Meet The Face Behind Decade Artworks

His official names are Kefentse Keboitse, he is 30 years of age, born and raised in Serowe but currently lives in Molepolole. Throughout his journey as an artist, a name "Jakamotako" emerged which is simply an expression which defines him best as he relies on his creatives to earn a living.

Tell us about your art business and the journey behind it.

My drawings serves best as gifts, over the past 7 years my drawings have brought about joy and happiness in many homes and many relationships, as clients kept on engaging my services in order to gift their loved ones. Within the period I also produced some drawings that were shipped to Maun region, also as gifts.

When did you start doing art, and what materials do you use to do your work?

My Journey in Art draws back to my junior

and senior school days, I always loved this ability to produce and think of ideas that can be identified as art. Several years later in 2016, I decided to try and sell art after seeing some of the artists doing it on social media space, and that's how the journey of Jakamotako began.

The material that I mostly use is Faber Castel Coloured pencils, because they give a very great and intense results when carefully working with them.

How is the business doing since you started it?

Well, currently the business is kind of slow because the year has just began and most of my potential clients are engaged with other demands of life, which is normal since I have experienced this over the years in this art production and selling business.

How do you approach your customers,

selling strategies u use?

Most of the time I use social media space to advertise my business, and I always make sure to avail different options with different costs to my clients which makes it target a larger group of people.

Is artwork your everyday work or there is something else you are doing for a living?

Yes, Art is the backbone of my life, which is reflected in my name "Jakamotako". That is, for me to eat I have to seat down and produce art and for me to dress up, I have to seat down and produce art.

How many artworks have you sold so far?

I have by far produced and distributed over 450 drawings across the country, having to have distributed to prominent figures like Obakeng Mmipi, and former Miss Botswana 2006 Malebogo Marumoagae. Few were shipped outside the country through my local clients.

Who are your clients?

Since I have mentioned that I target a larger group through providing options for my clients, you will find that those who are not able to afford an A3 sized usually opt for an A4 Sized. So my clients ranges from ordinary individuals who are willing to make their loved ones happy, to prominent individuals who display interest and are captivated by my execution skills.

Share your achievements about your business since its inception e.g any award you have received?

Well, my art business have not yet scored any visible award yet, maybe it could be because I'm still in the process of registering and establishing it well, but however for now, I would speak of the great growth in the circle of reaching people and also how my production skill has intensified over the last seven years.

What do you call this type of art you are doing?

In Art, it is drawing under fine art. But I'm more of a portraiture than just a general artist because I specialize in the production and distribution of portrait art.

Are you doing art as a passion or just because you wanted to do it for money or for a living?

Producing art is my passion, and being able to make money out of it is just like an icing on a cake and it makes everything guite easy for me, because now I'm able to get proper materials for my creative skill, and automatically my skill will grow and also presentation of my works will also show improvements. This presentations, I speak of things like packaging, framing and delivery.

What is your business name and where is it located?

My business is currently going by the name "Decade Artworks" the nicest thing about it is that my production skill is always with me everywhere I go, and now since I'm in Molepolole, Decade Artworks operates in Molepolole.

What are your last words to other young artists hoping to make it in the art industry?

My last words: I encourage other artists to recognize and appreciate their talents, then practice more to invite growth, because we are living in a very competitive world where unemployment is the topic of the day, so your gift of talent can be the only thing that can assist you through your day to day lifestyle, and that gift has to be producing something worthy.

Remembering AKA

AKA, was a South African rapper, born and raised in Cape Town, Forbes gained recognition after releasing his single "Victory Lap" from his debut studio album, Altar Ego. The death of Kiernan Jarryd Forbes left family members and friends emotional and traumatized after the heart breaking announcement and when the footage of his shooting surfaced on how he was killed on social media. The send-off of AKA was done privately although some of his fans managed to attend the memorial service which was held on the 17th of February 2023.

