

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

Shopping Lis Why You Need To Have One


ith the constant rising cost of living and economic uncertainty it has become increasingly important to exercise financial prudence. "I am committed to using a shopping list, and as things go - I have saved good money," he says. He went on to say that his I-phone application shave also proved instrumental in helping him draw up a suitable shopping list.



She has won the hearts of many viewers and keeps them glued to their TV screens every Friday evening, watching Flava Dome-the show she co-hosts with Loungo Andre Pitse. But that's no surprise. The proper way to apply your favorite scent is to put it directly onto your body. It's best to put it on directly out of the shower.

 Always shine your shoes when you first buy them and before you wear them, then shine them on a regular schedule after that. Preventive maintenance will help protect your shoe investment.

• Moisture protection is a must. Mink oil

will waterproof and preserve the shoe, but it can darken lighter shades of leathers.

• Brushing away dirt and dust will help keep the leather looking good, and polishing them with good quality creams and waxes will help condition them and prolong their life by protecting against water damage, etc.

• Polishes fall into two main categories: cream and wax. They can be used interchangeably or together (cream first, followed by wax). Cream polish cleans, conditions, and buffs to a moderate shine, whereas wax polish protects more and can be buffed to a high gloss if desired.

• It is a good idea to have cloths and brushes dedicated to black and brown polishes, and not to interchange them.

• While selecting a shoe polisher cream, match the shade exactly. If in doubt, go with a shade lighter and not darker.

• If the shoes have leather soles, use a little of the polish around the edge to darken them up.



How to Raise Responsible Kids



o you tend to do too much for your kids?Do you hold your kids accountable for their actions?

What about chores and responsibilities at home, what are your expectations for your kids?

5 PRACTICAL TIPS FOR RAISING RESPONSIBLE KIDS

As parents, we all want our children to someday become responsible adults. On the other end of the spectrum, we don't want to force our children to grow up too quickly. There is a balance, but how do we find it? There are many indicators we can use to let us know whether we are giving our children enough responsibility.

REACTIONS

How does your child react to responsibility?

Does he (or she) cringe or accept it with enthusiasm? A child who resists responsibility may be overwhelmed with what you are already giving them, or simply not wanting more. This is an area where knowing your child comes into play. A child who eagerly accepts more responsibility when given it is generally being given the right amount.

BOREDOM

This can be an indicator that your child doesn't have enough responsibility. Children, unless special circumstances are preventing it, enjoy and even seek a good challenge. They take pride in their accomplishments and look for more ways to replicate that feeling. If a child is not being challenged enough, they may get bored and act out.

Often, a child labelled with "bad behavior" is just seeking fulfillment.

Gather Input from Other Parents

Do you have friends with children the same age as yours?

If yes, that's great. If not, aim to find some. Compare notes and determine if your child is being given approximately the same amount of responsibility as his friends.

Requests from Your Children

Has your child asked for more chores, or been seeking accountability from you in some area?

Children have more wisdom than we often give them credit for, and a child can be his own best judge. A child who feels an innate need for more responsibility may ask for it, which can be displayed by wanting more chores, or checking in with you even when you didn't ask him to.

Trust your child's natural intuition and work with him to find a better balance.

Responsibility Should Match Privilege

As Voltaire, the famous writer and philosopher, is quoted saying: "With great power comes great responsibility."As your child grows and becomes more responsible, his privileges should expand to reflect that as well. And likewise, as your child grows old enough to receive more privileges, you will know that you can hold him accountable with more responsibility. As long as these two match, it's a good indicator that you are on the right track.

Teaching our children responsibility is an area where there is not always an easy answer. All children are different, and not one approach fits all. However, we can use this list to give ourselves a general idea of whether or not we are giving our child enough responsibility, and ensuring their future success.

Tell us about the education system in Botswana, what you can share with Batswana about it.

Answer: This is a very broad and open question and one can be very certain the answer provided will do justice to it. Generally Botswana provides free and accessible academic and vocational and technical education from pre-primary to university levels. Education is mainly provided by government in public schools. However, over the years we have seen an influx of private schools coming on board to provide education at a cost which is mainly accessible to the privileged and more affluent section of our population. The private sector has particularly done well in the provision of pre-primary school education.

Since you joined the Ministry of Basic Education, what have you achieved so far as the Assistant Minister?

