



Boemo Boby Ponatshego aka Bimah Flair is an independent hip-hop/Motswako musician. He started doing music back in 2014 but started recording in 2016 with Holy Stucha who encouraged him to record rather than wasting lyrics by doing freestyling on facebook.

His music is meant to motivate people and would definitely like to change people's mindsets and discourage them from the use of drugs and alcohol and also to show people how to appreciate their loved ones, to encourage his followers to stop GBV through

his music.

Talking about his development since he started music, Bimah Flair said, "All I can say is, I've seen ups and downs but that kept me going since I started taking advices. I've seen myself growing lyrically and I've been to Mokaragana and BLAC NETWORK that alone means a lot to me as I'm grown and even my fan base is going there. So far I've released twenty songs."

He said the name Bimah comes from a Religious Education book and he really liked the name. "It means a big holy table on which the Torah is read upon, Torah is a sikh Holy book and Flair means a natural talent in short I'm talented and holy," he said.

On the main challenges and goals when he started as an artist and how they have changed over time, Bimah Flair replied, "I was so shy, I was afraid what people would say, but I was so strong because I was so passionate and ambitious, I really love music I wanted to see myself on public television screen as time goes on. I learnt a lot from Lil Wayne on how to become confident so here



(Red Gang) etc. In the same year 2016, I had a meeting with Christophe Durand who by then was a digital distribution consultant but today is my manager," she said.

The ambitious artist whose hobbies are also dance, painting, acting, fitness, playing the guitar etc., in 2018 relocated to Reunion Island in the Indian Ocean, a French territory, where she had to adapt herself and continue growing her professional music career. Epitome of courageous defines this exotic artist from Tonota. She continues to tell us about how she's been tackling the promoting cultural exchange between countries working with different record labels with prominent musicians from France. This gave her the opportunity to develop her skills, image and to showcase her music performing it on different stages to an international audience, with tourism rates being high and entertainment is key. At the same time she pushed fashion boundaries abroad i.e. being ambassador for a French brand 'Skooob' and doing cultural exchange programs with students.

In 2019, she released her debut single "I'm Woke" produced by Honest Beatz with an official music video by Lapso FilmMaker which played on both local and international music channels followed by singles "Falling Back" and Leader featuring Alex Sorres published by Sakifo Talent and "Badass" with Queen Favie produced by JT (Blackmail Ent).

"Just when the Covid-19 pandemic befell the whole world, when we could still gallivant when given time out from confinement in 2020/21, I met a beat maker/producer, who I have been working closely with since at StanRecords; with Stanley Pivoteau who is Franco/Japanese. Our working relationship was smooth, he understood my sound and the nature that it keeps evolving, full of authenticity and moral messages. We worked on different singles i.e. No Control, Shackles and two singles featuring Raywon on "Dumb Dumb" and "Everyday". From there the team and I started compiling my first solo album "Are You Ready?" consisting of ten tracks, "La Vie Est Belle" being the first single to be officially released from the album with a music video where we collaborated with local talent from here in France", Swagger continued.

After the release of the album, Danielle Swagger got the opportunity to part-



take in some of the biggest festivals in theIndian Ocean; i.e. Electropicales Festival, where she opened for the French Rapper "Jok-Air" and The Sakifo Festival, which is one of the biggest highlights of her career to date. Also gracing the "Fête De La Musique" stage where she got invited by UrbanHit Radio Reunion exclusively as an international act. In present day, the promotion of her first solo album "Are You Ready?" which was released mid 2021 continues. Nevertheless the Covid-19 complications, the brand continued to promote the album releasing "I'm Dazed" music video (2022) and a collaboration "Laisse Tomber" single with a music video. I also signed a deal with Avico Boisson, to be the brand ambassador for their imported product from South Africa, "B.O.S Ice Tea" in the French territory. Our fans who I call "The SwaggerTrain" are currently awaiting the "Yéléle" music video due for June 2023 and what I would like to call my comeback. I am working on new music in the studio of late, my fans should look forward to more content in May 2023.

Danielle Swagger whose favorite dishes are Tswana meals, is a versatile artist, open to work with different talents in Botswana. "I hope to inspire Batswana/ African girls like myself, to always take a leap of faith towards success and to know their worth, in a world where women are limited and over shadowed by male dominated industries.