Cause of his death

On the 10th of February 2023, AKA was scheduled to perform at Yugo nightclub in Durban as part of his birthday celebrations. At around 10 P.M. that night, Forbes and his friends were standing outside a restaurant in South Africa when a hooded gunman ran up to them and shot Forbes in the head, while his accomplice who was standing by Forbes's car released more shots which killed his friend. The two gunmen then fled the scene on foot. Forbes his friend were pronounced dead at the scene.



Don Design Deletes Facebook Account Amidst Acusations Of Giving Signal To Aka's Shooters

South Africa's creative designer, Disc Jocky and Singer Don Design has deleted his Facebook account after being accused of knowing the plan to have his close friend Kerlian Forbes known as AKA to be assassinated.

According to the videos that have gone viral on social media, Don Design is seen making eye contacts with the shooters who were standing straight at him, before giving a signal that they should start advancing to have the rapper killed.

It is believed that Don Design Who looked at the shooter who was on the other side of the road signaled and he started moving slowly by passing a car that was near the artist.

He then gave a stretch signal before moving quickly to join the group as shooters pulled the trigger to end the life of a popular South African hip hop artist.

Don Design is the only friend to AKA who was seen closing his ears immediately gun shots were fired.

What many South Africans are surprised of is that, the first shooter who was in the white hoodie was looking at Don Design and immediately he stretched, the shooter advanced and the rest is history. Don Design has however deleted his Facebook account remaining with his Instagram account after accusations.

It is not clear if he deleted his Facebook account following multiple tagging or it is out of respect for his close friend AKA. Don Design is seen taking a selfie with AKA minutes before his assassination. Source: FB

Born on October 28, 1947 and died on June 15, 2010, Victoria Busisiwe Mhlongo, was a singer, dancer and composer originally from Inanda in Natal, South Africa.

Mhlongo drew on various South African styles such as Mbaqanga, Maskanda, Marabi and traditional Zulu, fused with contemporary elements from jazz, funk, rock, gospel, rap, opera, reggae and West African music. Her lyrics carry poignant messages and she had a carefree way of performance that included performing bare-foot.

In the 1960s, she adopted the artistic name Vickie; only later did she become known by Busi Mhlongo. She was an initiated sangoma, which heavily influenced her music.

In the 1970s, Mhlongo relocated to London, later recording with other South African artists who were living in exile, such as Dudu Pukwana and Julian Bahula. By the 1980s, she performed internationally, performing with other well-renowned artists such as Salif Keita.

By the early 1990s, she began releasing her own individual works, with her first album, Barbentu, being released in 1993. A year later, she joined Hugh Masekela's homecoming tour.

In 1995, Mhlongo joined Hugh Masekela in the Africa '95 festival in London. In 1998, she released her second album, Urban Zulu, which became a hit in various markets around the world and reportedly spent months in the Billboard World Music charts. She went on to release several more albums, Freedom (2003), and Amakholwa before her death from breast cancer in June 2010. Although physical-self isn't around, her energetic style of performance remains and can be seen through choreographer Somizi Mhlongo. Her music is a symbolism of the struggle for justice in South Africa. Her vocal range is incredible for she was able to go from a soft note to a booming roar. Due to her powerful activism against apartheid through music. Mhlongo was exiled therefore working and living in the Netherlands, North America and the UK. Busi sold half-a-dozen



solo albums. Later during her career she became known as "Mam'Busi". During her youth, she joined the musical King Kong in Durban and was encouraged to play the drums. Her creativity launched her decision to create her band, Twasa. Her style of performance was inspired by Dorothy Masuka and Miriam Makeba, but mostly Princess Magogo.

Mhlongo was raised in a musically inclined family in the mountain village of Ohlange. She married drummer Early Mabuza, and they later had a daughter. Due to Mhlongo's exile, she was unable to raise her daughter or attend the funeral of her husband, whose cause of death was murder



ising abruptly, and dramatically, from the Kalahari scrub bush the rock face turning a copper colour in the dying sun the magnetic power of Tsodilo Hills both captivates and mystifies. There is an undeniable spiritualism about the Hills that immediately strikes the visitor.