Answer: A better response to your question will mean that I should first give you a brief background to what my job entails. Well my portfolio covers pre and primary education, secondary education, human resource management including teaching service administration, regional operations, curriculum development and evaluation, inspectorate services, facilities development and maintenance as well as parliamentary issues. In a nutshell as the title suggests, I am the Minister's right hand man. The core business is to ensure that all eligible children access quality and relevant basic education. I think it suffices for me to mention that this role involves a lot of extensive travelling so as to visit institutions where our core mandate takes place. I have done that fairly well and have been to almost every corner of this country addressing the issue of improving our academic performance. Last year we have seen a lot of primary schools, twenty one in number getting 100% ABC performance in Primary School Leaving Examinations and this is a remarkable feat.

It has been realized that schools in major cities and towns perform better than those in rural and remote areas. What are your implications on that issue?

Answer: Yes, urban schools tend to outperform rural schools. It is not clear why this is the case. Government does not make a distinction between urban and rural schools in terms of provision of resources and staffing. Schools in towns and rural areas enjoy equal treatment and services. It is just a problem of mindsets. To prove this, some rural schools with the right positive minds are doing better than urban schools. Of course I must admit that rural schools are facing challenges on issues of retention.

What are the implications?

Answer: Well education is linked to improved livelihoods. High failure rate in rural schools worsens poverty rates and increases rate of unemployment.

What measures have been taken by your Ministry to address the problem faced by education system in Botswana?

Answer: We are working on mindsets and capacity building of school managers and improving resourcing and making schools friendlier to learners. The ESP programme has also come in handy to improve our infrastructure in terms of both schools expansion, staff houses construction and maintenance of facilities.

What can you say about the declining performance of the education system so far in the country?

Answer: There has been a decline in academic achievement levels in the last few years. It is largely caused by a combination of factors being failure on the part of some staff and students to apply themselves fully. There is also the issue of minimal parent support in some schools. One cannot of course underestimate shortage of teaching and learning materials.

In Botswana, education is not only seen as important for helping people find jobs, but is also valued as a way to create social harmony. Kindly elaborate on this statement.

Answer: Yes, education is an equalizing force; it bridges the gap between the rich and poor. It inculcates the spirit of peace-ful coexistence among people who are otherwise culturally diverse. That's why it is a fundamental right that should not be denied anybody.

What more information do you deem important to share with us?

Answer: What I can say is that while government is doing all she can to improve resourcing and staffing, I would like to implore those charged with the role of teaching to double their efforts. I would also like to appeal to all the learners to take their education seriously, to respect themselves, the teachers as well as their parents.

Ear Infections In **Babies**

How to tell if your baby has an ear infection

The easiest way to tell if your baby might have an ear infection is by observing a change in his mood. If your baby turns fussy, or starts crying more than usual, be on the lookout for a problem. If he develops a fever (whether slight or high) you have another big clue. Ear infections tend to strike after a common cold or sinus infection, so keep that in mind too.

You may also notice the following symptoms:

•Your baby pulls, grabs, or tugs at his ears - This could be a sign he is in pain. (Babies do pull on their ears for all kinds of reasons or for no reason at all. So if your baby seems otherwise fine, he probably does not have an ear infection.)

•Diarrhea or vomiting - The bug that causes the ear infection can also affect the gastrointestinal tract.

•Reduced appetite - Ear infections can cause gastrointestinal upset. They can also make it painful for your baby to swallow and chew. You may notice your baby pull away from the breast or bottle after he takes the first few sips.

•Yellow or whitish fluid draining from the ear - This does not happen to most babies, but it is a sure sign of infection. It also signals that a small hole has developed in the eardrum. (This will heal once the infection is treated.)

•Unpleasant smell - You may detect a foul odor coming from your child's ear.

•Difficulty sleeping - Lying down can make an ear infection more painful.

What causes ear infections in babies?

An ear infection can be caused by bacteria or a virus. It happens when fluid builds up in the area behind your baby's eardrum and then becomes infected. Germs like to grow in dark, warm, wet

places, so a fluid-filled middle ear is the perfect breeding ground. As the infection gets worse, the inflammation in and behind the eardrum also tends to worsen, making the condition more painful. Fever may develop as your baby's body attempts to fight the infection.

Using a pacifier may increase the risk of middle ear infections in babies and young children.

What is the treatment for an ear infection in a baby?

Most ear infections clear up on their own but severe cases need to be treated with antibiotics. If your baby is at least 6 months old, your doctor may recommend that you give him infants' acetaminophen or ibuprofen to relieve pain caused by the infection.


How to prevent future ear infections

Ear infections are not contagious, but the respiratory infections that often precede and accompany them are. The best way to reduce the spread of germs is to wash your hands (and your child's hands) often.

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ow can I tell the difference between a yeast diaper rash and a regular diaper rash?

A: Diaper rash affects most babies at one time or another. The most common cause is known as contact dermatitis. This rash develops when skin that is in direct contact with a soiled diaper becomes red, raw and irritated. It's important to note this type of diaper rash does not appear in the creases and folds of baby's skin.