Although working in the creative industry is a dream, I would like to appreciate those who support me and would appreciate it, if more Botswana Media Outlets, public and private owned, reinforced more effort in publicizing young Batswana who are making strides in the International market with ease. It would motivate us to work harder because we can feel it is not in vain we work and home got our back since we are promoting our country tirelessly through cultural exchange in the Diaspora from our own investments. I hope to inspire Botswana and African girls like myself, to always take a leap of faith towards success and to know their worth, in a world where women are limited and over shadowed by male dominated industries. Kabo Kalane, affectionately known as Duzboi is a 30 year old Motswako artist from Ramotswa. He has been in the music industry for almost ten years and said he has learnt a lot on how to be an independent artist as this industry requires hard work, dedication and team work.

"Ever since I have joined this industry, I only released singles through social media platforms and on the streets. I pushed my music through events, because growing up in this industry, I realized that as artists it's not easy to be booked so I went into event organizing whereby I did my own events in clubs,

community halls and bars. As I did these events, I was booking mostly upcoming artists for I realized that they also didn't get much recognition for most of them aren't booked most of the time.

My biggest hurtful moment was when the industry was closed

because of Covid19, that time, music was my only source of income so it hit me very hard for my first born was due to be born so when the industry got closed there was no how I could have income. This affected me mentally and I nearly got depressed, I ended up joining construction to do floor tiling and carpentry. This gave me a living till date, after the industry was open I didn't have any interest in getting back to music until this year when lot of my supporters forced me to. I then dropped my latest radio project which is a Mapiano song tittled 'Lerato' feat Raskhejo and produced by Wouziebeatz. It was released on the 20th of March 2023 and launched at Blak Ball bar and at Buddy Chillas club in Otse. The single was inspired by the kind of relationships whereby you are in love with someone whom is in love with different people, the song is expected to be played on all radio stations in May.

Talking about the issue of gender based violence, all I can say is that it is so stressing in our country and I condemn it and wish a very harsh punishment to those who abuse other genders because nowadays the abuse is from both genders.

My last words to Botswana citizens is for them to support local artists for some have no work experience nor better qualifications so basically music is their only source of income. and I'd plead with Botswana promoters to at least always include upcoming artists from all over Botswana in their events to at least make them get recognition, and to the government I also love to plead with it to come up with strategies to make at least tours around Botswana in talent search and sponsor those who qualify at least with scholarship be it producer's, artists, dancers, poet's etc.

The stunning beauty of Northern Tuli Game Reserve

Spectacular landscapes, rich and varied wildlife, and a host of historical, cultural and natural history attractions define this unique and very striking corner of northeastern Botswana.

Straddling the Shashe, Motloutse and Limpopo Rivers, which serve as natural boundaries with Zimbabwe and South Africa, the Northern Tuli Game Reserve (NTGR) comprises 71,000 hectares of remarkably diverse habitat, including mophane bushland, riverine woodland, and marshland, punctuated by towering sandstone cliffs, basalt formations and unusually shaped kopjes – making for truly breathtaking scenery.

One of the largest privately-owned game reserves in Southern Africa and incorporating three major private concessions (Tuli Safari Lodge, Nitani Private Game Reserve, and Mashatu Game Reserve), the NTGR is home

to 48 species of mammals and over 350 species of birds, with an estimated 20 000 animals residing in the reserve.

Most naturally occurring wildlife species are present, including elephant, kudu, zebra, impala, duiker, wildebeest, waterbuck, steenbok, and warthog. Large herds of eland – often not seen elsewhere in Botswana – are present, and these are indeed an awesome sight. All major predators, including lion, leopard, cheetah and hyena, are present, and the birdlife is prolific.

The NTGR is adjacent to a larger area of eastern Botswana called the Tuli Block. This is a ten-kilometer-wide strip of land running approximately Northern Tuli Game Reserve 180 kilometers south to Martin's Drift that holds a string of commercial agricultural and game farms, several of which also offer tourist facilities

Travellers keen for a more active safari experience will delight in all there is on offer. You can hike the reserve, bike the reserve, horse-ride the reserve, and even hot air balloon the reserve! At Mashatu Game Reserve, guests can accompany elephant or predator researchers, to gain first-hand insights into the behaviour, feeding habits, territories, demography, and social structure of these animals, as well as critical wildlife conservation issues. A similar experience awaits guests at Nitani – as they come to understand the complexities of a long-term hyena research project.

Molema Bush Camp, a community-based tourism project managed and operated by Tuli Safari Lodge, is an ideal way to take part in a tourism concept that is rapidly gaining momentum in Africa. Local communities become active partners in tourism projects, from which they can more readily see clearcut financial and social benefits.