Tsodilo is located in north-western Botswana. It gained its World Heritage Site listing in 2001 because of its unique religious and spiritual significance to local peoples, as well as its unique record of human settlement over many millennia. It contains over 4,500 rock paintings in an area of approximately 10 km² within the Kalahari Desert.

These hills are of great cultural and spiritual significance to the San peoples of the Kalahari. They believe the hills are a resting place for the spirits of the deceased and that these spirits will cause misfortune and bad luck if anyone hunts or causes death near the hills. The San people believe these hills to be the site of first Creation. Factually, the San people painted more than 4500 rock paintings against the magnificent stone faces of the Tsodilo Hills, making it one of the most historically significant art sites in the world. The San did most of the paintings, although there are few by Bantu-speakers whose style differs from that of the San. The exact age of the paintings is not known although some are thought to be more than 20,000 years

old. The hills contain 500 individual sites representing thousands of years of human habitation.


The hills are referred to by human attributes - male, female, child and the male's first wife. The second tallest hill is referred to as the female. The San people believe that the caves and caverns of this hill, the "Female" hill, are the resting places of the deceased and various gods who rule the world from here. The people of Hambukushu believe that their god, Nyambe, originally lowered their tribe and livestock to earth on the female hill. Their supporting evidence is hoof-prints clearly etched into a rock, high on the hill. (The word Tsodilo is derived from



the Hambukushu word 'sorile' which means sheer.) In the northwest part of the female hill, some distance up from ground level is an old mine that has filled with water. This water is considered to be holy water and confers good luck on those that wash their faces with it. The most sacred place is near the top of the "Male" hill, the biggest rock, where it is said that the First Spirit knelt and prayed after creating the world. The San believe that you may still see the impression of the First Spirits' knees in the rock. The smallest hill is the 'child'. The fourth hill was the male hill's first wife, whom he left for a younger woman, and who now prowls in the background.

There are numerous rock art paintings in the Tsodilo Hills. Most of the San rock paintings are found on the "Female" hill, the most famous being the "Whale" painting, "Two Rhinos" and the "Lion" on the Eastern face of the "Father". Some of the paintings have been dated to be as early as 24,000 years before present. There are numerous paintings, but relatively few on the outlying hills. There are so many paintings in obscure places that it is very unlikely they have all been discovered or documented.





Located in north-west Botswana near the Namibian Border in Okavango Sub-District, the Tsodilo Hills are a small area of massive quartzite rock formations that rise from ancient sand dunes to the east and a dry fossil lake bed to the west in the Kalahari Desert. The Hills have provided shelter and other resources to people for over 100,000 years.

The archaeological record of the site gives a chronological account of human activities and environmental changes over at least 100,000 years, although not continuously. Often large and imposing rock paintings exist in the shelters and caves, and although not accurately dated appear to span from the Stone Age right through to the 19th century. In addition, within the site sediments, there is considerable information pertaining to the paleo-environment. This combination provides an insight into early ways of human life, and how people interacted with their environment both through time and space. The local communities revere Tsodilo as a place of worship and as a home for ancestral spirits. Its water holes and hills are revered as a sacred cultural landscape, by the Hambukushu and San communities.



Alanya is a beach resort city and a district of Antalya Province on the southern coast of Turkey, in the country's Mediterranean Region, 133 kilometres (83 mi) east of the city of Antalya. As of Turkey's 2010 census, the city had a population of 98,627, while the district that includes the city and its built-up region had an area of 1,598.51 km2 and 248,286 inhabitants.

Alanya's greatest political importance came in the Middle Ages, with the Seljuk Sultanate of Rûm under the rule of Alaeddin Kayqubad I, from whom the city derives its name. His building campaign resulted in many of the city's landmarks, such as the Kızıl Kule (Red Tower), Tersane (Shipyard), and Alanya Castle.