Most health care providers recommend applying 1 percent hydrocortisone followed by a topical antibiotic (Neosporin, Bacitracin, etc.) to the raw areas and then covering them with a thick layer (like frosting on a cake) of a "barrier" cream or ointment (Desitin, Vaseline, A&D ointment, etc.). There are also many natural creams without phthalates, parabens, and petrolatum or sodium laurel sulphate. These generally work just as well.

- Cut down on the use of diaper wipes for a few days, and instead clean bitty bottoms with warm water (and a mild soap if necessary). Improvement should be visible within 24 to 48 hours.
- Contact dermatitis typically resolves

within 7 to 10 days. The best ways to prevent it are to change diapers frequently and apply a barrier ointment or cream to the skin before a rash develops.

- If the rash doesn't go away or worsens, it may be that your baby has developed a yeast infection. Do not panic! Yeast infections are easily treated once identified.
- The best ways to prevent any type of diaper rash are to change soiled diapers promptly, clean baby's skin thoroughly and make sure the diaper area is completely dry before putting on a new diaper.

Winter vegetable growing allows you to extend the season and many vegetables that can be grown in winter will produce earlier crops than spring plantings.

Vegetables to grow outdoors in winter

Most winter vegetable plants are fully hard and will cope well with cold winter weather, but if hard frosts threaten then you can always throw some fleece across them to provide some extra protection.



Garlic



Perpetual Spinach

Perpetual spinach makes an excellent 'cut and come again' crop that will produce huge yields of tasty leaves. Early autumn sowings will keep you supplied with tender young leaves throughout winter and with regular harvesting it will continue to crop well into summer.

Onions and Shallots

Autumn planting onion sets are easy to grow and will virtually look after themselves over winter. Onions have a long growing season and won't be ready for harvesting until next summer.



Carrots

Growing garlic couldn't be easier and there are lots of varieties to choose from for autumn planting. Like onions, they have a long growing season and won't be ready to harvest until next summer, but it is well worth the wait.



For an exceptionally early crop of carrots in spring try growing Adelaide. This fast-maturing variety can be sown as early as November in the greenhouse and as late as July outdoors.

Tricks for Perfectly Clean Windows

The keys to successful window cleaning are having the right supplies.

- A squeegee, scrubber, combination tool, if you have hard to reach windows, you may want to make sure you get an extension pole
- A rectangular bucket this will fit your window cleaning tool better than a round bucket
- Microfiber cloths.
- Good liquid dish soap
- Razor blade scraper (if you have tree sap, bugs or other hard to remove qunk)
- old bath towels (optional- to protect window sills inside)

1. Choose a time of day when the sun is not shining directly on the windows. The heat from the sun can cause the cleaning fluid to dry, which will result in streaks or water spots.

HOW TO CLEAN BURNT POTS & SCORCHED PANS

What You Need **Materials**

- 1 cup of vinegar
- 2 tablespoons of baking soda
- 1 cup of water (give or take depending on the size of your pan)
- A burnt stainless steel pan that was left empty and unattended on a heated hot plate.
- A scourer, because I can't find any way to avoid it entirely

Instructions

1. Fill the bottom of the pan with a layer of water.



your bucket and fill it about 1/2 way with warm water.

3. Dip the scrubber in a solution of 1 teaspoon dishwashing liquid to two gallons of water. Squeeze excess water from the scrubber.

4. Scrub the glass by applying the scrubber to the glass in an S pattern – try and get into all of the corners and cover every square inch of the glass.

5. Next, you'll use the squeegee and starting at the top, pull it from one side to the other steadily across the window.

6. Use a microfiber cloth to wipe the frame and corners clean. Wipe off any streaks using a clean area of the microfiber cloth. Change clothes when you can't find any fresh, clean areas.

7. If you have any tree sap, dead bugs or other hard to remove bits on your window, use a razor blade scraper to remove them (be sure the glass is wet when scraping with the razor)



3. Bring the pan to the boil. It should be looking a bit cleaner already.

4. Remove the pan from the heat and add the baking soda. Expect fizz!

5. Empty the pan and scour as normal; if necessary add an extra bit of dry baking soda.

6. If there are any super stubborn marks that don't come off with scouring, make a paste of baking soda and a couple of drops of water. Leave the paste on the marks for a while and return to clean as normal.

Make your flowers and plants even more beautiful by decorating your boring flower pots! Decorative flower pots brighten up balconies, windowsill, and make the perfect personalised gift. Here are 5 inspiring ways to decorate your ordinary flower pots to make them more eye-catching.