Molema is a joint venture between three local villages: Motlhabaneng, Lentswe le Moriti and Mathathane and two tour operators: Tuli Safari Lodge and Talana Farms.

Archaeological sites provide an important historical perspective to the region. Iron Age sites demonstrate the formidable skills in pottery, mining, and smelting of the Zhizo, Leopard's Kopje and Mapungubwe peoples, who practiced agriculture and animal husbandry in the area.

Artifacts from the Mapungubwe Kingdom (1220-1290AD), a precursor to the Great Zimbabwe civilization, reveal the sophistication of the technology and society of its people, and their extensive trade networks.

The NTGR will form the heart of the proposed Shashe/Limpopo Trans- Frontier Conservation Area (TFCA), its signatories – Botswana, Zimbabwe and South Africa – agreeing to cooperate to conserve and manage shared natural resources. Rich in biodiversity, the proposed TFCA will cover approximately 4,872 square kilometers and will be one of the largest wildlife conservation areas in Southern Africa. Some cars are big-bodied and some are thrilling. The BMW M5 is both, with a body based on the regular 5-series and a heart and lung transplant courtesy of the brand's M performance division. Under the hood lives a spectacular 600-hp twin-turbo V-8 bolted to an eight-speed automatic transmission that powers all four wheels. An optional Competition package turns up the heat with 17 extra horsepower, a more soulful exhaust, stiffer suspension, and competition badging and trim. That version rocketed to 60 mph in 2.8 seconds in our testing. Built to handle the rigors of mountain hairpins, blasts on the autobahn, and everyday life the M5 offers a premium experience with a penchant for fireworks.

The M5 is mighty, boasting 600 horsepower from its twin-turbo 4.4-liter V-8 in base form. In the more track-focused Competition, that figure increases to 617 horses. The M5 faithful will lament the discontinued manual gearbox and all-wheel-drive system, but this Bimmer has a high-tech drivetrain that can send 100 percent of its torque to the rear wheels for tail-wagging fun. Driving enjoyment is maximized here with lively and direct steering and a well-controlled albeit stiff ride. That doesn't mean the M5 can't also do duty as a luxury sedan: In Comfort mode, it cruises placidly, the cabin whisper quiet.



The M5 has an elegant leather interior with supportive sport seats. Unlike many of its rivals, BMW hasn't gone the all-touchscreen route, so adjusting the air conditioning or radio is easy to do while the vehicle is in motion. The M5 comes with a slew of desirable features such as customizable ambient interior lighting, a heated steering wheel,

heated front seats, and a power-adjustable steering column. BMW offers ventilated front seats with massage functionality, heated rear seats, and four-zone automatic climate control for more coin. As for storage space, the M5 has useful cubbies in the cabin, and its trunk held six carry-on suitcases in our testing.



airo is a place of physical contrast. Along the well-irrigated shoreline, lush vegetation shares the landscape with tall skyscrapers. Cairo is fan-shaped, narrowest in the south, where the river valley is wedged between desert escarpments, and widest in the north, where the valley blends into the delta. Over the centuries the city expanded westward, as a receding river channel left land flood-free. In response to heightened demand, however, the city also has been elongated to the north and south and has developed an expanding annex on the Nile's western shore.

Cairo has only two seasons: approximately eight months of summer and four months of winter. In the hottest of the summer months June, July, and August, the average daily maximum temperature is 95 °F (35 °C), and the average daily minimum is 70 °F (21 °C). The summer temperature has reached as high as 117 °F (47 °C). During winter the strong Tropic of Cancer sun makes for warm, dry days, but nights are cool and humid, often freshened by breezes from the Nile. Building styles in Cairo are related to the historical period during which each quarter developed. In the oldest sections, two-

four-storied structures prevail, most built of fired brick covered with plaster and sometimes shored with half-timbering. A number of these have windows covered with delicately turned wooden lattices and massive wooden doors elegantly decorated with inlay, brass, or iron nailheads. The traditional dwellings (of which only a few remain intact) open onto fountained courtyards and have separate quarters for men and women; the traditional workshops and warehouse inns (khans) have galleries overlooking their interior courtyards.

In the quarters on the west and north the more elegant districts have both handsome high-rise apartments and one- or two-storied "villas," with high walls enclosing colourful gardens. Lower middle- and working-class housing consists exclusively of concrete multi-flat walk-up structures, gray or yellow-beige in colour, often with shops occupying the ground floor. The poorest zones contain similar structures, informal housing that is often left unfinished on the exterior.