Mediterranean climate, natural attractions, and historic heritage make Alanya a popular destination for tourism, and responsible for nine percent of Turkey's tourism sector and thirty percent of foreign purchases of real estate in Turkey. Tourism has risen since 1958 to become the dominant industry in the city, resulting in a corresponding increase in city population. Warm-weather sporting events and cultural festivals take place annually in Alanya. In 2014 Mayor Adem Murat Yücel, of the Nationalist Movement Party unseated Hasan Sipahioğlu, of the Justice and Development Party, who had previously led the city since

1999. Adem Murat Yücel continues his duty as the Mayor of Alanya Municipality.

The city has changed hands many times over the centuries, and its name has reflected this. Alanya was known in Latin as Coracesium or in Greek as Korakesion from the Luwian Korakassa meaning "point/protruding city". The Roman Catholic Church still recognizes the Latin name as a titular see in its hierarchy. Under the Byzantine Empire it became known as Kalonoros or Kalon Oros, meaning "beautiful/fine mountain" in Greek. The Seljuks renamed the city Alaiye, a derivative of the Sultan Alaeddin Kayqubad I's name. In the 13th and 14th centuries, Italian traders called the city Candelore or Cardelloro. In his 1935 visit, Mustafa Kemal Atatürk finalized the name in the new alphabet as Alanya, changing the 'i' and 'e' in Alaiye, reportedly because of a misspelled telegram in 1933. Located on the Gulf of Antalya on the Anatolian coastal plain of Pamphylia, the town is situated between the Taurus Mountains to the north and the Mediterranean Sea, and is part of the Turkish Riviera, occupying roughly 70 kilometres (43 mi) of coastline.

From west to east, the Alanya district is bordered by the Manavgat district along the coast, the mountainous Gündoğmuş inland, Hadim and Taşkent in the Province of Konya, Sarıveliler in the Province of Karaman, and the coastal Gazipaşa district. Manavgat is home to the ancient cities of Side and Selge. East of the city, the Dim River flows from the mountains in Konya on a south-west route into the Mediterranean.

Alanva has typical hot-summer Mediterranean climate, or a humid subtropical climate. Located at the Mediterranean Basin, the subtropical high pressure zone ensures that most rain comes during the winter, leaving the summers long, hot, and dry, prompting the Alanya board of Tourism to use the slogan "where the sun smiles". Storm cells sometimes bring with them fair weather waterspouts when close to the shore. The presence of the Taurus Mountain in close proximity to the sea causes fog, in turn creating visible rainbows many mornings. The height of the mountains creates an interesting effect as snow can often be seen on them even on hot days. Alanya's culture is a subculture of the larger Culture of Turkey. The city's seaside position is central to many annual festivals. These include the Tourism and Arts Festival, which

Culture of Turkey. The city's seaside position is central to many annual festivals. These include the Tourism and Arts Festival, which marks the opening of the tourism season from at the end of May or beginning of June. At the opposite end of the season, the Alanya International Culture and Art Festival is held in the last week of May, and is a notable Turkish festival. Other regular festivals include the Alanya Jazz Days, which has been held since 2002 in September or October at



the Kızıl Kule, which is otherwise home to the municipal ethnographic museum. The Jazz Festival hosts Turkish and international jazz musicians in a series of five free concerts.

Alanya is home to a woman's basketball team, Alanya Belediye, which started in the first division but was relegated after the 2002 season. The city hosts a Süper Lig soccer team, Alanyaspor. The club was founded in 1948, and play home games at Milli Egemenlik Stadium. It played in the Second League between 1988-1997 and 2014–2016. The club finally promoted to top level in 2015–16 season. In 2007, the city began constructing a new soccer facility with the intention of hosting winter competitions between major teams. The public Alanya Municipality Sports Facility is located adjacent to Milli Egemenlik Stadium, which is one of thirteen facilities.

Planting is easy, just scatter a packet of rice seed onto the soil, cover lightly and allow it to germinate in place. The seedlings will sprout within a week of sowing. The plants will develop leaves through the summer for 50-85 days after sowing, depending on the variety you grow.

Rice feeds more than half of the world's inhabitants. No other crop feeds so many people, supports so many farmers, or is as crucial to our global environment.

The best month to plant rice is

March - Early August in most countries. Rice plants grow to a height of three to four feet over an average of 120 days after planting. During this time, farmers irrigate the rice fields using the method that best fits that field or farm.

