. It’s tough trying to resist the world’s ways when it comes to money. We’ve all experienced temptation in that area and have buckled at some point. That’s why keeping God’s desire for our finances front of mind is so important. God says: Pay yourself by saving. Then enjoy the fruits of your labor.

What Does The Bible Say About Money?

The Bible is full of advices, but what does it say about how we should handle our money? Take a deeper look at the following points:

Money Is a Major Temptation

Even though money is a good gift from God, the Bible teaches that it can also be a serious temptation. Why? Because it promises to deliver everything we desire. Want comfort? Security? Fun? Fulfillment? Power? Sex? Money seems like the universal key that unlocks all the doors to happiness. But this is a lie.

The Bible constantly unmask the false promises of money. Money promises security, but it can’t protect you against God’s judgment. Money promises lasting happiness, but it can disappear overnight and you can’t take it with you when you die, anyway.²⁴ Money promises freedom and ease, but it brings anxiety and worry: the more you have, the more you have to lose.

Money Is a Noble Gift

Money is what you earn by working, and money is what you use to obtain provisions. Money is how you sustain your own life and the lives of those for whom you’re responsible. In other words, money is a good gift from God because it is both a reward for the work he himself commands us to do and a means of sustaining the life he has given to us. As a result, the Bible often portrays wealth as the result of hard work, honesty, and wisdom. Just take a look at this sampling from the book of Proverbs: “Lazy hands make for poverty, but diligent hands bring wealth.”¹³ “Dishonest money dwindles away, but whoever gathers money little by little makes it grow.”¹⁴ “The lazy do not roast any game, but the diligent feed on the riches of the hunt.”¹

So, as you can see, material prosperity is not singularly fated in Scripture. Nowhere in the Bible does it say that a person cannot be wealthy and still love God. Actually, a

What is Low Blood

Low blood also known as Hypotension. It is when your blood pressure is lower than expected. This means the heart and other parts of the body do not get enough blood. Normal blood pressure is mostly between 90/60 mmHg and 120/ 80 mmHg (millimeters of mercury).

Symptoms of Low Blood

The most common symptoms includes;

- Dizziness
- Fainting
- Rapid and shallow breathing
- Agitation or unusual change in behavior
- Unsteadiness

Causes of Low Blood

Blood loss; Losing a lot of blood by any means may reduce blood volume which may cause drop in blood pressure.

Anaphylaxis; is a severe allergic reaction. It can cause the immune system to release floods of chemicals which can affect your body to go in shock hence decrease in blood pressure.

Dehydration; when the body does not have enough water, it automatically leads to sudden decrease in blood volume.

Lack of nutrients; lower levels of vitamins like vitamins B -12, folate and iron can keep the body from producing enough red blood cells, which leads to sudden reduction in blood pressure.

Pregnancy; Low blood is very common in

the first 24 weeks of pregnancy. Changes during pregnancy causes blood vessels to expand which makes the blood pressure to drops.

Prevention

Here are the few guidelines which may help to prevent low blood;

Manage your diet; eat small, low carbs meals.

Exercise regularly; get involved in activities that can help with blood circulation. However be vigilant, do not overdue exercising because some workouts activities may be the cause of low blood.

Drink water; water helps to prevent dehydration. Drinking water on a regular basis may help to boost your blood count.

Fish Farming

About two years ago, we learnt that Botswana imports approximately 3000 tons of fish per annum while the local fish farm production is roughly 100 tons. Looking at this, the Ministry of Agriculture acted on it by introducing forums to promote fish farming Botswana. The good thing about fish farming is that, it can be successful even in areas where there are no major water sources such as rivers or dams. Any person who does fish farming will surely make profit from it because it is profitable.

How to start fish farming

1. Select a good area of land

Minimum land required is about 50 acres or more. For a local working agriculturist, even a 5-acre farm is feasible.

2. Construct a pond

The cost to build a pond depends on its size and it varies based on a variety of factors. Some factors affecting price are size, depth and whether there are fish.

3. Select the type of fish you would like to farm

Tilapia is the easiest fish to farm. Tastes great and is one of the easiest fish to raise. Tilapia tolerate a wide variety of water conditions, including low oxygen levels and high concentrations of ammonia, and are resistant to diseases and parasites.

4. Feed the fish

Fishmeal is a natural and well-balanced source of high-quality protein. As ingredients in aquaculture feed, fishmeal and fish oil supply essential amino acids and fatty acids reflected in the normal diet of fish.

5. Fish harvesting

Usually it takes about six months to harvest fish because they will be big enough. After five months you may catch a few big fish each week to eat with your family. When most of the fish are big enough it is time to harvest all of them and start marketing to make profit.

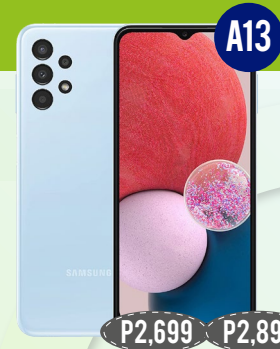

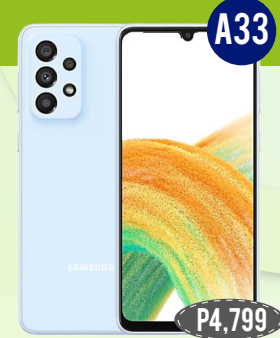

This is by far the easiest way of maintaining

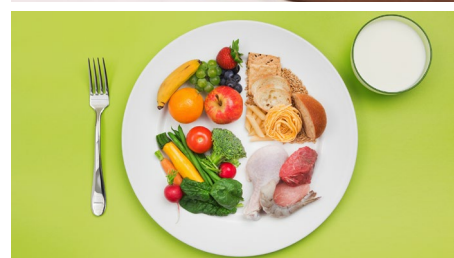

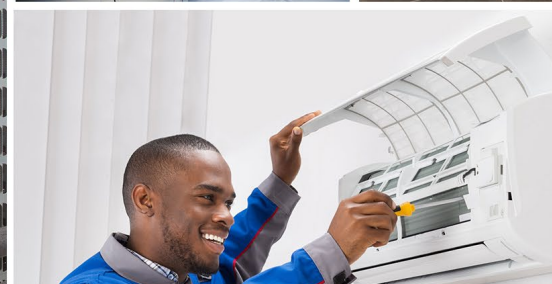
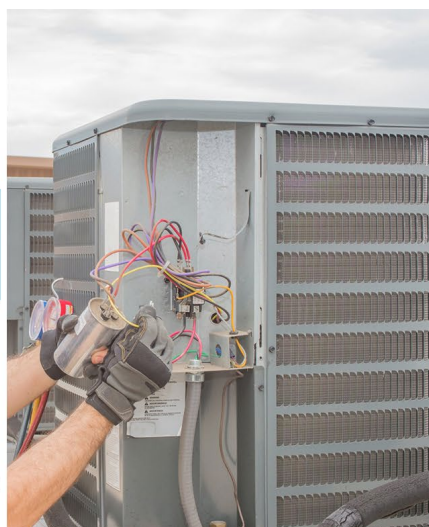