Cairo's population, once both ethnically and religiously diverse, is now predominantly Muslim. A significant number of Egyptian Christians, the majority of whom observe the Coptic Orthodox faith, continue to dominate certain districts in the city. From its inception, Cairo's economy has been based on governmental functions, commerce, trade, and industrial production. The modern productive sector expanded dramatically in the second half of the 20th century. Cairo is the country's primary centre for economic production and financial control. It still contains many of Egypt's important banks, hotels, restaurants, entertainment venues, and cafés.

Egypt's extensive transportation network, laid out by the British, connects most of the country's urban centres with the capital. Within metropolitan Cairo, the transportation network is made up of both formal and informal sectors. The Public Transport Authority runs a bus network, which was introduced in the 1950s. In addition, a farreaching system of authorized, licensed cabs operates in the city. Informal transportation services include minibuses and taxis, which sprang up in the late 1970s and '80s; these continue to predominate, particularly in areas that serve the expanding informal neighbourhoods. The Cairo Metro, a citywide subway system, began service in 1987 and has since been significantly expanded.





It's normal for newborn babies (boys and girls) to have mild or even swollen, enlarged breasts and/or lumps under the nipple. They are almost always benign and due to exposure to maternal hormones in the womb. The same hormones that cause the mother's breasts to swell and milk glands to be stimulated can do the same to the baby's breasts.

These lumps and enlarged breasts in the baby may be quite noticeable at birth. They

might even continue to grow after birth for a while. If you were to pinch them, some real breast milk may be expressed.

Over weeks, or sometimes even months, when there is no more exposure to the hormones, the breast tissue begins to shrink and eventually becomes quite flat. Occasionally a normal, small amount of tissue remains, but it doesn't grow or cause discomfort.

Tips for Concerned Parents

Sometimes, overly worried parents touch and pinch the breasts so much that the area gets irritated. Leave them alone and let nature take its course in shrinking them.

When to Worry About Swollen Breasts or Lumps

In the rare case when the breasts look infected (swollen, red, tender, or have a discharge) and the baby has a fever, visit the doctor to check if an infection has set in.

Rearing Dairy Cows

he ideal temperature range for dairy cattle is between 25 and 65 degrees Fahrenheit. Once the temperature goes above 80 degrees Fahrenheit cattle reduce feed intake, which has a negative impact on production.

It is essential that cows have constant access to high-quality feed and clean water. Milking cows each need 60-70 liters of water a day, plus an additional 4-5 liters per liter of milk produced. To accomplish this, they need consistent access to water troughs.

Dairy cows eat pasture grasses. Hay: dried grass or alfalfa. Silage: made in silos; fermented grasses, alfalfa, or corn.

Cows should have access to feed 22 hours daily (with an additional 2-3 hrs daily spent in the holding pen) with feed pushed up numerous times daily so cows have easy access to feed. Dairy cows eat 9 to 14 meals daily with larger meals upon return from the parlor and/ or when fresh feed is provided.

A dairy cow should be given 15-20 kg of chopped forage per day, preferably in two splits i.e. one in the morning and the other in the evening. Dry feeds include materials such as wheat straw; rice straw, maize Stover and other vegetable by products.

The average DM (Dry matter) requirement of desi cow is 2 (dry) to 2.5 (lactating) Kg. / 100 Kg. body weight / day while it is 2.5 (dry) to 3.0 Kg. (lactating) in cross breed cows and buffaloes. Soybean meal, which is the byproduct of oil extraction, has a high crude protein content of 44 to 50 percent and a balanced composition, amino acid complementary to maize meal for feed formulation. A high level of inclusion (30-40 percent) is used in high performance monogastric diets.



Too much protein, however, can cause cattle to excrete more urinary nitrogen, which, in the farm environment, may be converted to ammonia - a component of acid rain, which poses contamination threats to farms' surface and ground-water.

A dairy cow will produce an average of 28 litres per day over a period of 10 months. During peak lactation, a high-yielding cow may produce as much as 60 litres per day and up to 12,000 litres over her whole lactation.

Anthurium - Anthurium is a genus of about 1,000 species of flowering plants, the largest genus of the arum family, Araceae. General common include anthurium, names tailflower, flamingo flower, and laceleaf.

African Mask Plant - The African mask plant, commonly called the Kris plant, is a type of Alocasia from the Araceae family native to the tropics of the South Pacific.