Cover the Flower Pots with Fabric

Use a few strips of outdoor fabric, turn a basic, inexpensive planter into a colourful statement piece for your deck this summer. You will need an outdoor fabric in a variety of colors, plastic planter, pinking shears use waterproof glue to put a line of it from the rim, add More different stripes then Fill your pots with seasonal flowers to add color to your deck or patio or you can use only one coloured fabric.

Affix Twigs

If you want a more natural look to match with your plant you can use some twigs to cover your pot. Go and look for some twigs in a good width to give you some nice slices. Cut the twigs with an appropriate tool making round pieces in different sizes but same width. Glue the twigs in the pot plant using wood glue.





Glue on Bark

Collect bark that's been shed from trees, break bark into 3- to 4-inch pieces, creating jagged edges. Using floral shears, cut bark into thin strips for the raised rim of the pot. Apply hot glue generously to the bark, and press the bark onto the pot, starting with the area just below the raised rim; hold in place about 10 seconds. Continue adding bark, slightly overlapping the pieces. Glue the smaller strips to the raised rim, including the top edge and just inside the rim.





Cover Pots with Lace

Here you will need Lace, Glue, Scissors, Terra Cotta Pots and Plants. Brush glue all over your pot. Adhere lace and then brush an extra layer of glue over the top to seal. Allow your new pots to dry completely before you use them.



Wrap in Rope

Paint the pots white or any color so that any gaps with the rope didn't show the terra cotta color. Once your pot is dry, start wrapping clothesline/ rope around your pot and secure with hot glue as you go. Keep wrapping until you get over the lip.



Moremi Game Reserve



his National Park has garnered a number of important distinctions. In 2008, it was voted the 'best game reserve in Africa' by the prestigious African Travel and Tourism Association at South Africa's premier tourism fair, Indaba.

It is the first reserve in Africa that was established by local residents. Concerned about the rapid depletion of wildlife in their ancestral lands – due to uncontrolled hunting and cattle encroachment – the Batawana people of Ngamiland, under the leadership of the deceased Chief Moremi III's wife, Mrs. Moremi, took the bold initiative to proclaim Moremi a game reserve in 1963.

Moremi Game Reserve is in northern Botswana, in the Okavango Delta, which becomes a lush animal habitat during seasonal floods. Dugout canoes are used to navigate past birdlife, hippos and crocodiles on waterways like the Xakanaxa Lagoon. Many tourists choose to visit the park by self-drive. On land, wildlife includes lions, leopards and rhinos. Moremi is a very popular destination for the self-drive camper, Safari camps are common, with several dotted around large Chief's Island and the forested Mopane Tongue Peninsula.

The reserve offers some of the most stunning scenery in the country and boasts an equally impressive ecosystem. Campervan but the park also has a number of great campsites. It is often combined with the Chobe National Park to the northeast. Moremi Reserve accommodation is offered in luxury safari lodges in Botswana. Activities in Moremi Reserve include game drives, bush walking safaris and birdwatching.

products.





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What Is Coronary Artery Disease?

oronary artery disease develops when the major blood vessels that supply your heart with blood, oxygen and nutrients (coronary arteries) become damaged or diseased. Cholesterol-containing deposits (plaque) in your arteries and inflammation are usually to blame for coronary artery disease.

Symptoms of Coronary Artery Disease

The most common symptom is angina, or chest pain. Angina can be described as a:

Heaviness, Pressure, Aching, Burning, Numbness, Fullness, Squeezing, Painful feeling, it can be mistaken for indigestion or heartburn.

Angina is usually felt in the chest, but may also be felt in the: left shoulder, arms, neck, back and jaw

Other symptoms that can occur with coronary artery disease include:

Shortness of breath, Palpitations (irregular heartbeats, skipped beats, or a "flip-flop" feeling in your chest), a faster heartbeat, Weakness or dizziness, Nausea, Sweating

How Is Coronary Artery Disease Treated?

It can involve:

Lifestyle changes: If you smoke, quit. Avoid processed foods and adopt a lowtrans-fat, low-salt, and low-sugar diet. Keep your blood sugar in control. If you have diabetes, exercise regularly (but talk to your doctor before you starting an exercise program).

Medications: If lifestyle changes are not enough, medications may be needed. The drugs you will take depend on your situation. If you have been diagnosed with coronary artery disease, you will probably be on aspirin and a statin, if not other things.





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Appendicitis

ppendicitis is an inflammation of the appendix, a 3 1/2-inchlong tube of tissue that extends from the large intestine. The appendix may have some role in gut immunity, but nothing is definite. One thing we do know: We can live without it, without apparent consequences.