Rice will grow best in full sun and in a waterlogged environment similar to a flooded field. You can grow your rice in gallon buckets, a raised bed like a garden box, or you can create long troughs in the soil in your garden bed that can be filled with water.

Spacing of 22.5 x 22.5 cm2

between hills and rows is most suitable for obtaining optimum grain yields in the rice crop. There are two methods of planting rice: direct seeding and transplanting. Direct seeding is either by broadcast, hill or dibble, or by drill method. The hill and the drill methods are alternative options in row planting.

When choosing the suitable planting method, consider; the locality, type of soil, rice ecosystem, and availability of inputs and labor, should be considered. Choosing when to plant is crucial to establishing the crop in the field.

One would wonder what really makes rice grow faster, the fact; nitrogen Excess. Nitrogen application in sufficient amount helps rice grow faster and provide us with high-quality grains. However, many farmers apply a larger amount than the one that rice needs. There are around four methods of cultivating rice, broadcasting, drilling, transplantation and Japanese method. Rice can be grown all year round and annually it is possible to grow at most three crops in a year.

The buyer should go through the terms and conditions of the contract and after sale service available to the online shopper.



Rear Reshaper Work butt, thighs

Start on all fours, knees under hips, hands slightly in front of shoulders. Lift right knee to side at hip level: trace 12 large circles clockwise, then 12 the other way. Switch legs: repeat.

Butt Lifter Work butt, hamstrings

Lie face up, knees bent, flee flat. Extend right leg toward ceiling, toes pointed. Squeeze glutes and lift hips to form left knee to shoulders. Raise hips higher, then lower to floor for 1 rep. do 15 reps, switch legs: repeat.

Twisting Toner

Works butt, thighs, abs, oblique's Step right leg into a lunge, arms out to sides, rotating upper body

to right until arms align with right thigh. Rotate to center, stepping right leg back to meet left. Repeat on opposite side for 1 rep. do 12 reps.

Leaping Firmer Works butt, legs

Stand with feet together, hands clasped in front of chest. Step left leg into a forward lunge. Push off floor immediately, jumping as high as you can. Land in a swing with right leg forward for 1 rep. Do 15 reps as quickly as possible.

2023 Land Rover Range Rover Auto



Venturing off-road is certainly an option for Range Rover owners; all-wheel drive is standard and the air suspension can be raised to provide extra ground clearance although we know that few will actually dare to subject this rolling art piece to such indignity. The Range Rover is more expensive as compared to its rivals such as Cadillac Escalade, the Jeep Grand Wagoneer and the Mercedes-Benz GLS-class.

The Range Rover has a trio of powertrains, starting with a turbocharged inline-six with a 48-volt hybrid system dubbed P400 that develops 395 horsepower. During our initial test drive, it proved to be silky-smooth and provided adequate pep to tug the large Range Rover around. A 523-hp twin-turbo

4.4-liter V-8 engine Land Rover calls it P530, is even perkier and cranks up the Range Rover's towing capacity to 8200 pounds.

The Range Rover's ride is suitably plush and, with its adjustable air suspension set to Comfort mode, it virtually floats down the road. Turning the dial to Dynamic mode firms things up some, but the big Rover still aims for a comfort-first mission.

The most fuel-efficient Range Rover will likely be the plug-in hybrid P440e. The entry-level P360 and mid-range P400 are both rated for 18 mpg city and 26 mpg highway while the V-8¬–powered P530 has earned 16 mpg city and 21 mpg highway estimates.

This new generation model offers a plush



interior decked out with rich leathers and woods, but buyers who want a more sustainable cabin can now opt for a new leather-free option, which subs-in wool or other textiles. The interior can be arranged to seat four, five, or seven depending on configuration and wheelbase. The third row, even in long-wheelbase trims, may not fit tall adults as the headroom there is somewhat limited, but shorter riders and kids will find it nearly as comfortable as the second row. An optional motorized divider for the cargo area helps keep things from moving around too much during travel, and the Range Rover's split rear lift gate can be used as convenient and comfortable seating for outdoor events.