Like many other houseplants, the African Mask Plant needs bright, indirect light. This would be medium or moderate light. It doesn't do well in low light, the leaves will get smaller and the plant won't grow.

Prayer Plant Maranta leuconeura, also known as prayer plant, is a species of

Shop in Order

Gather non-perishable items first. Then, select refrigerated and frozen items. Stop at the deli counter last. Place deli meats near the other cold items in your grocery cart.

Pick Your Produce

If you go to a farmers market, go early in the morning to avoid produce that has been sitting out all day. Choose loose produce rather than packaged so you have more control over what you select. Purchase only the amount of produce you will use within a week. Buy only pasteurized juices that have been kept refrigerated.

Inspect Food Packages

Check food packages. There should be no holes, tears or openings. Check safety seals. A loose lid on a jar means the vacuum has been lost and the product may be contaminated. Avoid buying any cans that are deeply dented.

Check Dairy and Milk Products

When buying dairy products, choose cartons and containers that are cold. Make sure the eggs are clean and aren't broken or cracked. Buy milk and other dairy products toward the end of your shopping trip. This will lessen the time these items are out of refrigeration.

Be Selective with Fish and Seafood

Buy fish only from reputable sources like grocery stores and seafood markets. Check for proper refrigeration of fresh fish. Make sure packaged seafood is well-packed in ice and that packages are tightly sealed and free of dents and tears.

Make Cleanliness a Priority

Check for cleanliness and only buy food from reputable businesses that follow food safety regulations. Determine the general impression of the facility and make sure it looks and smells clean. If provided, use the hand sanitizer at the store's entrance. Wipe hands and the handle of the shopping cart. Clean hands before sampling food. If you use reusable grocery bags, wash them often.

Look Over Meats and Poultry

Make sure packaging is tightly sealed and is very cold to the touch. Choose packaged chicken that looks pink, not gray. Always look for the Safe Food Handling label on packages of bacon and fresh sausage.

Separate Certain Foods

Put raw meat, poultry and seafood in plastic bags before placing them in your cart. This keeps packaging from leaking and dripping onto ready-to-eat foods like bread or produce.

At Home

Take groceries home immediately and store them right away. Keep perishable foods out of the hot trunk in summer and place in the air-conditioned car instead. Promptly refrigerate or freeze perishable items as soon as you get home.

- To improve the mobility of your shoulders and upper back, sit or stand with your feet shoulder-width apart.
- With your right hand, reach up and over your head as if climbing a rope (relax your left knee if standing). Hold the position for five seconds.
- Bring your right arm down and reach up and over with your left hand (relaxing your right knee) and hold the position for ten seconds.
- Repeat five times to each side.

Up and over

- 1. Stand with your feet apart. With your arms out to your sides, hold both ends of an exercise band (or a small towel) taut out in front of you at shoulder level.
- 2. Lift both arms up and take the band or towel over and behind your head and on as far down your back as comfortable.
- 3. Then, raise it up and over your head, still pulling hard at both ends to keep it taut throughout. Repeat ten times.

Palm squeeze

- Sit or stand. Holding two soft (tennis) balls (or oranges), tuck your elbows into your waist with lower arms out in front, and palms uppermost. Keep your arms and wrists still.
- Squeeze and release the balls ten times, as tightly as possible.





Confederation of African Football (CAF) has suspended four local match officials, referee Joshua Bondo for six months, the trio of Kitso Sibanda, Mogomotsi Morakile and Tshepo Gobagoba for three months. The quartet are believed to have failed to capture the booking of Rwanda star player during the first leg of African Cup of Nations qualifier away to Benin. The said player featured in the return leg in Kigali though he was supposed to have been on suspension. Both legs ended in a 1-1 stalemate. Botswana Football Association has also taken a decision to suspend the quartet from officiating in domestic football until further notice.

Former FIFA Assistant Referee Harris Lebotse on the suspended match officials; "Saddened by the developments. These are the best we have in the country. I was there when they started their refereeing journey, when it was unfashionable to do so. Joshua Bondo is a legend, having refereed at the Apex of African Football. O dirile morwa Bondo, walk with your head high. This mistake should not overshadow the good you have done up to now. I am proud of you son. We walked the journey together when you started. Tshepo Gobagoba, Kitso Sibanda and Mogomotsi Morakile, it is unfortunate that you were caught in the cross fire. Stay strong, don't despair, you have been good servants of Botswana Football and you still have a lot to offer to the game."