Appendicitis is a medical emergency that almost always requires prompt surgery to remove the appendix. Left untreated, an inflamed appendix will eventually burst, or perforate, spilling infectious materials into the abdominal cavity.

What Causes Appendicitis?

Appendicitis occurs when the appendix becomes blocked, often by stool, a foreign body, or cancer. Blockage may also occur from infection, since the appendix can swell in response to any infection in the body.

What Are the Symptoms of Appendicitis?

• Dull pain near the navel or the upper abdomen that becomes sharp as it moves to the lower right abdomen. This is usually the first sign.

- Loss of appetite
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• Nausea and/or vomiting soon after ab-

- dominal pain begins
- Abdominal swelling
- Fever of 99-102 degrees Fahrenheit
- Inability to pass gas

How Is Appendicitis Diagnosed?

The following tests are usually used to help make the diagnosis:

- Abdominal exam to detect inflammation
- Urine test to rule out a urinary tract infection
- Rectal exam
- Blood test to see if your body is fighting infection
- CT scans and/or ultrasound

How Is Appendicitis Treated?

Surgery to remove the appendix, which is called an appendectomy, is the standard treatment for almost all cases of appendicitis. Generally, if appendicitis is suspected, doctors tend to err on the side of safety and quickly remove the appendix to avoid its rupture.

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



ownship Rollers legend Mogogi 'Gino' Gabonamong has recently packed his boots and bid goodbye to football. Celebrity World Magazine had a one on one conversation with him to explore more about his lifetime journey in football.

Tell us about yourself?

I was born on the 10th of September 1982 in Mmutlane, but I grew up in Mahalapye. My family background is no different from most of Batswana kids; it was a poor one but filled with love. I started playing football at the age of 7, where I used to torment teams as I was a striker. I had everything needed; pace, skill and hunger. My primary football days got people noticing my talent. I have always been passionate with the game and I lived it day and night. I didn't let the hype get to me however, I was determined to work hard on my dream from as early as age 11.

I have played for Black Peril, Mogoditshane Fighters, FC Satmos, Mochudi Centre Chiefs, AIA Caledonia (Trinidad and Tobago), Cape Town Santos (South Africa), SuperSport United, Bloemfontein Celtic (South Africa), and Township Rollers.

What have you achieved during your time in football?

Having two decades in football was definitely a blessed career. Making my national team debut at 16years remains one of my greatest achievements. I believe to this day I am the only Motswana player who represented Botswana and Zebras at under 17, 20 & 23 all at the same time. I have won league champions with Mogoditshane fighters and Township Rollers. I had a great 10 years in South Africa as well.

How much can you value football in Botswana?

There is a big change where we are now as compared to when I started. Money is given out into the game and we have better stadiums. But a lot of work still needs to be done. We need to wake up and learn that football is money. Our players are not that determined though, something which I would like to see them improve for the hunger of the game.

What kind of support did you get from Batswana?

The fans have always been incredibly supportive. Fans deserve commitment from players because they spend their hard earned cash supporting us at the games and their support has pushed me to play better for them.

Who did you work with, that you feel did the best in moulding you?

I wish I could mention all of them; Great coaches, administrators, kit managers, team drivers, e.t.c. David Bright and Gavin Hunt were some of the best coaches I have worked with who played a huge role in my career. The late Samson was a great mentor.

Except being a football player, what else did you do?

I have always carried my other passions off the pitch. I never believed in being known as just a footballer and worked hard throughout my career to cater for my other passion. That is why I was able to get involved in my projects straight after hanging up my boots.

How did you balance your time between family and football?

My family is my number one priority, and I never compromised on that. I worked hard for them but I never let football dictate me. My spare time was always spent with my wife and two kids. Even before I met her, my off time meant resting and focusing on myself.

What challenges have you faced during your life career in football?

I faced a lot of challenges but I had a big heart, football can be cruel but it takes a strong heart to succeed. I didn't make the cut at few trials that I went to, not because I didn't give my all but at times football politics were involved. But I always soldiered on because I believed in myself. I always picked myself up and

didn't share much with people. My wife is the only person I started sharing my football ups and downs with when we met. She has been an incredible rock throughout my career.

How do you think your retirement will affect the previous teams that you played for?

I retired from football in May 2017, and I don't think it will affect them at all. I had long told them of my intentions to do so when the season ends.

Where are we going to see you after the retirement?

I can't say much right now but I will get involved in the game. I owe it to the young generations to give back my time and experience I gained from the game.

The RFEF also confirmed a one-game ban against Real Madrid defender Sergio Ramos for being sent off in his side's 3-0 win at Deportivo La Coruna.











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
